NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

- 2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.
- Of 16 series played this season, Omaha has won 5, lost 8 and split 3 ... the Storm Chasers have won 3 of their last 4 games after going 2-7 over the previous 9, dropping back-to-back series before the All-Star Break.
 - Omaha went 13-12 in April ... with a 13-14 record in May and 10-15 in June, the Chasers had back-to-back losing months for the first time since June/July 2025.

COMEBACK KIDS

- The Chasers have 24 comeback wins and have blown a lead in 28 losses this year.
- 24 comeback wins are tied for 7th-most in the International League, tied 11th in Triple-A ... 28 blown leads are 2nd-most in the league, 4th in Triple-A.
 - The Storm Chasers have led at some point in 16 of their last 27 losses, including 4 games where the team led for at least half the game and 2 losses where Omaha had a 6+ run lead at some point in the game.
 - In the last 58 games (since May 9), Omaha is 26-32 ... the Chasers have trailed at some point in 17 of 26 wins and led at some point in 18 of 32 losses, meaning 35 of Omaha's last 58 games (60%) have been a comeback win for one of the teams ... in this stretch, 38 of 58 games (66%) have been decided by 3 runs or less.

SUMMER HEAT

- A pair of Storm Chasers bats have especially been performing well in recent weeks.
- Over his last 16 games (since June 21), **Brett Squires** is slashing .368/.416/.647 (25-for-68) with 15 RBI ... last week, he snapped an on-base streak of 17 straight games, tied for the longest on-base streak among Storm Chasers hitters this year ... Squires hit safely in a career-best 14 straight games (June 16 to July 2).
 - Since his first game with Omaha on June 4, **Matthew Lugo** has hit .282 (35-for-124) with 8 home runs and 25 RBI in 32 games ... since his arrival, he is tied 5th in the International League in home runs and extra-base hits (18), tied 7th in doubles (10), 8th in total bases (69) and tied 8th in runs scored (25).

HONEST ABE

- Abraham Toro** started the season slow, but has been one of the International League's best hitters since mid-May
- Since May 12, Toro has a .320 average (55-for-172) ... he ranks tied 1st in the IL in OPS (.992), 4th in SLG (.605) and tied 8th in AVG (.320) ... his 41 RBI over 46 games since May 12 rank tied as the 6th-most in the league.
 - From March 27 to May 10, Toro hit .189 (21-for-111) with a .650 OPS and hits in 16 of 33 games ... since May 12, Toro has hits in 34 of 46 games, with 4+ hits in 3 games.
 - Over his last 13 games (since June 27), Toro is hitting .333 (17-for-51) with 9 extra-base hits and 11 RBI, with a 1.053 OPS.

CROSS ME UP

- Gavin Cross** had one of the league's slowest start to the season, but has heated up with the weather as the season has gone on.
- Over his first 36 games (March 27 to May 15), Cross hit just .128 (15-for-117) ... but in his last 46 games (since May 16), he's hitting .302 (51-for-169), with 15 XBH and 21 RBI, with 15 multi-hit games, including 5 of his last 8 games.

HOME COOKING

- A pair of Storm Chasers batters have excelled in front of the home crowd at Werner Park so far this season.
- While hitting a modest .232 (32-for-138) with a .704 OPS on the road this year, **Abraham Toro** has batted .303 (44-for-145) with a 1.004 OPS at home this year ... 11 of his 15 total home runs have come at Werner Park.
 - Luca Tresh** has also looked better in Papillion, batting .313 (40-for-128) with an .890 OPS at home while hitting just .229 (27-for-118) with a .597 OPS on the road ... 6 of his 8 homers have come at Werner Park, along with 28 of his 38 RBI.

NIGHT OWLS

- While some players enjoy the early games, a couple of Storm Chasers have performed better under the lights.
- John Rave** has hit .287 (49-for-171) with all 11 of his home runs this season coming in night games, posting an OPS over .260 points higher at night (.924) than in the day (.658).
 - Dan Altavilla** also appears nocturnal, pitching to a 4.18 ERA (13 ER in 28.0 IP) across 22 night games between St. Paul and Omaha, but posting an 11.57 ERA (15 ER in 11.2 IP) across 12 day games.

TODAY'S START

- Stephen Kolek is making his **5th start** with the Storm Chasers this year and his **15th overall appearance** this season.
- Playing his **8th professional season** this year ... the Royals are his 4th Major League organization, after being drafted by the Dodgers and spending time in the Mariners and Padres organizations.
- This is Kolek's 2nd appearance against Lehigh Valley and 4th against the Phillies and their affiliates... his last Triple-A start of 2025 came against the IronPigs, tossing 1.0 scoreless inning for Omaha.

KOLEK-TIVE DOMINANCE

- EVEN STEPHEN:** During a rehab assignment with Omaha at the start of the year, Kolek was one of the best Storm Chaser pitchers ... his 2.76 ERA ranks 3rd among 19 Omaha pitchers with at least 15.0 innings this year, while his 3.50 K/BB is 2nd among that group.
- CRUISE CONTROL KOLEK:** Kolek has had 5 quality starts for the Royals in the Majors this year, tied 3rd on the team, including Kansas City's only complete game, a shutout on May 23 vs. Seattle.

LAST OUTING: THURSDAY, JULY 2 vs. TAMPA BAY

- Made his 10th start of the season for Kansas City ... worked a perfect top of the 1st inning, but after retiring putting away 2 of the first 3 batters he faced in the top of the 2nd inning, allowed and RBI double, single and triple before walking a batter and getting out of the inning down 3-1. Did not return for the top of the 3rd inning with Randy Dobnak taking his place.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 1 Cactus League game for the Royals, working 2.0 innings on February 20 @ Texas ... was scratched from his 2nd spring start and diagnosed with a *Grade 1+ left oblique strain* on February 27.
- On March 25, placed on the Royals' 15-day Injured List, retroactive to March 22 ... sent to Omaha for a Major League rehab assignment on April 14 and activated by Kansas City on May 5.
- Optioned back to Omaha on May 6, but didn't pitch before returning to the Royals on May 8 ... had 2 stints on the Family Medical List before being sent to Omaha for a rehab assignment on July 18.

CAREER NOTES

- 2025** Opened the year with El Paso (AAA) before making his season debut for San Diego on May 4 ... had multiple stints with both clubs, pitching to a 4.18 ERA across 14 starts in the Majors with the Padres.
- Traded to Kansas City with RHP Ryan Bergert for C Freddy Fermin on July 31 ... began his tenure in the Royals organization with 5 starts for Omaha and had 2 stints in the Majors with Kansas City after that, posting a 1.91 ERA (7 ER in 33.0 IP) with 21 strikeouts to 5 walks (4.2 K/BB) in 5 starts in the Majors.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Was the 9th overall pick by the Padres in the Rule 5 Draft on December 6, 2023 ... spent most of 2024 in the Majors with San Diego and posted a 5.21 ERA (27 ER in 46.2 IP) with a 3-0 record and 39 strikeouts to 12 walks (3.25 K/BB) across 42 relief appearances ... ended the season on the IL from 7/31 to 11/4.
- Pitched in the Mariners organization from 2021 to 2023, working his way from Modesto (A) to Tacoma (AAA) ... pitched most of 2023 in Triple-A, with a 4-2 record and 4.23 ERA across 44 games (1 start) ... spent all of 2022 with the Arkansas Travelers (AA) and put up a 4.51 ERA with 138 strikeouts in 27 starts.
- Traded from the Dodgers to the Mariners on April 28, 2021 ... opened the season with Modesto (A), but spent most of the year with Everett (A+) while also making 1 relief appearance for Arkansas (AA).
- After being selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 11th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Texas A&M, he spent most of his first two professional seasons (2018-19) with the Great Lakes Loons (A).

MISCELLANEOUS

- Pitched 3 seasons (2016-18) for Texas A&M University (SEC) ... worked a career 12-11 record with a 4.03 ERA (89 ER in 199.0 IP) and 162 strikeouts to 75 walks (2.16 K/BB) for the Aggies.
- Was named to the Perfect Game 2014 Underclassmen First Team as a sophomore at Shepherd High School (TX) ... also played varsity football and basketball his junior and senior years.
- Older brother, Tyler Kolek, was selected by the Marlins as the 2nd overall pick in the 2014 MLB Draft and pitched parts of 5 Minor League seasons (2014-19).
