LAST TIME OUT

Moosic, PA (May 11, 2023) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders dropped to the Omaha Storm Chasers 4-3 in eleven innings. SWB was able to tie things up with two runs in the bottom of the ninth, but Omaha added one in extras for the win.

The RailRiders got on the board with the first two batters they sent to the plate. Estevan Florial singled to reach and Kole Calhoun doubled him home for a 1-0 lead.

Omaha tied it up on a hit and an error in the third. Tucker Bradley doubled and Major League rehabber Drew Waters batted him in.

The Storm Chasers tacked one on in the seventh. Angelo Castellano singled home Dairon Blanco for a 2-1 advantage.

The visitors added one more thanks to a leadoff homer from CJ Alexander in the ninth.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre brought the bats out for the bottom of the ninth. Elijah Dunham was hit by a pitch and Franchy Cordero singled to reach. Ben Rortvedt and Billy McKinney each recorded a base knock and an RBI in consecutive at-bats to tie the game at three apiece.

The contest moved to extras, but neither team could push across a run in the 10th. In the top of the 11th, Omaha began with Samad Taylor as their pace-of-play runner. A pair of wild pitches sent Taylor home for the winning run.

Sean Boyle got the start going 5.1 innings allowing just one unearned run. He walked one and struck out three. Michael Gomez finished the sixth, but let up a run in the seventh. Colten Brewer tossed an inning and two thirds giving up just a solo homer. DJ Snelten (L, 0-2) recorded a strikeout to end the ninth. He took on the next two frames quickly, but allowed just one unearned run on a pair of wild pitches.

Jonathan Heasley got the start for Omaha. He threw five innings allowing one run on three hits. Heasley struck out six. Evan Sisk pitched 1.1 frames scoreless. Brooks Kriske tossed an inning and a third clean. Nick Wittgren let up two runs in the bottom of the ninth to send it to extras. Andres Nunez (W, 2-1) threw the two extra innings without allowing a run.

NEWS & NOTES

EXTRAS NO FUN -The RailRiders have played four extra innings contests, two at home and two on the road, and have gone 0-for-4. The first was a 3-2 loss at PNC Field in 10 innings against Buffalo on opening weekend. The next three have all reached extra innings. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has recorded one walk-off win but they did so in nine innings thanks to Michael Hermosillo's solo shot in the day game on Wednesday.

FOUR IN A ROW -Scranton/Wilkes-Barre snapped a four-game winning streak, their longest of the season. They began the streak with back-to-back wins against Rochester to end the first week of the homestand. Then the home team continued with two more victories to open the series against Omaha. Prior to this, the most the RailRiders had won consecutively this season was three on the road at Lehigh Valley from April 5th to 7th.

FIELDING FAUX PAS -With two miscues in the contest last night, the RailRiders have totalled 41 errors on the season. This puts them first in the Triple-A in this category and tied for 9th in all of Minor League Baseball. Andres Chaparro has nine, seven at third base and two at first. The team has one game with five miscues committed. SWB has had 12 error-free games.

VETERANS UPLIFTING -Two new veteran additions to the RailRiders have helped the offense flourish in the last two weeks. Kole Calhoun leads the way with a .444 average, three homers, and 10 runs batted in. Franchy Cordero has knocked in seven runs off eleven hits in seven games. Both lefties for Manager Shelley Duncan can play across the outfield.

THE UP DOWN -In the past few days the New York Yankees have called upon numerous pitcher's from the RailRiders roster. Nick Ramirez, Greg Weissert, Deivi Garcia, and Ryan Weber have all went up to help the big league club through some innings.

CHALLENGE CHECK -The home team has made 14 challenges through the first six games of the system. Only two were correct challenges that became overturned and retained. Sean Boyle recorded the first correct one in the first game with the new opportunity. In Sunday's contest, Greg Weissert was correct in belief that ball one was in fact strike three in the ninth inning. The RailRiders have had a variety of players utilize them all throughout the contest.

ANOTHER YEAR DOWN -On May 4, Andres Chaparro turned 24 years old and the RailRiders will celebrate five more birthdays to come this May. Mitch Spence turns 26 on 5/6. Deivi Garcia turns 24 on 5/19. DJ Snelten turns 31 on 5/29, while Elijah Dunham turns 25 the same day. Matt Bowman turns 32 on 5/31.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM -The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Elijah Dunham (#16 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) in his first Triple-A season. Randy Vasquez (#12) and Sean Boyle (#28) are both set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

LONGEST OUTING: Tossed the team's first quality start of the season on 4/23 @ St. Paul...6.0 IP, 4 H, 3 ER, 5 BB, 6 SO...Got two big double plays...Allowed a homer to the second batter of the game

IN THE FIRST: Vásquez typically settles in after the first inning...in the first inning this season, batters hit .310 against him with three home runs and eight runs batted in

SPRING START: For the second year in a row, Vásquez received the invite to Major League spring training and appeared in Grapefruit League contents. This spring he went 1-0 in three appearances with one start. He tossed 7.0 innings allowing four runs on 10 hits. He struck out seven and walked four.

PITCH CLOCK VIOLATION: On 4/1/23, Vásquez committed the first pitch clock violation of the season. He took too long to come set on the mound to deliver his pitch and an automatic ball was issued to his batter.

BRING ON THE CURVE: Following the season, was tabbed by Baseball America as the Yankees' No. 9 prospect and labeled as having the "Best Curveball" among Yankees farmhands... combining low-80s power with vertical and horizontal movement produced by spin rates that top 3,100 rpm

PLAYOFF RANDY: He capped his 2022 season with eight no-hit innings in the deciding game of the Double-A Eastern League playoffs before getting added to the 40-man roster in November.

INITIAL SIGNING: Vásquez has gone from signing for just \$10,000 out of the Dominican Republic at the relatively old age of 19 in May 2018 to becoming one of the Yankees' better pitching prospects.
