TODAY'S GAME: The Curve open a six-game set with the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, their only meetings of the season.

LAST TIME OUT: Altoona nearly rallied for another late victory, but fell 6-4 in the series finale on Sunday night against Akron. **Aaron Shackelford** led the Curve offense with 3 hits including a 2-run homer, **Liover Peguero** added 2 hits and a walk in the defeat.

ALL-STAR SWOON: Following the four-day All-Star break, Altoona has dropped 12-of-15 games to send their season record under the .500 mark. Altoona dropped 2-of-3 in Harrisburg coming out of the break before dropping 5-of-6 in a series at Bowie and 5-of-6 in a series at PNG Field to Akron. Altoona batted 2-for-33 (.061) with runners in scoring position in their series with Akron.

SOMETHING ABOUT THE TRIPLE: **Jared Triolo** tripled three times in the Curve's series with Akron. It is the first time that the Curve have had one player triple three times in the same series since **Austin Meadows** did so in 2016 with three triples in Altoona's series with Binghamton from June 3-5. Meadows hit five triples in a four-day span, hitting two in two games in Akron before hitting three in two games against Binghamton at PNG Field.

STOLEN HEARTS: The Curve have stolen 129 bases on the season, on pace to break the franchise record of 159 (2014) with 40 games to play. Altoona is on track to have 3 players, **Liover Peguero** (21), **Jared Triolo** (20), **Andres Alvarez** (19), with 20 stolen bases for the first time since 2014 when Keon Broxton and Alen Hanson each had 25 and Drew Maggi stole 37 bases.

TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL: Altoona pitchers have surrendered 112 home runs across 64 of their 102 games played this season. Altoona allowed a home run in a season-high 8 straight games from July 26 - August 3, falling shy of the franchise record of 11 (5/19-29, 2013).

ALVY'S POP: Curve infielder **Andres Alvarez** has already set a career-high with 17 home runs and 41 RBI and on Tuesday, August 2 picked up his first career multi-homer game with two solo shots. Alvarez ranks T-10th in the EL in HR (17), 12th in SLG% (.485), 8th in OPS (.862) and T-3rd in BB (55). Alvarez recorded the 4th multi-homer game of the season on Tuesday.

SOME GOOD ARMS: **Quinn Priester** finished July with a 1.69 ERA in July, the second-lowest among all pitchers in the Eastern League with at least 25.0 IP. His 1.69 ERA ranks 7th among Double-A Pitchers in the calendar month. **Tahnaj Thomas** has tossed 10.0 scoreless innings while recording 13 strikeouts, a 0.70 WHIP and .167 batting average against in 7 outings across July.

A TREE-IDENTIFICATION WALK: After drawing just 19 walks in 42 games across April and May, INF **Jared Triolo** drew 20 walks in 25 games in June. Over his last 38 games (6/21 - Present), Triolo has a .394 on-base percentage which has raised his season OBP mark from .359 to .368. Triolo reached base safely in 19-of-23 games in July, his 55 BB are T-3rd in the EL.

NO LEAD IS SAFE: Altoona has held a lead after 5 innings in 46 of 101 games played this season and hold a 33-12 record in those games. Since May 17, the Curve are 22-3 when they hold a lead after 5 innings.

THE ARTISTS FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE B-METS: Managed by Reid Brignac, Binghamton's coaching staff features a wealth of MLB experience with Brignac (9 years), Pitching Coach Jerome Williams (11 years), Hitting Coach Tommy Joseph (2 years, plus 5 seasons in the Eastern League), and Bench Coach Mariano Duncan (12 years). The Ponies feature several top prospects according to MLB.com: SS Ronny Mauricio (#3), OF Carlos Cortes (#15), C Hayden Senger (#20), C Nick Meyer (#27) and RHP Brian Metoyer (#30).

THE FIRST PONY TO RIDE: Alex Valverde takes the ball in the series opener. Picked out of the Rays system in the minor league phase of the Rule V draft in 2021, Valverde has struck out 75 batters in 53.1 IP despite putting up a 6.04 ERA for the season. Valverde hails from Miami, FL and played at Miami-Dade CC before being picked in the 22nd round by Tampa in 2017. He attended Gulliver Prep in Miami who's most-recent big leaguer is former Dodgers RHP Paco Rodriguez (2012-15). The right-hander throws from a low-three-quarters, almost side-arm arm slot. He drops his body low when pushing off the mound, lowering his release point even further.

TODAY IN CURVE HISTORY

2005 - Jose Bautista lifts his 20th homer of the season, joining Josh Bonifay in the 20-homer department. Last pair of Curve teammates to hit 20 homers in the same season and third overall.

2009 - Yoslan Herrera improves to 9-0 with 6.1 two-run innings at New Hampshire, setting a team record for most wins to start a season and the most consecutive winning decisions. Lost next start at home against the Fisher Cats for his only loss of the season. Pedro Alvarez racks up four hits (4-5) in 6-3 win at New Hampshire

2022: Began the season as a member of the Curve rotation... Struck out a season-high 8 batters on 5/10 vs. Somerset... Became the first Curve starter to finish 6.0 innings on 5/21 vs. Richmond in the team's 38th game... Was suspended for 4 games on 5/25 stemming from Altoona's on-field disagreement with Richmond on 5/22, activated to start on 5/29 at Harrisburg... Brought a perfect game into the 5th inning on 6/4 vs. Bowie before allowing an infield single to Adam Hall, allowed back-to-back walks and an RBI double to Cesar Prieto to finish the outing... Allowed 2 HR in an outing for the first time in his career on 6/10 at Reading... Threw the 3rd immaculate inning in franchise history on 7/15 vs Richmond in the 2nd inning (Oddy Nunez, 9/4/21 and Jeff Bennett (6/7/03)... Became the first starter to work into the 8th inning on 8/3 vs Akron, allowed 1B and 2R HR to finish his outing... **Has allowed 2 HR in each of his last 3 starts...**

2021: Spent the entire season in the rotation for Low-A Bradenton and helped lead them to the Low-A East Championship... Went 5-3 with a 3.09 ERA in 22 appearances, 19 starts... **Finished the season ranked second in the Low-A Southeast and among Pirates minor leaguers with 113 strikeouts...** Bradenton's pitchers set their franchise record with 1,288 strikeouts, the ninth-most in all of minor league baseball... Started on Opening Day for the Marauders and struck out five in 3.0 innings allowing just one run... Struck out seven batters in 4.0 innings in his second start of the season on May 11 at Dunedin...
