TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field! The Quakes return home after a 12-game road trip, as they open a six-game home stand tonight against the San Jose Giants (SFG). Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE GIANTS: Today's game is the seventh of 18 games against the Giants and the seventh of 12 here at home. The Quakes are 4-2 against the Giants, after winning a mid-April series here at home. Rancho was 7-5 against the Giants in 2024, 4-2 here at LoanMart Field.

LAST GAME: The Quakes were held to a season-low two hits on Sunday, as they were blanked for the third time this year, dropping an 8-0 decision to the Modesto Nuts at John Thurman Field. Modesto starter Matt Tiberia (3-0) was dominant, allowing a pair of hits over five innings. Rancho starter Hyun-Seok Jang didn't allow a hit or a run over three scoreless innings, but in the fourth, gave way to Nicolas Cruz (1-2), who struggled and gave up four runs over just 1.1 innings of relief. The loss for the Quakes gives them a split of the six-game set and a 5-7 road trip overall.

RECAPING THE ROAD TRIP: The recent 12-game road trip was not only their longest of the year, but also the worst, as the Quakes went 2-4 in Stockton and 3-3 in Modesto for a 5-7 trip overall. Their series record overall is now 6-2-1, with both series losses coming in Stockton. Post-road trip, Rancho's offense is still tops in the league at .267 with a league-best 43 homers in 51 games. Their ERA (3.77) is second only to San Jose (3.35). Their defense has a fielding percentage of just .962 (#7) and has committed the second-most errors in the league with 68 in 51 games.

HOW TO WRAP IT UP: With 15 to play in the first half, the Quakes enter this series with a nine-game lead over Lake Elsinore and ten over Visalia. In theory, the Quakes could clinch as soon as Friday night, but that would require four straight losses for Lake Elsinore, three losses in four games for Visalia and four straight Rancho wins over San Jose. After this series, the Quakes will head to last-place Inland Empire for six, before finishing the half at home with three against second-place Lake Elsinore. This week, the Storm are in Modesto, while the Rawhide are home against Inland Empire. Next week, the Visalia Rawhide travel to Lake Elsinore for six. Meanwhile, there's real drama up north, as San Jose enters this series a game back of Modesto. The Giants' final three games of the half will be in Modesto.

CLOSE ONES: The Quakes have not played in many close games this year, with Friday night's game being just the seventh one-run game all year and the first since May 9th. Rancho is 4-3 in one-run games and 2-1 in two-run games.

QUINTERO FOR THE SECOND TIME: For the second time this year, Eduardo Quintero was named Player of the Week Award, after torching Modesto last week, hitting .480 (12-for-25) with a homer, seven RBIs, four walks and four stolen bases. He's currently leading the league in homers (9), fifth in the league in RBIs (35), fifth in on-base percentage (.427) third in average (.333) and tied for first in hits (60). He also leads the league in slugging (.606) and is now first in OPS at 1.033. MLB Pipeline rates him as the Dodgers' eighth-best prospect.

AIDAN FOELLER: Right-hander Aidan Foeller makes his tenth start and 11th appearance, his second against San Jose. In his only start against the Giants, he allowed a season-high six runs (five earned) on seven hits over 4.1 innings in a loss on April 17th. In his last outing overall, he allowed four runs (three earned) on three hits over 3.2 innings in a no-decision at Modesto on May 28th. Foeller was an 11th-round selection in last year's draft, out of Southern Illinois.

HUNTER DRYDEN: Right-hander Hunter Dryden makes his ninth start of the year and his second against the Quakes. In his first start against Rancho, he allowed one run on four hits over four innings in a no-decision on April 15th. In his last start overall, he allowed one run on two hits over five innings in a win over the 66ers on May 26th. Dryden was a 17th-round selection by the Giants in the 2024 draft out of Whitworth College in Spokane, Washington.
