TODAY'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and the Reno Aces compete in game four at Greater Nevada Field on Sunday afternoon. Express LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang is set to get the start against Aces RHP Humberto Mejia. First pitch in Reno is set for 3:05 p.m. CT.

LET'S RECAP

The Reno Aces topped the Round Rock Express by a final score of 2-1 in a pitchers' duel on Saturday night. The Express put their solo run across home in the second inning as CF Leody Taveras launched a solo home run for a 1-0 Round Rock lead that held until the seventh frame. Round Rock starter RHP Drew Anderson finished his 6.0 innings on the bump with six strikeouts, holding Reno scoreless on only three hits through his outing. As RHP Jake Lemoine took over to start the bottom of the seventh, Aces DH Henry Ramos knocked a two-out base hit before stealing second to put the tying run in scoring position. SS Juniel Querecuto drove Ramos in with a single, tying the contest at 1-1. Reno's go-ahead run found its spot on base in the eighth as RF Jake McCarthy hit a single then stole second base. The Aces moved ahead of the Express 2-1 thanks to a Drew Ellis double that sent McCarthy home. Round Rock recorded one hit in every inning except the first and ninth, but couldn't bring runners in to add to the team's total. Reno RHP Miguel Aguilar earned his second save of the series, keeping the Express at bay in the ninth with a two-strikeout inning, cementing the 2-1 final.

BETTER ON THE ROAD

Round Rock LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang is scheduled for the afternoon start in Reno. The lefty has found success on the road this season with a 3.72 ERA (4 ER/9.2 IP) through two away starts. Yang has recorded 23 strikeouts through his six total games.

HANGING OUT AT THE TOP

Express RHP Drew Anderson lowered his league-leading ERA to 3.15 (24 ER/68.2 IP) after his scoreless 6.0-inning outing on Saturday. The righty now holds a scoreless streak of 17.0 frames over three contests, which sits as the longest active streak in the Triple-A West League. Anderson also increased his season strikeout total, which leads all of Triple-A, to 85.

SWITCHING THINGS UP

Thursday's series opener marked a change in the Triple-A West League as base sizes were increased to 18 inches and moved to be positioned entirely in the baseline. Round Rock has stolen two bases in all three of its contests in Reno while the Aces swiped one on Thursday and three on Saturday.

LEADING THE WAY

Express 3B Yonny Hernandez, LF Delino DeShields and CF Leody Taveras have all worked their way into the top five among Triple-A West League leaders in stolen bases. Hernandez sits at first with 21, DeShields at fourth with 13 and Taveras, who tallied two last night, is tied for fifth with 12.

EVEN HITTING

Round Rock and Reno both tallied seven hits during Saturday night's game, marking just the eighth time this season that the Express has recorded the same number of hits as their opponent. All of Round Rock's hits came in separate innings as both LF Delino DeShields and CF Leody Taveras knocked two each.

SOLAK'S DEBUT

2B Nick Solak made his first start with Round Rock in Saturday night's contest at Reno and finished the game with one hit in four at-bats. The infielder recorded one assist as he connected with 1B Elier Hernandez for a groundout.

SOME WINNING RECORDS

The Express enters Sunday afternoon's contest with a 7-4 record when playing in game four of a six-game series. Round Rock also holds a winning record over six day games with five wins, including four when playing on the road.

ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Twenty one members of the Round Rock Express have made their Triple-A debuts so far in 2021: RHP Jason Bahr, INF Jax Biggers, OF Carl Chester, INF Ryan Dorow, RHP Scott Engler, RHP Demarcus Evans, C Jose Felix, RHP Joe Gatto, C Blake Grant-Parks, INF Yonny Hernandez, INF Jake Hoover, C Jack Kruger, INF Charles Leblanc, LHP Sal Mendez, RHP Tyler Phillips, RHP Ryder Ryan, OF Leody Taveras, INF Anderson Tejeda, INF Curtis Terry, RHP Collin Wiles and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang. Interestingly enough, Evans, Taveras and Tejeda all saw action with the Texas Rangers during the shortened 2020 season despite no experience at the Triple-A level. C Jack Kruger also suited up for the Los Angeles Angels and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang pitched for the Rangers in 2021 before making their Triple-A debuts.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 12 different states: California, Florida, Illinois, Kansas, Maryland, Michigan, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Oregon and Texas. Jake Lemoine is the lone Texan on the roster, hailing from Bridge City. Lemoine was a standout pitcher at the University of Houston before being drafted by the Texas Rangers in 2012.

AROUND THE WORLD

Six different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 22 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, C Jose Felix, OF Elier Hernandez and OF Leody Taveras hail from the Dominican Republic, LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang is from South Korea, RHP Jharel Cotton is a native of the U.S. Virgin Islands and C Yohel Pozo and INF Yonny Hernandez are Venezuelan.

EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.



An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.
