LAST TIME OUT

Worcester, MA (Aug. 15) -The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders rallied back for a 6-5 win over the Worcester Red Sox. The team hit three home runs thanks to Austin Wells, Franchy Cordero, and Jake Lamb.

A pitcher's duel ensued from the onset as both starters tossed five scoreless innings.

Worcester got on the board first putting up five in the sixth inning. Stephen Scott launched a three-run home run over the monster in right field. Ronaldo Hernandez and Bradley Zimmer were hit by pitches to reach. Red Sox #3 prospect Ceddanne Rafaela sent them both in with a triple to the corner for a 5-0 advantage.

The RailRiders cut into the lead in the seventh. Everson Pereira ran out an infield single and Carlos Narvaez senthim home with an RBI double.Austin Wells crushed his first Triple-A homer of the season 473-feet to right center field. SWB trailed 5-2.

The visiting team went into the top of the ninth with the bats alive. Wilmer Difo singled on a line drive and Franchy Cordero smoked a ball 461-feet to right center. Then, down to their final out, Jake Lambcame up with a long ball to left field to tie the game at five apiece. Brandon Lockridge continued the frame with a base hit. Oswald Peraza followed with a ground rule double to send Lockridge racing home for a 6-5 lead.

Will Warren got the start going five shutout innings, allowing a three run home run on the final pitch of his outing. He tied a season-high eight strikeouts. Zac Houston allowed two runs in his inning of work. Zach McAllister recorded three strikeouts in his frame. Greg Weissert (W, 4-3) and Ron Marinaccio (S, 1) slammed the door shut in the eighth and ninth. Shane Drohan tossed six innings of shutout ball with

NEWS & NOTES

STRIKEOUT CITY- Last night the RailRiders pitching staff combined for 18 strikeouts, their most in a nine innning contest hits season. Prior the arms had collected 15 K's multiple times this season. Thanks to a season-high eight from the starter Will Warren. Zach McAllister and Greg Weissert recorded three in their innings. Zac Houston and Ron Marinaccio each had a pair.

LOCKRIDGE LEGS IT OUT- Brandon Lockridge stole his 16th base for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on Sunday to have the third most on the team (Florial & Difo) in just 42 games. Lockridge had 17 more with Somerset earlier this season. He is second in the organization with his 33 swipes, well over a career-high, having only been caught four times on the summer. Jasson Dominguez (SOM) leads the Yankees affiliates with 36 steals on the season.

FRANCHY RAKES - Franchy Cordero smoked his fourth home run in four games, with a late inning long ball last night. That was his 13th here in Triple-A with six more coming from his time in New York. The righty had a career-high 20 long balls in 2017. He's battting .328 in 52 games with SWB, having batted in 48 runs.

JAMIE JACK - Jamie Westbrook is well on his way to producing career numbers with the RailRiders in his first season affiliated with New York. He had his 17th homer on the season, third most on the team. The righty has upped his batting average to .303 on the season with 88 hits in 83 games. The most home runs he has ever had in a summer was 19 back in 2018. Since June 1st, Westbrook is batting .365 with more walks (29) than strikeouts (20).

HITTING HOMERS-The RailRiders are now third in the International League in home runs with 179 to Worcester who has 182. The Las Vegas Aviators have the most in MiLB with 186 long balls while the Atlanta Braves lead all of baseball with 231 smashed.. The RailRiders have launched a half a dozen homers in two contests in this season. The team homered 20 times in a week against Charlotte, topping the 16 they hit last season against Omaha. Estevan Florial leads the team with twenty-three, while seven players are in double digits.

MCALLISTER STRONG - Since being signed by the Yankees August 5th, Zach McAllister has made four scoreless appearances, allowing just one hit and two walks. The righty has struck out seven. McAllister pitched for SWB back in 2010 making him have the most time between outings for the franchise. He recorded a win on August 9th making it 4,785 days between home wins for Zach McAllister at PNC Field. His last win for SWB was on July 3, 2010 -- when the team was known as the Yankees

ANOTHER YEAR DOWN - The RailRiders three August birthdays on the calendar. Josh Maciejewski turned 28 years old on August 14th. On the very next day, reliever Michael Gomez celebrates his 27th birthday. His teammate Zach Greene will as well on August 25th.

LEADING THE CHARGE - The RailRiders have had nine different first basemen this season, with Jake Lamb being the latest. Andres Chaparro leads the way with Billy McKinney following shortly thereafter. Catchers Rodolfo Duran and Carlos Narvaez have turned into regulars in the corner. Mickey Gasper, Jake Bauers, Franchy Cordero and Max Burt have defended there as well.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM – The RailRiders will showcase top prospects, catcher, Austin Wells (#8 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) and outfielder Everson Periera (#3) in his first Triple-A season. Will Warren (#10), Clayton Beeter (#16), and Edgar Barclay (#28) are set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre this summer

TJ TIME: Had Tommy John surgery in December 2017 before his first season at Texas Tech and a follow-up arthroscopic elbow procedure seven months later

FUTURE FARMHAND: Was one of two Yankees prospects selected to the All-Star Futures Game in Seattle. The righty tossed just nine pitches, five for strikes, to record two outs in the seventh. He got San Diego's Jackson Merrill to ground out and recorded a strikeout against Jackson Chourio. Chourio is the #3 ranked prospect in all of MiLB according to MLB Pipeline, while Merrill stands at #10.

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS: Led the Red Raiders' 2019 College World Series semifinalists with eight saves and dominating in four starts as a redshirt sophomore, was a Freshman All-American in 2019 after recording a team-high eight saves in 20 appearances, where he owned a 3.20 ERA and 39 strikeout

PERSONAL/CAREER:

- 2023: In Beeter's second start of the season (55th career game) on 4/14 @BNG, he earned his first professional win with a career-high 6.2 IP, breaking his previous career mark of 5 IP, set in his final two starts of 2022. In the performance, Beeter started the Patriots' second shutout win of the season.
- 2022: Spent the beginning of his second season with the Dodgers in Double-A Tulsa making 18 appearances (16 GS), continuing to serve primarily as an opener, working no more than 4 IP in any of his starts, posting an 0-3 record with a 5.75 ERA and 15.33 K/9 IP. Beeter was acquired by the Yankees from the Dodgers hours before the 2022 MLB trade deadline on August 2 as the lone piece received in exchange for outfielder Joey Gallo. At the time of the trade, Beeter was ranked the Dodgers' No. 21 prospect by Baseball America, which credited him with having the Best Curveball in the Dodgers Mil.B system. Beeter made his Yankees organizational debut with Double-A Somerset on 8/10/22, pitching three scoreless innings in which he posted six strikeouts and allowed only one baserunner (BB). In seven starts to end the season with Somerset, he posted a 2.13 ERA over 25.1 IP with 41 K and 11 BB (14.57 K/9 IP). Across his 7 GS with Somerset to end 2022, Beeter set and matched a new career-high 9 K on 8/27/22 vs. NH and 9/3/22 @BNG. Over this stretch, he also set a new career high in IP three different times, including in his lone postseason start on 9/22/22 vs. POR. He allowed 2 R (1 ER)
- 2021: Made his pro debut in 2021 and posted a 3.44 ERA between High-A Great Lakes and Double-A Tulsa, working mostly as an opener, going no more than 3.1 IP in any outing
