LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones picked up their third shutout win of the season — and second of the series — as they took down the Blue Rocks, 3-0, on Friday night...The Brooklyn arms of RHP **Jordan Geber** (notched the win), RHP **Brett Banks** (collected a hold), and RHP **Justin Lawson** (snagged his fourth save of the season) limited Wilmington to only one base hit...**Gilbert Gomez**'s squad grabbed a pair of runs in the fifth courtesy of a bases-loaded walk and wild pitch, before tacking on another in the sixth on a sacrifice fly from 2B **Junior Tillen**...The 'Clones have held Wilmington to only four combined runs through the first four games of the series

BIG DRIP RETURNS: RHP **Tylor Megill** is scheduled to make a Major League rehab start for the Cyclones on Saturday afternoon...The 28-year-old was placed on the New York Mets' 15-day injured list on April 1 with a right shoulder strain...Megill is the second player to join Brooklyn in 2024 on an MLB rehab assignment...RHP **Sean Reid-Foley** struck out the side for the Cyclones on April 14 vs. Asheville before being reinstated on April 22...Megill began his professional career on Coney Island in 2018 after being drafted...In 10 appearances (two starts), the California native held a 1-2 record with a 3.21 ERA (10 ER in 28.0 IP), 14 walks, and 36 strikeouts...Since making his MLB debut in 2021, Megill is 17-17 with a 4.68 ERA (139 ER in 267.1 IP), 101 walks, and 259 strikeouts in 59 appearances (53 starts) for the Mets.

NOT ON OUR WATCH! The Cyclones' bullpen has been nearly untouchable as of late...Brooklyn relievers kept Wilmington at bay again on Friday; entering Saturday, the unit has not allowed a run during the homestand...The last time anyone scratched was a run off a 'Clones reliever was in the sixth inning of Sunday's series finale in Jersey Shore...Brooklyn comes into Saturday with a 2.78 bullpen ERA, good for the second-lowest mark in the SAL, trailing only Hudson Valley (1.95)...It is also fourth-best at the High-A level...The 'Clones' pen has also registered a league-best 118 strikeouts while issuing the second-fewest walks (30).

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: RHPs **Jordan Geber**, **Brett Banks**, and **Justin Lawson** united on a one-hit shutout of Wilmington in Friday's 3-0 victory...The one-hitter marked the first time the Cyclones held an opponent to one or fewer hits since May 22, 2022...Brooklyn bested Hudson Valley, 3-1, in Game 2 of a doubleheader...It was the first one-hitter in a nine-inning game since a 6-1 rout vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...RHP **Conner Grey** carried a no-hit bid into the ninth inning that night...It was Brooklyn's second shutout of the series and third of the year after RHPs **Nolan McLean**, **Dakota Hawkins**, and **Joey Lancellotti** combined on Brooklyn's 5-0 win vs. Wilmington on Tuesday...RHPs **Brandon Sproat**, **Jordany Ventura**, and **Justin Lawson** registered a five-hitter vs. Asheville on April 9...The Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts in 2023.

LONG ARM OF THE LAW: RHP **Justin Lawson** has started his 2024 with a bang...The reliever notched a three-inning save in Friday's shutout of Wilmington, good for his fourth of the season (and second that spanned three full innings)...The former member of the N.C. State Wolfpack is tied for second in the circuit in saves (4)...Among South Atlantic League relievers with at least nine innings pitched, the 23-year-old has the lowest WHIP (0.33) and opposing OPS (.136) in the circuit and has permitted the fewest hits (1).

DOOGIE HOWSER: RHP **Douglas Orellana** was untouchable on Wednesday night vs. Wilmington...The 21-year-old retired all 15 batters he faced — striking out six — in five shutout innings of relief, earning the hold...Orellana became the first Cyclone since at least 2005 to throw five or more innings out of the bullpen without allowing a hit...RHP **Benito Garcia** (8/12/23 vABD), RHP **Daison Acosta** (6/21/22 vJS), and RHP **Chris Schwinden** (6.0 IP; 7/18/08 @ONE) each posted 5.0+ innings, but allowed only one hit...Orellana is just the third Brooklyn pitcher in any capacity since 2005 to toss five or more innings without yielding a hit at all...However, the other two allowed a man to reach on a hit-by-pitch...LHP **Nelson Pereira** (5.0 IP) was the last to do it in a 2-1 win over 14 innings on August 15, 2010, at Williamsport.

LOVE THE DRAKE! C **Drake Osborn** has been unstoppable at the plate to start the 2024 season...The 25-year-old has reached base safely in all 10 games he's played, hitting an eye-popping .438 (14-32) with a 1.206 OPS, adding four doubles, a home run, and four RBI...Among players in the South Atlantic League with at least 40 plate appearances, the Corpus Christi, Texas native leads the circuit in batting average (.438), on-base percentage (.550), and OPS (1.206), while trailing only Aberdeen C **Creed Williams** (.691) in slugging (.656).

GLORIOUS LORUSSO: INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The former Maryland Terrapin tied a career-best with three hits in Tuesday's victory, adding a triple and a career-high three RBI...Entering play on Thursday, Lorusso is tied for fifth in the SAL in extra-base hits (7) and tied for sixth in total bases (26).

RUN FOR YOUR LIFE: The Cyclones' offense exploded for seven runs in the bottom of the third in a 13-3 win vs. Wilmington on Wednesday...Brooklyn had 10 consecutive batters reach base with one out in the inning...The seven-run frame was the largest for the Cyclones since they erupted for nine in the bottom of the second inning on July 27, 2023, also against Wilmington, in an 11-7 triumph...The 13 runs for Brooklyn also set a new season high...The Cyclones had not tallied that many in a single contest since a 13-2 win at Asheville in 10 innings on August 24, 2023...It was the first time Brooklyn scored 13+ in a nine-inning game dating back to an 18-1 thrashing at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...Since 2005, the Cyclones' highwater mark for runs in a single inning is

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn opens their first two-week homestand of the season against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks possess three of Washington's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: OF **Daylen Lile** (11), INF **Kevin Made** (24), and INF **T.J. White** (28)...Wilmington swept a three-game season-opening set against Brooklyn, winning the last two games on walk-offs from OF **Jared McKenzie**...In 30 meetings during the 2023 campaign, Brooklyn posted a 16-14 record against Wilmington, but just a 9-9 record at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones were 7-5 last year against the Blue Rocks at Frawley Stadium...Including 2024, the 'Clones are 45-42 (.517) all-time against the 'Rocks.

10 in the top of the sixth of a 20-6 romp at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022...The 20 runs were also a franchise record.

CANARSIE'S OWN: IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** returns to his native Brooklyn to start a minor league rehab assignment on Tuesday, recovering...The 23-year-old grew up in the Canarsie neighborhood, roughly 10 miles northeast of Maimonides Park...Palmer also attended Holy Cross High School in Flushing, Queens, approximately five miles east of Citi Field...The right-handed swinger has appeared in at least one game with Brooklyn each season since 2021 and enters the day as the franchise's all-time leader in games played (201), runs scored (100), walks (108), stolen bases (49), and hit-by-pitches (17).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** enters Saturday's contest 8-for-9 stealing bases to start the season...The eight swipes are tied for fifth in the South Atlantic League...De Los Santos is second on the Cyclones' all-time stolen base list (45)...He is four steals shy of matching IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer's** (49) all-time record...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is eighth across the Minors for swipes (115)...He broke INF **Walter Rasquin's** (32) franchise single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023.

GRAB SOME PINE: RHPs **Calvin Ziegler**, **Jordany Ventura**, **Sean Reid-Foley**, **Justin Lawson**, and **Ben Simon** united to punch out 18 Asheville batters in April 14's walk-off victory...RHPs **Calvin Ziegler**, **Josh Hejka**, **Dakota Hawkins**, and **Joshua Cornelli** also combined to strike out 18 Wilmington hitters over 9.2 innings in April 7's loss at Wilmington...The 18 strikeouts by Cyclones pitching are the most for the franchise in a single game since July 23, 2016, vs. Aberdeen...RHP **Justin Dunn** (5), LHP **Kyle Regnault** (2), and RHP **Nabil Crismatt** (11) combined to whiff 18 IronBirds over nine innings in a 7-2 win...The multiple contests with 18+ strikeouts are tied for the most by a Cyclones team since 2005...Brooklyn also accomplished the feat in a pair of extra-inning games in 2016 and two nine-inning games in 2008...The single-game franchise mark for team strikeouts is 22 set in a 20-inning, 3-2 loss vs. Staten Island on June 17, 2016.

KING STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 44 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 98 RBI...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

YOUTH IS SERVED: **Gilbert Gomez** takes over as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2024...At 32 years of age, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native is the youngest skipper in franchise history...After leading Single-A St. Lucie last summer, Gomez served as manager of Tigres del Licey in the Dominican Winter League (LIDOM)...Became the youngest manager to win a championship in LIDOM history and the second-youngest manager to win a game in Caribbean Series history...Gomez's younger brother, **Dariel**, played at Double-A Binghamton in the Mets' organization last summer and is currently with the Charleston Dirty Birds of the MLB Partner Atlantic League...Older brother, **José**, is a scout for the Tampa Bay Rays and general manager for LIDOM's Leones del Escogido...Older brother, **Héctor**, is a well-known baseball reporter...Gomez also played seven years in New York's farm system, posting a .662 OPS in 537 games.

GENUINE DRAFT: Eight members of last summer's New York Mets' draft class are with the Cyclones early in 2024...Pregent returned to the roster, while second-round selection RHP **Brandon Sproat** and third-round pick two-way player **Nolan McLean** are scheduled to make their High-A debuts...RHP **Noah Hall** (7th), INF **Nick Lorusso** (9th), RHP **Brett Banks** (11th), RHP **Ben Simon** (13th), and RHP **Justin Lawson** (15th) round out the group...RHP **Dakota Hawkins**, who signed as an undrafted free agent, is also with the club.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Ryan Clifford** (No. 5), **Brandon Sproat** (11), **Nolan McLean** (15), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Clifford (4), Sproat (13), McLean (19), Ziegler (22), and INF **Wilfredo Lara** (23)...MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 93rd-best farmhand in all of baseball.

LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss in his first and only start of the season for the Mets on March 31 vs. Milwaukee...Allowed just two runs (one earned) on three over four innings...Walked three and struck out four...Plunked one batter and induced a double play...Tossed 78 pitches and 44 strikes (56.4%)...Relieved by RHP **Yohan Ramirez** to start the top of the fifth with New York behind 2-1...Brewers went on to defeat the Mets, 4-1.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Megill returns to Coney Island for a Major League rehab start, six years after making his professional debut with the Cyclones...Saturday will mark the 28-year-old's first appearance at Maimonides Park since August 16, 2018, vs. Vermont...Megill tossed four scoreless, one-hit innings of relief in support of LHP **Josh Walker**, walking one and striking out eight...He took a no-decision in Brooklyn's 2-1 walk-off win in 10...During the 2018 season, Megill accrued a 1-2 record with a 3.21 ERA (10 ER in 28.0 IP), walking 14 (12.1 BB%) and striking out 36 (31.0 K%) in 10 appearances (two starts).

REHAB STINT: Megill was placed on the New York Mets' 15-day injured list on April 1 with a right shoulder strain...He is the second player to join Brooklyn on a Major League rehab assignment in 2024...RHP **Sean Reid-Foley** struck out the side in order on April 14 vs. Asheville before rejoining the big league club on April 22.

HUG ME BROTHER!: Tylor is not the only Major Leaguer in the family, as his older brother, **Trevor**, is currently a relief pitcher for the Milwaukee Brewers...So far in 2024, the elder Megill has a 1.59 ERA (1 ER in 5.2 IP) with one save, three walks, and five strikeouts...Trevor has made 103 appearances (two starts) since 2021 with the Brewers, Minnesota Twins, and Chicago Cubs...The brothers pitched with one another during the 2015 college baseball season at Loyola Marymount University and each made their MLB debut in 2021.

OPEN THE DOOR: Megill was the Mets' Opening Day starter on April 7, 2022, at Washington...The following year, the right-hander was New York's starter in the home opener vs. Miami on April 7, 2023...He joined RHP **Dillon Gee** (2007) as the only former Cyclones to start for the Mets on Opening Day.

HIT ME BABY ONE LAST TIME: Megill holds a unique part of New York Mets history...The 28-year-old is the last Mets pitcher to record a hit before Major League Baseball adopted the universal designated hitter in 2022...Megill registered a double on October 1, 2021, at Atlanta.

PROSPECT RADAR: Sproat enters the 2024 campaign as one of the top pitching prospects in the New York Mets farm system...The 23-year-old is considered New York's No. 11 prospect per *Baseball America* and No. 13 by MLB Pipeline...He is the fourth-ranked pitching prospect in the organization by *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline.

SPRING BREAKOUT: The Pace, Fla. native earned a hold pitching in relief for the New York Mets prospects in their contest against the Washington Nationals' farmhands on Friday, March 15...Sproat came on in support of fellow Cyclone RHP **Nolan McLean** in the top of the sixth...The right-hander retired the side in order on just six pitches (all strikes) earning punch outs of C **Maxwell Romero Jr.** and OF **Andrew Pinckney**...McLean earned the win and teammate RHP **Calvin Ziegler** picked up the save in New York's 4-2, seven-inning win.

GATOR BAIT: Sproat did not pitch after being drafted by the Mets last season, but thrived for the 2023 NCAA runner-up Florida Gators...In 19 starts, the right-hander posted an 8-3 record with a 4.66 ERA (55 ER in 106.1 IP), earning All-SEC Second Team honors...Sproat finished the campaign seventh among Division I pitchers in strikeouts (134).

THIRD TIME'S THE CHARM: Sproat was drafted for the third and final time in the MLB draft last summer, ultimately signing for a \$1.47 million bonus...Prior to being New York's second-round selection in 2023, the 23-year-old was picked by the Mets in the third round of the 2022 draft out of Florida, but did not sign...In 2019, Sproat was drafted by the Texas Rangers in the seventh round out of Pace High School, but also did not sign.

FAMILIAR FACES: While at the University of Florida, Sproat spent the summer of 2021 pitching for the Chatham Anglers of the Cape Cod Baseball League...During that time, the right-hander was teammates with current Cyclones TWP **Nolan McLean** and former Brooklyn RHP **Kolby Kubichek** and C **Kevin Parada**.
