BRIDE HOMERS TWICE AS SHRIMP WIN 7-5

Jonah Bride crushed two home runs Friday as Jacksonville rallied from a 4-0 deficit to beat Charlotte 7-5. The Knights plated their four runs in the third. José Devers hit a solo shot in the bottom of the third to get the Jumbo Shrimp on the board. Bride led off the fourth with a bomb and then Victor Mesa Jr. tied the game with a two-run shot. Otto López's RBI single in the fifth broke the tie and later in the inning, Bride smashed his second homer. In the sixth, a passed ball plated Dane Myers. Colson Montgomery's eighth-inning homer drew the Knights within 7-5, but they could get no closer.

GRAND THEFT OTTO

The Miami Marlins claimed Otto López off waivers from the San Francisco Giants on April 4 and promptly optioned him to Jacksonville. The Montréal native has been almost impossible to retire since that point. Over his first six games with the Jumbo Shrimp, López is 13-for-24 (.542/.593/.875/1.468) with two doubles, two home runs, five RBIs, three walks and four runs scored. He has reached base multiple times in five of his six games with Jacksonville.

Jacksonville's bullpen has excelled of late. Over the club's last five games, Jumbo Shrimp relievers have combined to yield just two runs on 13 hits in 22.0 innings (0.82 ERA) with 27 strikeouts against six walks. On the season, Jacksonville's bullpen has posted a 3.35 ERA, which ranks fourth in the International League. Jumbo Shrimp relievers have retired 31 of the 37 first-batters they have faced (83.8 percent), far above the baseball-wide average of roughly 70.0 percent.

GRAY'S ANATOMY

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Tristan Gray, who played 331 games with the Durham Bulls from 2021-23, has been on a tear since returning to the Bull City for a series that began on April 2. The Missouri City, Texas native homered in five consecutive games from April 2-6, the longest such streak for a Jacksonville hitter since Peter O'Brien went yard in six straight games from June 6-11, 2018. Over the last nine games, six of which came against Durham, Gray is a combined 10-for-34 (.290) with a double, five home runs, nine RBIs, four walks and eight runs scored.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Outside of a 10-0 loss to Gwinnett on March 31, a 6-2 defeat to Durham on April 5 and another 6-2 loss to Charlotte on Thursday, all 10 of Jacksonville's contests in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have gone 8-2 in those closely-decided affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

SEVENTH HEAVEN

Jacksonville began the season by losing two of three games against Gwinnett, but since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have won seven of their last 10 games. All seven of those victories have come by three runs or fewer, with Jacksonville outscoring their opponents by a narrow 43-39 margin. Relatedly, those 43 runs scored rank in a tie for ninth-fewest in Triple-A during this stretch. However, their 39 runs allowed are the sixth-fewest at the level since this stretch began on April 2. The Jumbo Shrimp's 3.27 ERA leads Triple-A during this stretch.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through 13 games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 49 runs (3.8 per game), in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 19for-113 (.168/.296/.283/.579, ranking 30th, 29th, 29th and 30th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position, stranding a total of 87 runners. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

Of the 28 innings Jacksonville in which has scored in this season. 16 have been multi-run frames... José Devers has hits in nine consecutive games, batting 11-for-32 (.345) with three doubles, a triple, two home runs, six RBIs, two walks and seven runs scored... The Jumbo Shrimp's four home runs were the club's most in a game since launching six on May 27, 2023 against Charlotte.



ABOUT YONNY

-A native of Bachaquero, Venezuela, Chirinos signed with the Tampa Bay Rays for \$10,000 as an international free agent from Venezuela in June 2012.

-On March 25, 2018, the Rays announced that Chirinos had made the Opening Day roster. Chirinos made his opening debut in a long relief role against the Boston Red Sox on April 1. He worked four scoreless innings while allowing just one hit. Chirinos set a franchise record by pitching his first 14 2/3 innings without allowing an earned run.

-Chirinos pitched for Tampa Bay on August 16, 2020 against the Blue Jays. His start that night followed a stint on the injured list due to right triceps inflammation. A week later, he underwent Tommy John surgery. Chirinos' rehab and recovery process was stalled in September 2021 when he fractured his elbow while throwing batting practice. The injury required surgery and, as it turned out, set him back another year. He wound up going 752 days between appearances for the Rays, finally returning to the mound on September 8, 2022. Chirinos allowed four hits, one walk and struck out four while blanking the Red Sox during a three-inning stint. When he took the mound in the fourth in relief of Jeffrey Springs, the game was scoreless. When he exited after the sixth, the Rays had a 1-0 lead. That is how the game finished and Chirinos had his first win since August 4, 2019.

-After more than a decade in the Rays' organization, Chirinos was claimed off waivers on July 23, 2023 by the Atlanta Braves. Atlanta non-tendered Chirinos in November and he signed a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins in February.

-With both Tampa Bay and Atlanta, when pitching with the bases empty, opponents posted an .832 OPS in 224 appearances. In 138 plate appearances with runners on base, that figure dropped to .794. Additionally, in 87 plate appearances with runners in scoring position, opponents compiled a .742 OPS.

-According to Baseball Savant, Chirinos was in the 87th percentile in offspeed run value (+4) while also ranking in the 71st percentile in ground ball percentage (46.3 percent).
