LOGAN AND THE HENDERSON'S: Logan Henderson will make his first start for Nashville since May 8th against the Norfolk Tides. His last three starts were for the Brewers and he went 2-0 with a 1.80 ERA and had 20 strikeouts to just five walks...Through his first four career MLB starts, Henderson is 3-0 and allowed four runs and has 29 strikeouts...With the Sounds this year, Henderson has won each of his last five games and owns a 1.04 ERA over his last five Triple-A games dating back to April 3rd. Over the stretch, he has allowed 12 hits and three runs in 26.0 IP with 32 strikeouts and eight walks.

MAY RECAP: The Sounds posted the fourth-most wins in the International League during the month of May with a 16-11 record. As a pitching staff, the Sounds owned the second-best team ERA in the IL at 3.60...Indianapolis took over the top spot with their 3.48 ERA in part by holding the Sounds to nine runs during the three-game slide to end the month. Nashville had the second-most triples hit as a team with 13 (Toledo, 18) and were third as a team with 51 stolen bases behind Jacksonville (55) and Lehigh Valley (53). The Sounds .257 AVG was 11th in the IL and the 18 home runs were tied for the 18th. **Anthony Seigler** led the International League in AVG (.386), OBP (.506), OPS (1.177), and was T-1st in triples (3). He also finished the month second in SLG (.671) and T-4th in SB (9) along with **Adam Hall**. **Oliver Dunn** ended the month T-2nd in the league for the most doubles (8)... **Jesus Liranzo** had three saves to finish tied for the third most in the IL behind Gwinnett's Wander Suero (5) and Charlotte's Dan Altavilla (4).

ANOTHER JORGE HOMER: Jorge Alfaro joined Jared Oliva as the only other player to homer in consecutive games multiple times for the Sounds this season. Alfaro also had back-to-back games with a home run on April 19-20 on the road in Charlotte. Alfaro is now in a four-way tie for the second-most home runs in the International League with 11. Lehigh Valley's Otto Kemp leads the league with 12 home runs this year.

ROUND TRIP ROSARIO: Eddie Rosario extended his hitting streak to six games with his solo home run in the top of the fourth inning. It was the second Nashville home run for Rosario in 11 games since joining the Sounds. Through his first 11 games, Rosario is hitting .317 (13-for-41) with three doubles to go along with his two round trippers and he has eight RBI. In 25 total Triple-A games in 2025 he is hitting .330 with four homers and nine doubles and has a SLG of .540 with a .945 OPS between his time with Nashville and Oklahoma City.

THOSE BOOTS: The nine walks issued by Nashville matched a season-high, something they have now done three times in 2025. The six walks issued by Jacob Misiorowski tie his single-game career-high. He also had six walks on July 23, 2024, when he was with Double-A Biloxi. The six walks are the most by a Sounds pitcher since Tyler Woessner also had six on May 8, 2024, on the road in Durham.

DON'T CRY BECAUSE IT'S OVER: After an 0-for-3 day at the plate, Anthony Seigler saw his 16-game hitting streak come to an end. It was the third-longest streak by a Nashville player over the last three-plus seasons. Estuary Ruiz was the last player to have a 17-game hitting streak for Nashville when he did it from August 10-28, 2022. Seigler posted five multi-hit games during his 16-game streak that began on May 2nd, including his single-game career-high four hits that he had in Wednesday night's win.

HAMMER AND NEL: Raynel Delgado had his 11th multi-hit game of the season on Thursday, tying Jared Oliva for the most on the team in 2025. Seven of those 11 multi-hit games have come in the month of May for Delgado who is hitting .316 (25-for-79) with five doubles, a triple, 14 RBI, and seven runs scored in his 23 games played this month.

ELVIS IN THE BUILDING: RHP Elvis Peguero earned his second save of the season and struck out all three Indianapolis batters he faced in the bottom of the ninth inning on Wednesday night. The right-hander has now pitched seven straight games with Nashville without allowing an earned run dating back to April 24th. Over the span he has allowed three hits in 8.0 IP with nine strikeouts. Eight of the nine appearances he has for the Sounds this season have come without an earned run charged to him. His three strikeouts are tied for the most he has had in a game with Nashville so far this year. He also struck out three over 2.0 IP back on April 24th when his no earned runs streak began.

- Currently ranked as the no. 12-ranked prospect in the Brewers top 30...no. 2-ranked RHP behind Jacob Misiorowski.
- Made his Major League debut in 2025 and tossed a quality start in his first career start (6.0 IP, 3 H, ER, HR, 9 K, BB) against the Athletics...Through first four MLB starts is 3-0 with a 1.71 ERA (14 H, 4 ER, 29 K, 6 BB)...One of two MLB pitchers since 1901 to have struck out at least 29 and allowed four or fewer runs through first four MLB starts...Joined fellow Brewer Freddy Peralta (per Brewers' beat writer Curt Hogg).
- Got a late start to his 2024 season after injuring his oblique during the 2024 Spring Breakout Game...Made his season debut on May 9th in the Arizona Complex League.
- Earned Southern League Pitcher of the Month as well as Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Month in June 2024 after going 4-0 with a 1.66 ERA in four starts...Held opposing hitter to a .192 AVG and matched his single-game career-high with 10 strikeouts in two of his outings (6/15 vs. TEN and 6/28 vs. PNS).
- From the time of his first start with High-A Wisconsin on May 24th until he was promoted to Nashville (8/8) he led the Brewers farm system with his 78 strikeouts.
- Made his Triple-A debut on August 9th and allowed one run on three hits over 4.0 IP but took the loss...Tossed a quality start in his second game vs. DUR (6.0 IP, 0 R, 8 K, 3 H).
- Finished the 2024 season 8th in the Milwaukee farm system in strikeouts (104) and was T-8th in wins (7)...Added to the Brewers 40-man roster on November 19th. 35.2% strikeout rate was fourth best among 661 minor leaguers with at least 70.0 IP in 2023.
- Missed the majority of 2022 after undergoing non-Tommy John elbow surgery in the spring.
- Pitched one season at McLennan CC in Texas and was named NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year after going 10-2 with a 1.66 ERA in 17 games (14 GS)...Led NJCAA DI in strikeouts (169) and IP (97.2)...Struck out 17 over 8.0 IP with one run allowed to guide the Highlanders to their first championship since 1983.
