Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fourth in a six-game series at the South Bend Cubs, High-A affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. These are the only six meetings between the two teams this season. Today is the tenth game and 11th day of the Lugnuts' 12-game, 13-day road trip, wrapping up the 2022 road schedule.

Starting Matchup: Coming off an 11-K gem in six innings at Wisconsin last week, right-hander Kyle Virbitsky makes his sixth Lugnuts start, taking on Cubs' No. 29 prospect Kohl Franklin in his 22nd start for South Bend.

(Adam Jaksa was in Stillwater, Okla., watching the Central Michigan Chippewas battle gamely in a 58-42 loss to the OSU Cowboys.)

Last Night: Cubs 3, Lugnuts 1. Right-hander Joey Estes turned in his third quality start and second straight quality start on the road, but Jordan Nwogu delivered a game-tying RBI grounder and tie-breaking RBI single to lift the Cubs to their third straight win in the series.

On Deck: The Nuts play the Cubs through Sunday, followed by a six-game homestand with the Dayton Dragons at Jackson Field to end the 132-game Midwest League season.

With a Win Today... the Lugnuts would notch their 1800th win as a franchise and halt a four-game losing streak.

Today's Transaction: Infielder Alexander Campos was placed on the Injured List and catcher Hansen López was reinstated from the Covid IL.

Nailbiters: 11 out of the last 15 Lugnuts' road games have been decided by two runs or fewer, including the first three games of this series; Lansing has a record of 7-4 in those games, albeit 0-3 at South Bend.

#### **Organizational Report:**

- At the Major League level, the Athletics lost in a walk-off at Washington, 7-5, with Joey Meneses hitting a three-run game-winning homer off Norge Ruiz, who made four appearances for the Lugnuts in 2021. The game featured the MLB debuts of Ken Waldichuk and former Great Lakes Loons outfielder Cody Thomas.
- In Triple-A, the Aviators beat Reno, 5-4, behind a starting lineup of Kevin Smith (2018 Lugnut), Jordan Díaz (2021) and William Simoneit (2021). Garrett Acton (2021) fired 1 1/3 scoreless innings in relief.
- In Double-A, the RockHounds lost in a tight one, 22-5, to Arkansas. Outfielder Shane Selman (2021) pitched the ninth inning and allowed seven runs on six hits and three walks via 41 pitches. Trayson Kubo (2022) preceded Selman on the mound and turned in two scoreless innings in his Midland debut, striking out three.
- In Single-A, the Ports lost to San Jose, 10-3. Stevie Emanuels (2021-2022) started the game, allowing four runs (three earned) on five hits and five walks in 5 1/3 innings, striking out four.

- Since Phil is a native of Cooperstown, the National Baseball Hall of Fame is following his career closely. His gameworn Lugnuts baseball cap from the season's first weekend was sent to the Hall

To the Show: Ten former Nuts have debuted in MLB this year, namely A's pitchers **Norge Ruiz** (2021), **Zach Logue** (2018) and **Zach Jackson** (2017) and infielder **Christian Lopes** (2013); Jays utilityman Vinny Capra (2018), catcher Gabriel Moreno (2019) and pitcher Max Castillo (2018); M's reliever Danny Young (2016); Red Sox pitcher Josh Winckowski (2019) and Marlins pitcher Jake Fishman (2017).

Skipper for the Series: When Phil Pohl went on scheduled vacation from August 16-21 vs. Great Lakes; Veronica Alvarez stepped in as interim Lugnuts manager through Sunday. A standout at Villanova, Alvarez served as the starting catcher for Team USA Baseball Women's National Team, winning medals in 2008 (bronze), 2010 (bronze), 2012 (silver) and 2015 (gold). She joined the Team USA's coaching staff as assistant coach in 2018, rising to manager of the Women's National Team beginning in 2019, when she led Team USA to a 7-0 record and the gold medal at the Women's Baseball World Cup Qualifier in Mexico, earning her the honor of 2019 USA Baseball Rod Dedeaux Coach of the Year. Since 2019, she has worked as a coach in Spring Training for the Athletics. Alvarez went 2-4 with the Nuts against the Loons.

Inside the Park and Out of This World: On August 2-3, 2022, CF Denzel Clarke joined Fred Bello (Everett, July 2-3, 2010) as the only Minor Leaguers since 2005 to have inside-the-park home runs in back-to-back games. The feat has never occurred in the Majors.

### **Today in Lugnuts History**

2015: Rehabbing Blue Jays ace Marcus Stroman pitched 4 2/3 hitless scoreless innings, striking out seven and walking one, but the Great Lakes Loons rallied for seven runs with two outs in the ninth, including a three-run homer by Justin Chigbogu ("shi-BAH-goo") to hand the Lugnuts a 7-4 loss. **2019:** In the final game of the Lugnuts' 24th season, Sean Wymer tossed an

85-pitch (63 strikes) nine-inning complete game and Yorman Rodriguez, Otto Lopez and Griffin Conine all hit solo home runs in a 3-1 victory at Fort Wayne. The game lasted two hours and 14 minutes. Wymer allowed four singles, one run, one walk and two HBPs with two strikeouts

**Welcome Back!** After joining the Nuts directly after signing last year as the Athletics' 17th-round selection and making seven appearances, three starts, the towering Virbitsky rejoined the Lugnuts after excelling in Stockton's rotation, replacing the demoted Stevie Emanuels... limited the Great Lakes Loons to an Imanol Vargas solo homer in his 2022 Lansing debut on July 29th, whiffing six in five innings.

Last start: August 27 at Wisconsin. Whiffed 11 in six innings, tying the Lugnuts' season high as set previously by Blake Beers and Jeff Criswell in May... strikeouts by inning: one in the 1st, two in the 2nd, two in the 3rd, one in the 4th (when the Rattlers scored two runs), three in the 5th, two in the 6th... 96 pitches, 65 strikes.

**The Strikeouts Mean More:** Kyle has partnered with the Pediatric Brain Tumor Foundation Vs. Cancer program (#GoHead2Head to #CancelChildhoodCancer), raising money with every strikeout he records in September.

**Turning Pro:** Virbitsky's first time being drafted was in 2021, taken 518th overall by the Oakland Athletics... signed for \$50,000... also from Penn State: Mike Scioscia, David Aardsma, and Hall of Famer John "Monte" Montgomery Ward... both of Kyle's parents attended Penn State.

Glory Days: Attended Episcopal Academy, where he pitched against Dayton's Michael Siani (William Penn Charter School), who also was the first player faced as a pro (Siani tripled)... named a Top-25 baseball player in Pennsylvania by PennLive.com... 2016 Perfect Game Underclass high honorable mention... 2017 Rawlings-Perfect Game honorable mention All-America... as a junior, posted 1.76 ERA with 66 strikeouts while hitting three home runs... as a senior was named Team MVP of the Episcopal baseball team, honored as the No. 8 right-handed pitcher in Pennsylvania by Perfect Game... also named Team MVP of the Episcopal football team (tight end and defensive lineman), and was honored as first-team all-league and all-area at TE and DL.
