LAST GAME OUT

(JACKSONVILLE, FL, April 30) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders beat the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp 7-6 on Tuesday night.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre started the offense in the top of the first inning against Jacksonville's Yonny Chirinos. With one down, Everson Pereira, T.J. Rumfield and Oscar Gonzalez reached on three straight singles to load the bases. Pereira scored on groundout by Jose Rojas for a 1-0 SWB lead.

Jacksonville answered quickly in the bottom of the first. Javier Sanoja tripled and scored on a sac fly from Jonah Bride to even the game at one. After the RailRiders left runners on in the second and third innings, they regained the lead in the top of the third. Jeter Downs reached on an error and Josh VanMeter hit a 1-0 pitch from Chirinos over the wall in left-center for a 3-1 Scranton/Wilkes-Barre edge. The Jumbo Shrimp again countered quickly. Griffin Conine's solo home run to right cut the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre lead down to 3-2.

In the top of the seventh, Rumfield hit his first Triple-A home run to extend the RailRiders lead to 5-2; a two-run blast off reliever Devin Smeltzer. Jacksonville answered in the bottom of the inning as Victor Mesa, Jr. hit a three-run homer off reliever Yerry De Los Santos to tie the game at 5-5. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre plated two runs in the top of the eighth for a 7-5 advantage. With the bases loaded, Caleb Durbin worked a walk from Devin Smeltzer to put the RailRiders back up by one. Smeltzer hit Pereira to bring in an insurance run and extend the lead back to two at 7-5. In the bottom of the eighth, the Jumbo Shrimp got one run back on an RBI triple from Will Banfield to cut the lead to 7-6, but Anthony Misiewicz struck out the final two batters of the inning to end the threat.

Will Warren made the start for the RailRiders, allowing two runs on six hits with seven strikeouts. Misiewicz (W, 1-0) earned the win and Phil Bickford pitched a perfect ninth for his first save of the season. Smeltzer (L, 0-1) took the loss for Jacksonville.

NEWS & NOTES

STILL IN FRONT: With an important win last night, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre have sole possession of first place in the International League. The team has a game advantage over Buffalo and have the highest run differential (+37) in the league. The RailRiders are also the only team in the IL to have reached 18 wins.

NARVY'S UP NEXT - The Yankees called up Carlos Narvaez for the first time in his career to replace Alex Verdugo who went on the paternity list. He played in 23 games for the RailRiders as a catcher and as a first baseman. The righty is batting .211 with four doubles and two homers. He drove in twelve. Narvaez was added to the Yankees 40-man roster in November of last year.

PITCHING ON TOP - The RailRiders pitching staff has the lowest earned run average in all of Triple-A baseball with a 3.64. They have also allowed the least amount of runs with 111 this summer. They are also lead in saves with ten total.

WILLING IT - Yankees #7 prospect Will Warren pitched three consecutive quality starts. In his last outing, Warren went six innings allowing just two runs. He did not allow any walks, but hit two batters. The righty struck out seven on 90 pitches.

T.J. TIME: T.J. Rumfield smacked his first home run of the season last night, giving the RailRiders the late lead. With SWB, the rookie is hitting .292 in a dozen contests. Rumfield has 14 hits, including five doubles. He has batted in eleven runs. Last season, he hit 17 homers. Rumfield was traded along with LHP Joel Valdez from the Phillies for RHP Nick Nelson and C Donny Sands in 2021.

CLAYTON'S CRUSHING: Clayton Beeter has lowered his ERA to 3.63 in four starts this season. He has been electric on the road going 2-0 with a 1.80 earned run average. In both of his starts away from PNC Field, Beeter has gone five innings with no walks and eight strikeouts apiece.

BICKFORD'S BEST: Phil Bickford recorded the one inning save last night for his first of the season. He preserved a one run ballgame with a pair of strikeouts and a flyout. Manager Shelley Duncan said it was his best outing of the season. Bickford lowered his ERA to a 3.60 in his ten innings of work. The righty has just three walks to 12 strikeouts in his nine appearances.

VANMETER ON HIGH: In the last two weeks, Josh VanMeter has found his groove at the plate. In his past ten contests, he is hitting .360 with nine hits and nine runs batted in. VanMeter has also walked nine times to his seven strikeouts. The lefty hit his second home run of the summer yesterday. VanMeter was signed as a free agent on January 16.

MLB DEBUT: Made the 2024 Opening Day roster and his New York Yankees debut on March 29 at Houston...Entered in the ninth inning and threw three pitches, all strikeouts...Allowed one single to Jose Altuve, got an odd 5-6-3 DP, and a flyout; Was optioned to SWB on 3/30

ORIGINALLY DRAFTED: Selected in the Competitive Balance B-Round by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Texas Tech... received a \$1.2 million signing bonus, over the \$1 million slot value for the No. 66 overall selection... Competitive Balance Round B pick was acquired as part of the Dodgers' February 2020 trade with the Minnesota Twins

YANKEES GOT HIM: Was ranked by MLB.com as the Dodgers' No. 15 prospect at the 2022 Trade Deadline in August... traded by the Dodgers to the New York Yankees for LF Joey Gallo at the Trade Deadline on Aug. 2, 2022... was assigned to Double-A Somerset upon the trade... was a Rangers and Gallo fan growing up

TJ TIME: Had Tommy John surgery in December 2017 before his first season at Texas Tech and a follow-up arthroscopic elbow procedure seven months later

FUTURE FARMHAND: Was one of two Yankees prospects selected to the All-Star Futures Game in Seattle. The righty tossed just nine pitches, five for strikes, to record two outs in the seventh. He got San Diego's Jackson Merrill to ground out and recorded a strikeout against Jackson Chourio. Chourio is the #3 ranked prospect in all of MiLB according to MLB Pipeline, while Merrill stands at #10.

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS: Led the Red Raiders' 2019 College World Series semifinalists with eight saves and dominating in four starts as a redshirt sophomore, was a Freshman All-American in 2019 after recording a team-high eight saves in 20 appearances, where he owned a 3.20 ERA and 39 strikeouts

CAREER:

• **2023:** In Beeter's second start of the season (55th career game) on 4/14 @BNG, he earned his first professional win with a career-high 6.2 IP. Split the 2023 season with Double-A Somerset (12GS) and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (15G/14GS), combining to go 9-7 with a 3.62 ERA (131.2IP, 105H, 54R/53ER, 75BB, 165K, 18HR) in 27 games (26 starts)... among Yankees farmhands, ranked 2nd in strikeouts, 3rd in starts and 4th in wins, innings pitched and opponents' batting average (.216)... his 165K also ranked eighth among all minor league pitchers... Began the season with Double-A Somerset, going 6-2 with a 2.08 ERA (60.2IP, 44H, 14R/ER, 31BB, 76K, 3HR) in 12 starts... was named the Eastern League's "Pitcher of the Week" from 6/5-11 after going 2-0 and tossing a combined 11.0 scoreless innings over two starts at Hartford on 6/6 and 6/11 (6H, 4BB, 17K, 3HP)... Was selected to the 2023 SiriusXM Futures Game... Was promoted to Triple-A SWB on 6/23 and went 3-5 with a 4.94 ERA (71.0IP, 61H, 40R/39ER, 44BB, 89K, 15HR) in 15 games (14 starts)... Had a career high 13K on 9/14 vs BUF... Was named an Eastern League Postseason All-Star... Was added to the 40-man roster on 11/14

• **2022:** Spent the beginning of his second season with the Dodgers in Double-A Tulsa making 18 appearances (16 GS), continuing to serve primarily as an opener, working no more than 4 IP in any of his starts, posting an 0-3 record with a 5.75 ERA and 15.33 K/9 IP. Beeter was acquired by the Yankees from the Dodgers hours before the 2022 MLB trade deadline on August 2 as the lone piece received in exchange for outfielder Joey Gallo. At the time of the trade, Beeter was ranked the Dodgers' No. 21 prospect by Baseball America, which credited him with having the Best Curveball in the Dodgers MiLB system. Beeter made his Yankees organizational debut with Double-A Somerset on 8/10/22, pitching three scoreless innings in which he posted six strikeouts and allowed only one baserunner (BB). In seven starts to end the season with Somerset, he posted a 2.13 ERA over 25.1 IP with 41 K and 11 BB (14.57 K/9 IP). Across his 7 GS with Somerset to end 2022, Beeter set and matched a new career-high 9 K on 8/27/22 vs. NH and 9/3/22 @BNG. Over this stretch, he also set a new career high in IP three different times, including in his lone postseason start on 9/22/22 vs. POR. He allowed 2 R (1 ER) • **2021:** Made his pro debut in 2021 and posted a 3.44 ERA between High-A Great Lakes and Double-A Tulsa, working mostly as an opener, going no more than 3.1 IP in any outing
