JOHNSTON HOMERS IN 4-1 JACKSONVILLE WIN

Troy Johnston homered for the second day in a row and the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp bested the Gwinnett Stripers 4-1 in front of 6.545 fans at 121 Financial Ballpark, With Gwinnett (44-56, 11-14) ahead 1-0. Paul McIntosh singled to lead off the bottom of the third. After a strikeout, Jake Mangum lashed a base hit. Jacob Amaya then laced a tworun double down the left field line off Stripers starter Max Fried (0-2) to give Jacksonville a 2-1 advantage they would not relinguish. The score remained that way until the sixth when Xavier Edwards bunted for a single and Johnston launched a two-run homer to widen the gap 4-1.

X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 43 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 66-for-181 at the plate. slashing .365/.409/.475/.884 with six doubles, one triple. four home runs, 26 RBIs and 38 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to second in the International League in batting average (.348) and eighth in OBP (.417). Among the 296 players in the IL this season with at least 100 plate appearances. Edwards ranks tied for third in swinging-strike rate (4.0 percent).

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 50 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 51-for-175 (.291/.371/.663/1.034) at the plate with 12 doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 48 RBIs and 34 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season, Allen is fanning just 20.3 percent of the time in 2023.

FOUR SCORE AND 16 SERIES AGO

With a 4-1 win against Gwinnett Saturday night, Jacksonville is one win away from their first series win at 121 Financial Ballpark since a 3-2 series win against Nashville (April 18-23). The Jumbo Shrimp have only won two series since May (May 2-7 at Memphis & July 4-9 at Charlotte), During that five-game set, Jacksonville was outscored 23-17 and outdueled on the mound. The Sounds tallied a 2.68 ERA in 43.2 IP while the Jumbo Shrimp posted a 3.72 ERA in 46.0 IP.

MAYOR MANGUM

Jake Mangum went hitless in seven of the eight games he played in from May 31-June 8, going just 1-for-24 at the plate. In the 33 games since that point, Mangum is a sizzling 45-for-132, hitting .341/.383/.455/.838 with 10 doubles, one triple, one home run, 12 RBIs and 24 runs scored. The Flowood, Miss., native has picked up 12 multi-hit games in his last 19 games, batting 33-for-88 (.375/.402/.489/.891) with seven doubles, one homer, eight RBIs and 16 runs scored during this stretch. On the season, among the 222 IL players with at least 150 plate appearances, Mangum has the fourth-highest opposite field rate (44.6 percent). His 30.2 percent line drive rate is eighth.

ODDS & ENDS

Jacksonville looked like world beaters in a six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9. The Jumbo Shrimp took five out of six games from the Knights - their most wins in a series since 2022 and outscored Charlotte by a whopping 58-28 margin. However, in the other 20 games of the second half of the season, Jacksonville is just 9-11, with all but two of those victories coming by no more than two runs. In those 11 defeats, the Jumbo Shrimp have lost by a combined 53 runs. Thus, while the club was +30 in their run differential in the Queen City, they are at -22 against their other second-half opponents (Durham, Worcester, Nashville & Gwinnett).

THE PENDULUM SWINGS

Jacksonville started their series at Nashville with strong performances from their bullpen. In the first two games against Nashville, Shrimp relievers surrendered only one run on seven hits in 11.0 innings of work, combining for 12 strikeouts against seven walks. However, things devolved quickly from there; over the next three contests, Jacksonville's relief corps combined to allow 21 runs, all earned, on 24 hits in 17.0 innings with 23 strikeouts against 12 walks. Over the last six games, the bullpen has regained its footing, firing 22.2 innings of seven-run ball, ceding nine hits and 15 walks while picking up 25 strikeouts.

SHRIMP BITES

Five of the last six home triumphs for Jacksonville have all come by one run...A win today would give the Jumbo Shrimp their first home series win since (April 18-23 vs. Nashville).
