AARON ZAVALA HITS THREE HOMERS IN LOSS:

Aaron Zavala collected four hits, three of them for home runs, and **Marcus Smith** recorded an inside-the-park home run, but the San Antonio Missions outpaced the Frisco RoughRiders 14-11 on Wednesday night from Riders Field. Frisco (25-28, 63-58) racked up 17 hits, but the Missions (20-33, 59-63) totaled seven home runs, including four homers in the seventh inning. Zavala singled and scored the go-ahead run in the first inning, hit a go-ahead, three-run homer in the second, walked in the fifth, and homered in his final two at bats. All three of his home runs went opposite field to left. Smith notched his inside-the-park home run on a line drive up the first base line in the sixth inning, scoring Julian Brock. Zavala hit his second home run on the very next pitch to score the sixth run of the inning and provide Frisco a 10-6 lead. San Antonio plated eight runs in the next half inning to take the lead for good. **Sebastian Walcott** and **Luis Mieses** both collected three hits, while **Julian Brock** and **Marcus Smith** added two hits of their own. Walcott and Biggers both had doubles. The RoughRiders left two runners on base in each of the first six innings, leaving 13 on base for the game. Frisco held leads of one, three, and four runs, but San Antonio wiped out each lead the half inning after conceding them. For San Antonio, Marcos Castañon and Braedon Karpathios both hit two home runs. Castañon's homers tied the game in the second and seventh innings. José Geraldo (3-2) earned the win, allowing two runs over two innings. **Larson Kindreich** (5-3) took the loss, giving up four runs in 1.2 innings.

THREE HOMER GAME, THE Z-QUEL:

Aaron Zavala had an amazing night on August 27th against San Antonio, going 4-for-5 with three home runs, five RBIs, four runs scored and a walk. It was his first three home run game in his career and tied a career best in RBIs and runs scored. Last homestand, he walked off the Midland RockHounds with a home run on August 15th for his first walk-off homer with Frisco and second walk-off hit. In his last 18 games, he is hitting .286 (20-for-70)/.354/.600/.954 with seven doubles, five home runs, 18 RBIs, six walks, 14 runs scored and two steals.

CAULEY'S HISTORIC NIGHT LEADS TO PLAYER OF THE WEEK AWARD:

The RoughRiders witnessed an incredible night from **Cam Cauley** against the Hooks on August 19th, when he tied a franchise record with three home runs. He tied his career-best with four RBIs as well. It was the fifth time in franchise history that a RoughRiders player has hit three home runs in a game and the fifth time in Double-A this season that a player hit three home runs in a game. He followed it up with another home run on Wednesday, giving him four home runs in the first two games of the series. In three games, he is 7-for-11 and has increased his season OPS from .696 to .742. He was placed on the 7-Day Injured List, retroactive to August 22nd.

ROTATION ROTATING:

With the RoughRiders' recent promotions of **Trey Supak** and **Ben Anderson** and the trade of **Mitch Bratt**, Frisco only has one remaining starter from the opening rotation of the year (**Josh Stephan**). In 23 August games, Frisco has a 3.68 ERA for starters which is second in the league. **Jose Corniell** (15.2 IP, 0 ER) and **David Davalillo** (43.0 IP, 11 ER) have been incredible to start their Double-A careers.

THE BOYS ARE PICKIN' IT:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on defense this season, owning the best fielding percentage (.983) in the Texas League while committing the fewest errors (72). After committing 20 errors in the first month of the season, Frisco owns a .985 fielding percentage since May 1st, which is the third-best in Double-A. They snapped a string of 10-straight games without an error on Friday (they were 8-2 in those games), the longest such streak in the Texas League this season.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

Aaron Zavala walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilherme Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

WALLY'S WORLD:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been incredible for a 19-year-old in Double-A. This season, his walk rate of 12.0 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.3 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 32 steals over 123 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively.

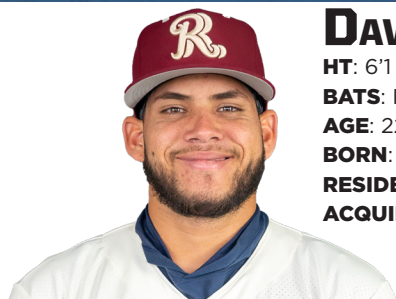

ABOUT DAVID

-In 2021, he was signed by the New York Mets for \$30,000 as a free agent, but did not pitch. After the contract was voided, he then signed with the Rangers for \$10,000 in 2022.

-Father, David, has spent 16 seasons as an MiLB coach in the Mets organization and was named the 2019 Mets MiLB Coach of the Year as the NYM Culf Coast League manager. Both his grandfather, Pompeyo, and great-uncle, Vic, played Major League Baseball. His younger brother, Gabriel, signed with the Angels in January of 2025 as a catcher and is currently their No. 14 prospect.

2025 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 16 prospect in the Rangers organization by *Baseball America*. He also was listed as having the best curveball in the organization by *Baseball America*.

-No. 28 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Dominated in first 10 starts in High-A Hub City, going 4-0 with 1.09 ERA while striking out 68 batters in 49.1 innings to just 11 walks.

-Went 3-0 with 0.96 ERA over five May starts, whiffing 35 in 28.0 innings to just four walks while holding opponents to a .152 batting average against. He was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month.

-Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on 4/20.

-Struggled in final High-A start, allowing a career-high six runs over 1.2 innings against Wilmington on 6/13.

2024 SEASON

-Led all of Minor League Baseball (min. 20 GS) with a 1.88 ERA in 22 games, 21 games started. He never allowed more than three earned runs in a single outing between Low-A Down East and High-A Hickory.

-Was named Carolina League Postseason All-Star.
