SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost their road trip finale to the Hartford Yard Goats, 6-3, at Dunkin Donuts Park. David Villar put the Flying Squirrels on top, 1-0, in the first with a solo homer, his 10th of the year. Hartford tied the game in the bottom of the first with a solo homer by Taylor Snyder. In the sixth, Richmond went back in front, 3-1, with a two-run home run by **Sandro Fabian.** Hartford evened the score again in the bottom of the sixth with RBI hits by Snyder and Coco Montes. In the eighth, Willie Abreu brought in the go-ahead run with a sac fly and Matt McLaughin added a two-run double to extend the Yard Goats' advantage to 6-3.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the first of a six-game series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. This series marks the only trip to The Diamond for the Rumble Ponies this year. The Flying Squirrels play in Binghamton from August 31-September 5.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won four of the last six games. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 4.0 games behind first-place Bowie and Erie. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .233 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 3.76 ERA for the season

THE RUMBLE PONIES have won back-to-back games after dropping their previous three. Over their last 13 games, Binghamton has gone 4-9. The Rumble Ponies started the season 0-10 before picking up their first win on May 16 against Altoona. They lost seven of the next eight to begin the year with a 2-17 record through May 26. For the year, the Rumble Ponies are ranked eighth in the Double-A Northeast with a .235 batting average. The Binghamton pitching staff is ranked 10th in the league with a 5.41 ERA this year. Binghamton's roster includes five of MLB.com's top-30 New York Mets prospects, including 3B Mark Vientos (8), RHP Ryley Gilliam (16), 2B/OF Carlos Cortes (17), RHP Oscar De La Cruz (23) and OF Jake Mangum (30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Phil Pfeifer makes his fourth start. He last pitched on Wednesday at Hartford. In that start, he allowed three runs, all in the first inning with two outs, before throwing a scoreless outing over his final 3.1 innings of work. He began the year with Triple-A Sacramento, going 0-3 with an 11.25 ERA in five relief appearances. He signed with the Giants as a minor league free agent in March. Pfeifer was originally drafted by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the third round in 2015 out of Vanderbilt before being traded to the Atlanta Braves in 2016.

FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Troy Miller makes his second start with the Rumble Ponies and his fifth overall appearance in the Double-A Northeast this year. He last pitched on Wednesday in his Binghamton debut at Reading, working 5.1 innings and allowing five runs in a loss. Miller was originally signed as a non-drafted free agent by the Toronto Blue Jays in 2018 out of the University of Michigan. He spent the 2019 season as a starter for Low-A Lansing, where he went 6-8 with a 4.81 ERA. He began this season with High-A Vancouver and made three starts, posting a 2-0 record with a 1.84 ERA before a promotion to Double-A New Hampshire. With the Fisher Cats, he pitched in four games (three starts), going 1-2 with a 7.20 ERA before being traded to the Mets on June 19.

TOASTY: Over his last 18 games since June 6, Frankie Tostado is batting .343 (23-for-67) with four homers, five doubles and 19 RBIs. He is now first on the team this season with 29 RBIs. He is also first among qualified Richmond batters with a .288 batting average on the year. On Friday, Tostado recorded a season-high four hits and became the first Richmond player this year to record five RBIs in a single game, and he clubbed a go-ahead, two-run homer with two outs in the ninth. On Saturday, he mashed a go-ahead, two-run homer in the ninth inning for the second straight game

FABULOUS FABIAN: Over his last 20 games since June 1, Sando Fabian is batting .344 (21-for-61) with three homers, six doubles and 16 RBIs while scoring eight runs. He hit a two-run homer in the series finale at Hartford on Sunday, his fifth longball of the season. Fabian hit .184 through his first 18 games of the season, but his performance since June 1 has raised his season average to .273.

BREAKING OUT: After going 0-for-14 over four games from June 10-15, David Villar has hit .405 (17-for-42) with five homers and 10 RBIs over his last 11 games since June 16. In the last series against Hartford, Villar hit three homers. Entering play today, he has homered in each of his last two games.

SIMON SAYS: Simon Whiteman started his Double-A career 0-for-17 in his first four games from June 15-18 after being promoted from High-A Richmond. In his last eight games since June 19, Whiteman is batting .344 (11-for-32) with nine singles and two doubles. In that stretch, he has collected multiple hits in five games, including a Double-A-high three singles on Friday night. Since joining the Flying Squirrels, Whiteman has picked up six stolen bases, which is tied for the team lead this season.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 26-22 record is tied for the best start in team history through 48 games, even with the start in the franchise's inaugural season in 2010. That year, the team posted a 27-22 mark through 49 games.

LAW OF AVERAGES: The 12 teams in the Double-A Northeast have combined to hit .242 this season. In 2019, the Eastern League combined for a .238 batting average, which was the lowest for the circuit since a .234 mark in 1971 and the sixth-lowest since the league was first classified as "Double-A" in 1963.

PITCHERS WHO RAKE: For the season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Double-A Northeast with six RBIs by pitchers at the plate. Flying Squirrels pitchers have eight hits this year, which is tied for first in the league with Reading. On the year, Richmond has gone 23-13 (.639) against National League affiliates, but have gone 3-9 (.333) against affiliates of American League clubs. Pitchers returned to the batter's box for last week's set against Hartford and continue to hit this week against Binghamton. After July 4, the Flying Squirrels will return to using the DH for the remaining four series in July.

GOING FOR GOLD: Flying Squirrels manager José Alguacil is currently away from the team for a second time this season to manage his home country, Venezuela, in the final WBSC Olympic Qualifier in Puebla, Mexico. Venezuela lost to the Dominican Republic in its first game of the tournament last Tuesday, 10-7. The team rebounded for a 9-3 win over the Netherlands on Wednesday night. On Friday, Venezuela beat the Netherlands, 10-0, to advance to the finals against the Dominican Republic. The Dominican Republic won that game will secure a spot in the Olympics later this summer in Tokyo, Japan. Flying Squirrels fundamentals coach Gary Davenport is handling the Flying Squirrels' managerial duties during Alguacil's absence

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America*'s Top-30 Giants prospects: Heliot Ramos (3), Tristan Beck (12), Sean Hjelle (13) and Jose Marte (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Four players, Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Beck (20) and Caleb Kilian (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
