#### **BOLAÑOS LEADS SHRIMP TO SHUTOUT**

Ronald Bolaños tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and Peyton Burdick and Paul McIntosh each homered on Thursday to lead Jacksonville to a 6-0 blanking of Charlotte, Burdick's bomb opened up the scoring in the second inning. The Jumbo Shrimp added a pair of runs in the fifth inning, highlighted by Santiago Chavez's RBI double before McIntosh launched a solo shot in a two-run sixth. Xavier Edwards' RBI single in the eighth capped the scoring at 6-0. Jacksonville recorded its first shutout of the season

Jacksonville led the International League with 12 shutout victories in 2022. However, heading into play on Thursday, 82 games into the season, the Jumbo Shrimp remained one of two teams (Charlotte) in the league without blanking an opponent. That changed following a stellar performances from Ronald Bolaños, who fired 6.0 scoreless frames, Zack Leban. who pitched 2.0 scoreless innings, and Richard Rodriguez, who needed just six pitches for a perfect ninth inning. Through 82 games in 2022, the Jumbo Shrimp had already recorded six shutouts. The 2023 campaign marked the latest in a season it took for a Jacksonville club to record their first shutout since at least 2005.

#### AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 38 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 39-for-131 (.298/.374/.710/1.084) at the plate with nine doubles, 15 home runs, 35 RBIs and 26 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season. Allen is fanning just 18.4 percent of the time in 2023.

#### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Despite a 6-0 win over Charlotte on Thursday, eight of Jacksonville's last 12 games have been decided by three runs or fewer. Of the Jumbo Shrimp's 83 games played thus far in 2023, 46 have been decided by these slim margins. Jacksonville is 22-24 (.478) in these contests this season, but they excelled in them during an 80-69 2022 campaign, going 44-38 (.537). In 2021, when the club went 75-55, Jacksonville was 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three

#### NINTH TIME'S A CHARM!

After falling in the first two games of their series at Memphis on May 2-3, Jacksonville rallied to win the series, taking the final four games. After that, though, the Jumbo Shrimp lost four consecutive sets before finally splitting a pair of series with Nashville and Memphis. They then lost four of six at Gwinnett before splitting their series with Durham last week. Thus, Jacksonville has gone eight sets in a row without a series win, their longest drought since June 11-August 11, 2015, when they went 12 consecutive series' without a win in what turned out to be a 57-81 (.413) campaign.

#### ON THE OFFENSIVE

Heading into play on Friday, Jacksonville has scored at least five runs in seven consecutive contests, their best such run of the season, and in nine of their last 10 games. Over this 10-game stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored 68 runs (6.8 per game), tied for sixth in the International League. while batting .285/.377/.477/.854, figures that respectively rank seventh, ninth, ninth and ninth. Over the season's first 73 games, Jacksonville's 347 runs (4.8 per game) ranked 19th in the 20-team circuit. The club collectively batted just .247/.331/.404/.735, which placed 18th, 20th, 18th and 20th, respectively.

#### X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 28 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 44-for-114 at the plate, slashing .386/.421/.500/.921 with four doubles, three home runs, 17 RBIs and 21 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to second in the International League in batting average (.354) and ninth in on-base percentage (.426). Among the 265 players in the IL this season with at least 100 plate appearances, Edwards ranks second in swingingstrike rate (3.6 percent).
