JACKSONVILLE EDGES CHARLOTTE, 6-5

Jesús Bastidas notched a three-run double in the Jumbo Shrimp's five-run fifth on Saturday to help Jacksonville beat Charlotte 6-5. The game was scoreless until the fourth, when a Knights error plated Agustín Ramírez. The Jumbo Shrimp scored five times in the fifth on Bastidas' bases-clearing double, a Devyison De Los Santos RBI double and Ramírez RBI ground out. However, Charlotte registered five runs in the sixth to pull to within 6-5. Tyler Zuber and Jack Ralston combined to toss 3.2 scoreless innings of relief in the victory.

GOOD MORNING, GOOD AFTERNOON, GOODNIGHT!

Jacksonville's pitching staff has recorded a whopping 417 strikeouts through 38 games, a rate of 11.0 per game. The Jumbo Shrimp have 40 more punchouts than Norfolk, the team that ranks second in Triple-A. Thus, the Tides' 377 strikeouts are as close to 13th-place Gwinnett as they are to Jacksonville in first. In addition to the swings and misses, the Jumbo Shrimp have also shown an ability to limit hard contact; their 86.9 average exit velocity against is the second-best figure in Triple-A.

DEFENSE AGAINST THE DARK ARTS

Jacksonville has yielded the fourth-fewest runs (169) in Triple-A while posting the level's fourth-best ERA (4.14). While the club leads all Triple-A staffs in strikeouts (417), the Jumbo Shrimp have also done a phenomenal job at turning batted balls put into play into outs; Jacksonville ranks second in Triple-A by turning 72.7 percent of balls put into play into outs. Only two clubs have recorded a rate of at least 71 percent this season.

BERRY BLAST

Jacob Berry struggled significantly over the 2025 season's first 33 games, going just 13-for-103 (.126/.229/.223/.452) at the plate with 35 strikeouts in 119 plate appearances (29.4 percent). The Queens Creek, Ariz., has been truly excellent since that point. Over his last 119 Triple-A games, Berry is batting .300/.392/.442/.834, cutting his strikeout rate by more than half at 14.1 percent with just 67 over 474 plate appearances. Over his last 26 games this season, Berry is 28-for-89 (.315/.438/.461/.899) with seven doubles, two home runs, 16 RBIs, 19 walks and 15 runs scored.

A TALE OF TWO SEASONS

In 2025, Jacksonville starting pitchers worked 603.1 of the club's 1,304.0 innings - a rate of just 46.3 percent and the 24th-most of any starting staff in Triple-A. This season has been a much different story; Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have tossed 176.2 of the club's 337.0 innings - a rate of 52.4 percent and the second-highest total of any Triple-A staff. On the campaign, Jacksonville starters collectively lead Triple-A in strikeouts (197), batting average against (.195) and WHIP (1.16) while ranking third in fewest hits (122) and GO/AO (1.22) and fourth in ERA (3.87).

ON THE OFFENSIVE

Heading into play on April 22, Jacksonville had scored at least five runs in a contest just three times in 22 affairs, ranking last in Triple-A in runs (68, 3.1 per game) and each slash line category (.186/.296/.282/.578). The Jumbo Shrimp have now plated at least five runs 11 times in the 16 games since, awakening a previously-dormant offense. During this stretch, the club ranks seventh in Triple-A in runs (102, 6.4 per game). They also place in the top 12 in doubles (T-2nd, 37), hits (9th, 152) and average (12th, .268). Jacksonville was hitting just .166 with runners in scoring position over the season's first 22 games; they are 51-for-181 (.282) in those situations over the last 16 contests.

KEMPIRE STATE OF MIND

Jacksonville outfielder Kemp Alderman got off to a slow start to the season. Through his first 11 games, Alderman was just 5-for-35 (.143/.318/.200/.518) with only one triple, one RBI, eight walks, seven runs and 18 strikeouts over 44 plate appearances (40.9 percent strikeout rate). The Decatur, Miss., native has surged since then; Over his last 22 games, Alderman is a scorching 31-for-90 (.344/.398/.556/.954) at the plate with four doubles, five home runs, 14 RBIs, five walks and 17 runs scored. He has fanned 29 times in 98 plate appearances, lowering his strikeout rate to 29.6 percent during this span.

SHRIMP BITES

Josh White is scheduled to start Sunday's game against Charlotte. He has made just 14 starts out of 135 career appearances in the minor leagues, though two came with the Jumbo Shrimp last season.
