MIGHTY MATOS: Luis Matos ended a 26-game homerless drought since July 7 at Charlotte with his two-run, go-ahead home run in the bottom of the fourth inning on Sunday. His 438-foot blast on Sunday was the second-furthest HR hit by a Nashville player this year behind Eddys Leonard (445 ft, 5/20 @ DUR) and the second-furthest tracked home run of his professional career. His furthest was a 442-foot bomb on June 15, 2024, against the Reno Aces in Reno. Sunday was the fifth home run in 65 games played for the Sounds. It was his first go-ahead home run with the Sounds, who have 36 total go-ahead home runs this season led by Brock Wilken (8). Go-ahead home runs have accounted for 31% of the total home runs hit this season for Nashville. Matos is up to 88 career home runs in 701 career games.

NAY DAY: After having Saturday night off following his multi-HR performance on Friday, Bo Naylor didn't miss a beat with his third home run over an eight at-bat span as he launched a solo home run in the bottom of the fifth inning Sunday. Naylor became the eighth different Nashville player to homer in back-to-back games this season and the first since Jefferson Quero on June 20 at Memphis and June 23 vs. Gwinnett. It's the 10th time in Naylor's professional career with home runs in consecutive games and his first since April 29-30 of last season with Cleveland against Minnesota. He homered in a career-best three straight games during the 2021 season with Double-A Akron from July 9-15, 2021. Five of his back-to-back games with a homer have been in Major League games between 2023-2025. He now has three in Triple-A, and two in Double-A.

INDY ARTIST: Brewers no. 8-rated prospect Tyson Hardin made his second start of the week against Indianapolis in Sunday's series finale at First Horizon Park. Hardin finished his outing working 3.2 IP with five hits allowed, two runs, a walk, and five strikeouts. The five strikeouts were the most in any of his eight Triple-A starts of 4.0 IP or less. The right-hander produced three different starts for Double-A Biloxi of 4.0 IP or less with 5+ strikeouts to begin the year, including nine strikeouts over 4.0 IP on April 23 vs. Rocket City (LAA). Hardin has the most strikeouts in the Brewers farm system this year with 120 through 104.2 IP and also leads in organization in GS (23).

TATE OF THE UNION: Left-hander Tate Kuehner was activated off the 60-day Injured List prior to the series finale on Sunday against Indianapolis and made his first appearance in a game since May 20 on the road in Durham for the Sounds. The southpaw worked 2.1 IP and surrendered three hits with two unearned runs against him with a walk and five strikeouts. Kuehner appeared in nine games (8 GS) prior to landing on the Injured List for Nashville and has now worked in 12 career Triple-A games since an August promotion from Double-A Biloxi last season. At the time of his promotion to Nashville last year, Kuehner led the farm system with 116 strikeouts, ranked second in BAA (.228), third in ERA (2.46), and fourth in IP (106.0). Since making his professional debut in 2023, he ranks sixth in strikeouts (279) and seventh in IP (270.1) among all minor league pitchers in the farm system.

SECOND TIME THROUGH: Nashville's run in the bottom of the third inning on Sunday evening was the 97th of the season in the third inning; the most of any inning through 120 games. Their next largest run output by inning has been the 1st (79 runs). Nashville owns a +31-run differential in the third inning of games this year.

LET ME CLEAR MY SPROAT: Right-hander Brandon Sproat made his second start with Nashville and his First Horizon Park debut on Saturday night. He turned in a strong start for the Sounds, allowing just one hit across five scoreless innings. He racked up eight strikeouts, which were his second-most in any start this season in 23 total appearances (21 GS) between Milwaukee and Nashville. He set his season-high with 10 strikeouts on June 23 against the Cincinnati Reds. That start was also the only time he had allowed one or fewer hits, and no runs across a 5+ IP start this year. Saturday night's start against Indianapolis marked his 16th career start of 5+ scoreless innings and his ninth in Triple-A. He also has two in the big leagues, four in Double-A, and one in High-A. Saturday night was his fourth while doing so with one or fewer hits allowed.

TRIPLE DIPPER: Ethan Murray recorded his second triple of the season on Saturday night and his second career three-bagger with Nashville (110 G). It was the 10th triple of his minor league career. He has now recorded multiple triples in the same season for just a third time, also recording two in 2021 with Low-A Carolina and most recently a single-season career-high with three in 2023 for Double-A Biloxi. The Sounds lead the International League with 34 triples this season and rank fourth in all Triple-A along with El Paso.
