NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.

- Of 12 series played this season, Omaha has won 5, lost 6 and split 1 ... the Storm Chasers have lost their last 3 series, with a 5-14 record over their last 19 games.
- Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... with a 13-14 record in May, the Storm Chasers were one win away from having a winning record in back-to-back months for the first time since July and August 2024.
- Omaha has been under .500 following 43 of their last 44 games (since April 24) and the Storm Chasers have spent just 18 days at or above .500.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Storm Chasers have 18 comeback wins this season, while Omaha also has blown a lead in 20 losses.

- 18 comeback wins are tied for 7th-most in the International League, tied 10th in Triple-A ... 20 blown leads are tied for 3rd-most in the league, tied 6th in Triple-A.
- The Storm Chasers have led at some point in 8 of their last 14 losses, including 3 games where the team led for over half the game.
- In the last 34 games (since May 9), Omaha is 15-19 ... they have trailed at some point in 11 of 15 wins and led at some point in 10 of 19 losses, meaning 21 of Omaha's last 34 games have been a comeback win for one of the two teams ... in this stretch, 10 of 15 wins have been decided by 3 runs or less, while 13 of 19 losses have been decided by 3 runs or less ... 12 of the 34 games have been decided by 1 run, including 5 straight 1-run losses in a 7-game span May 31 to June 7.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Today, the Storm Chasers play a doubleheader against St. Paul, Omaha's 5th twin-bill of 2026 and the Saints' 3rd.

- The Chasers played two doubleheaders in April and two in May ... their last doubleheader was May 9 @ Indianapolis when the two teams split the day.
- Omaha is a combined 5-3 across the four doubleheaders this season, winning the twin-bill April 10 @ Iowa and splitting the other three ... this is Omaha's 2nd doubleheader against the Saints, having previously played one August 30, 2024

HERE WE GO AGAIN

Omaha's last series win came at CHS Field, taking 4 of 6 from St. Paul from May 19 to 24 ... the Chasers' 10 steals that week remain a season-best for a series, though the bullpen's 8.26 ERA (26 ER/28.1 IP) is the highest in any series this year.

- All four top performers from the May series remain active ... **Brett Squires** led the club that week with 17 total bases (7-for-22, .318 AVG, 5 XBH, 6 RBI) ... **Gavin Cross** hit .381 (8-for-21, 4 XBH, 4 RBI) ... **Luca Tresh** went 8-for-20 (.400) with 5 RBI ... **Josh Rojas** matched Squires with 6 RBI, going 7-for-21 (.333) with 4 XBH.
- This is Omaha's 12th series at CHS Field since 2021 and the 4th time in 6 seasons making multiple road trips to St. Paul ... the Chasers have 3 series wins, 2 series losses and 5 splits in the previous 10 weeklong series ... this also marks just the 4th time since joining the IL in 2021 that Omaha has visited the same road city twice within 30 days (of 79 total road trips), the 3rd time they've done so with St. Paul.

RELIEF RELIANCE

Omaha's bullpen has been heavily used this season, especially of recent.

- 343.0 innings from Omaha's bullpen this year are the 6th-most of any International League team, with 249.1 innings from the starters also ranking as the 4th-fewest in the league ... only 4 wins from Storm Chasers starting pitchers are the fewest at the Triple-A level, tied for the 7th-fewest in the Minors.
- Omaha's relievers threw a season-high 40.1 innings last week, with the starting pitchers offering a season-low 16.2 innings.

YOU GO, WE GO, LUGO

Matthew Lugo has seen significant success at the plate since joining Omaha.

- Since the Royals claimed Lugo off waivers from the Angels on June 2, the outfielder has hit .342 (13-for-38) with 8 extra-base hits and 15 RBI ... his 1.144 OPS since June 2 (min. 35 PA) ranks 7th in the International League.
- Last week, Lugo drove in 13 runs over 6 games against Las Vegas ... his 13 RBI in 7 games since June 9 are tied 4th-most in the International League in that stretch.

TODAY'S START

- ✓ Bailey Falter is making his **1st start with the Storm Chasers** this year, his **11th appearance with Omaha** and his **16th overall appearance** in 2026.
- ✓ Playing his **12th professional season** this year, the Royals are his 3rd MLB organization ... has played parts of 6 Major League seasons with Philadelphia (2021-23), Pittsburgh (2023-25) and Kansas City (2025-26).
- ✓ Falter will be making his 1st start against the Saints but 7th appearance against a Twins affiliate ... he's faced Fort Myers 5 times in his career and made one relief appearance against Minnesota in the Major Leagues.

THE FALTER FILES

- ✓ **GETTING BACK ON TRACK:** Falter made the Royals' Opening Day roster and pitched in 2 games before he landed on Kansas City's injured list (*left elbow inflammation*) ... he appeared in 9 games with Omaha on a rehab assignment, but pitched to a 14.21 ERA (10 ER in 6.1 IP) in 3 games after returning to Kansas City and was subsequently designated for assignment and sent outright to the Minors.
- ✓ **TRIPLE-A TALENT:** Falter pitched in 9 games for the Storm Chasers while on a rehab assignment from April 15 to May 14 ... he struggled in his first game, but in the next 8 (April 19 to May 14), he worked a 1.46 ERA (2 ER in 12.1 IP) and ended his rehab stint with 3 straight scoreless appearances.
- ✓ **STARTER'S ORDERS:** Falter has primarily been used as a starter since his **2015** professional debut, totaling 189 starts between the Major and Minor Leagues compared to 47 relief appearances ... 74 of his first 75 minor league outings were starts (**2015-19**), as were 106 of 116 combined MLB and MiLB appearances from **2022-25** ... after making just 1 start in 22 MLB outings in **2021**, he returned to a starting role in **2022** ... Kansas City used him as a starter in his first 2 appearances after the trade from Pittsburgh before shifting him to the bullpen ... his 3 MLB appearances in **2026** came in relief ahead of a pair of opener starts prior to his DFA.

LAST OUTING: FRIDAY, JUNE 12 vs. LAS VEGAS
