PAPILLION, NEB. – The Storm Chasers closed out the series win and took five of six games against the Clippers with a 7-5 win Sunday afternoon at Werner Park.

- ✦ In the final game of the series, the Chasers continued their dominance on the offensive side as **Ryan Fitzgerald** got the bottom of the second inning rolling with a single to left center field, then scored on a double from **Tyler Gentry ... Brian O'Keefe** hit a double of his own to plate Gentry and extend the lead out to 2-0.
- ✦ While Storm Chasers starter **Luis Cessa** cruised through 4.0 scoreless innings, the Clippers took their first lead of the day in the top of the 5th inning as **Micah Pries** singled in a run ... then, **José Tena** crushed a three-run home run to move Columbus ahead to 4-2 ... Omaha answered back in the bottom of the 5th with a two-run homer to right field from **Nick Pratto**, his seventh long ball of the year to tie the game 4-4.
- ✦ Cessa fired a pair of 1-2-3 frames over 4.2 innings of work, with 3 strikeouts but was relieved with left-hander **Austin Cox** with 2 outs in the 5th inning, after the go-ahead Clippers homer ... Columbus retook the lead off Cox in the top of the sixth inning with a **Daniel Schneemann** solo home run to right center field that made the score 5-4.
- ✦ After **John McMillon** worked a perfect top of the seventh inning with two strikeouts, Omaha surged ahead in the bottom half to take a lead for good, allowing McMillon to earn his first win of the year ... Fitzgerald connected for his first triple of the season to drive in **CJ Alexander** and **Logan Porter** for 6-5 lead favor of the Chasers ... with Fitzgerald at third, O'Keefe drove him in on a sacrifice fly to left field and extend the lead to 7-5, which held to be final.
- ✦ **Dan Altavilla** took the reins in the top of the 8th inning and kept Omaha up by two runs with a scoreless inning, allowing just one hit in the eighth before recording the first out of the top of the 9th and giving way to left-hander **Evan Sisk** for the final two outs ... Sisk recorded his first save of the year with and retired the final two batters of the game to secure Omaha's fifth straight win.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

IN GOOD STANDINGS

- Omaha's enters today's game in 1st place in the 20-team International League and a season-high 17 games over .500 at 33-15 (.688)
- ✦ Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .688 winning percentage is the 2nd-best, trailing the Clearwater Threshers (32-13 / .711 / Phillies Single-A) ... 33 wins are tied with the Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Houston Triple-A) for the most in the Minors.
- ✦ 19 wins in the month of May is the most of any team Minor League Baseball, just ahead of the 18-5 Cedar Rapids Kernels (Minnesota High-A).

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

- Omaha has won 5 straight series and 19 of its last 23 games... 17 of those 23 games have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 14 of the team's 19 wins in this stretch.
- ✦ After Omaha's relievers had just 4 saves in the first 26 games, 12 of the 19 wins have had a save awarded, the most saves of any team in the Minors in May... **Will Klein** has 5 saves in that span, **Walter Pennington** has 2, **Steven Cruz** and **Evan Sisk** each have 1.
- ✦ In total, 34 of Omaha's 48 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or fewer (71%), including 12 of 15 losses this season ... 11 of 23 games in the month of May have been 1-run games, Omaha is 8-3 in games decided by just one run this month.

COMEBACK KINGS

- 4 of Omaha's 5 wins last week were comeback victories, something the team has become accustomed to this year.
- ✦ The Storm Chasers have trailed at some point in 16 of their 33 wins this season (48%), including 9 of 19 wins in the month of May and 4 of last week's 5 wins.
- ✦ 4 times, Omaha has overcome a 4-run deficit to go on and win the game and trailed for as much as half the game (4.5 innings) but still won 8 times.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

- Omaha has outscored its opponents 293 to 223 this season, a +70 run differential.
- ✦ A +70 run differential ranks as not just best in the International League, but the top mark at the Triple-A level and tied 4th in Minor League Baseball ... Modesto leads all Minor League teams at +102 (300 to 198).
- ✦ Omaha has had a positive run differential after 41 of 48 games this year, including 39 straight games, since April 9.

YOU CAN COUNT ON ME

- Two factors contributing to Omaha's success this season include the starting pitchers going deep into games and the offense providing their starters run support.
- ✦ When Omaha's starter can get through at least 5.0 innings this year, the team has a 17-3 record, compared to 15-13 when starters don't make it through the 5th inning.
- ✦ When the offense can provide 3+ runs of support, the Storm Chasers are 22-4, while the team is just 11-12 when the offense offers 2 runs of support or less to the starter.
- ✦ Omaha starters have gone 7-0 in May, the only Triple-A starting rotation without a loss.

RELIEF AID

- Omaha's bullpen remains one of the best in the International League and even across the entire Triple-A level.
- ✦ The two longest scoreless streaks (by games pitched) in the International League this are active streaks from Omaha pitchers ... **Dan Altavilla** and **Evan Sisk** have each not allowed a run over their last 11 games, 11.2 IP for Altavilla and 9.2 IP for Sisk.
