"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

E-ROD'S ALL-AROUND GAME LEADS SAINTS TO SERIES WIN SATURDAY: Emmanuel Rodriguez drove a first-pitch fastball out to left field for his second home run in as many days to flip a one-run deficit to a one-run lead late as the Saints hung on to clinch a series win 2-1 on Saturday afternoon at CHS Field. Following a Jefferson Morales walk with one away, Rodriguez came to bat with the Saints down 1-0 and shook off a pair of strikeouts in his first two trips to the plate by depositing a first pitch into the Buffalo bullpen, nearly the exact same spot to where he had homered the night before. It marked the sixth time in the 22-year-old's career that he homered in consecutive games. The Bisons broke a scoreless deadlock with the help of a Saints error in the sixth. Zebby Matthews left the game 0-0, but was charged with an unearned run on the error, lowering his season ERA to 1.93 after going 5 1/3 innings and striking out four with no walks and five hits allowed. Rodriguez came up big to help the Saints preserve a one-run advantage when he cut down Alan Roden trying to go first to third on Will Robertson's one-out single. Alex Speas navigated around a walk, a hit-batter and some early shakiness, including wriggling out of a bases loaded jam with nobody out in the seventh, to earn the win with 2.0 scoreless frames. Tyler Beede slammed the door with a 1-2-3 ninth for his first save of the season with St. Paul.

THE SAINTS ARE HOT: Following Saturday's comeback win, the Saints have won nine of their last 11 games, the [best winning-percentage \(.818\) among all 120 full-season minor league clubs since Sunday, April 27](#). Over the past 11 games, the Saints have a zero run differential at 60-60 (-). St. Paul's team batting average of .293 (103-351, 4th) & their team OPS of .897 (2nd) are both [top-5 among all 120 full-season minor league teams in that span](#) while their 19 homers are tied for the most in MiLB in that run.

MY POWER IS BEYOND YOUR UNDERSTANDING: After hitting just 7 homers in their first 12 games of the season, which ranked tied for the second-fewest in the International League at the time, the Saints have touched off for 35 round-trippers in their last 22 games, which [ranks second only to Charlotte](#) (40) in all of minor league baseball in that span. St. Paul have hit at least one home run in their previous seven games, a season-high streak.

MCCUSKER MCCRUSHING: Recently named the Twins minor league player of the month for March/April, Saints outfielder Carson McCusker is crushing the ball to open the season and currently ranks 2nd in Triple-A in average exit velocity to start the year (see below). On one swing on Tuesday night, he simultaneously tagged the Saints' hardest-hit ball (114.7 mph) and the longest home run of the season (426 feet), a go-ahead, two-run blast in the sixth vs Buffalo. McCusker now has the two hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and five of the top-10, including two batted balls that rank among the top-10 in exit velocity in Saints history. The 6-8 slugger is one of eight hitters in the minors with at least 9 homers this year and has already tied Yuniar Severino in 2024 for the most home runs in Saints history by the end of May. The Sparks, Nevada also saw a career-long 12-game hitting streak come to an end on Saturday, the longest by a St. Paul batter so far this year, and a span in which he hit .423 (11-26) with 2 HR, 2 doubles, and 6 RBI. With a home run on Sunday, he would tie Trevor Larnach in 2023 for the 3rd-fewest number of games to reach 10 HR in Saints history (see below):

RUNNING INTO OUTS: The Saints are just 25-of-39 (64.1%) in stealing bases as a team this year, making them the 2nd-least efficient team in Triple-A in stealing and bottom-15 in the minor leagues ([they currently rank 110th out of 120 full-season teams](#)). The Minnesota Twins are also bottom-5 in the majors in stolen-base% (72.7%) in the majors and Double-A Wichita are bottom-20 in the minors as well (68.0%).

"I'M JUST LOOSENING MY ARM": Saints utility-man Jefferson Morales now has five outfield assists on the year, which places him [1-3rd in baseball \(majors & minors\)](#), trailing only the Guardians' Steven Kwan (6) & Hub City's Anthony Gutierrez (6). He's already just the 6th-ever Saint with at least five OF assists in a season, joining Jimmy Kerrigan (2x, 9-2021, 6-2021), Mark Contreras (2x, 8-2022, 5-2021), DaShawn Keirse, Jr. (7, 2024), Jake Cave (6, 2022), Matt Wallner (5, 2023).

STRAIGHT GAS: The Saints pitching staff [rank as the second-hardest throwing staff in Triple-A](#) to start the season with an average pitch velocity of 89.4 mph that ranks as a [harder throwing staff than 19 Major League teams](#). Despite the extra few ticks, the Saints rank just 10th in Triple-A in K-rate (24.7%) and 9th in whiff-rate (28.8%). By average velo on fastballs only, St. Paul ranks [1-7th in Triple-A](#) (92.6). Jacob Bosiokovic (96.9, 19th), Ryan Jensen (96.7, 22nd) and Alex Speas (96.5, 24th) are all top-25 in the Triple-A circuit in [average fastball velo \(min 100 pitches\)](#).

THE STARS OF TOMORROW, TODAY: The Saints' current roster features eight of Minnesota's Top-30 prospects according to MLB.com and nine according to Baseball America. The Saints tout four of Minnesota's top-10 prospects on the MLB Pipeline list. The Twins prospects in the rankings include OF Emmanuel Rodriguez (No. 2, MLB.com, No. 2 BA), RHP Zebby Matthews (-/4), RHP Marco Raya (6/8), RHP Andrew Morris (9/10), RHP Cory Lewis (11/20), INF Payton Elees (23/17-currently on 7-day IL), RHP Travis Adams (22/22), C Diego Cartaya (24/21), & C Jair Camargo (-/23). Rodriguez checks in at the No. 19 on the MLB Pipeline's top-100 prospects and No. 37 on Baseball America's Top-100 list.

TWINS REPORT: The Minnesota Twins (20-20) have won seven straight after edging the Giants 2-1 last night in Target Field. Joe Ryan went 6.0 innings of one-run ball while striking out seven, and has now allowed 1 ER or fewer in three straight starts, a stretch where he has a 0.95 ERA that ranks third in the majors. Trevor Larnach's go-ahead blast in the third, his sixth of the season, stood up to keep the Twins' longest win streak of the season alive. Pablo Lopez (3-2, 2.18) starts this afternoon at 1:10 for Minnesota. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (18-14) have won back-to-back games following a 5-game skid. High-A Cedar Rapids (19-12) have lost three straight in Beloit, but have still won 8 of their last 12 games. Low-A Fort Myers (15-17) have dropped four straight after winning Tuesday's series opener against Dunedin. Infielder Jay Thomson, a 17th-round pick by the Twins out of the Air Force Academy last summer, is out to one of the better starts in the Twins system, slashing .255/.440/.521 with 6 homers in 30 games. His .961 OPS ranks second in the Minnesota farm system.

LAST APPEARANCE: Pitched in relief behind David Festa to garner the win on Monday vs Buffalo. After allowing an inherited runner to score with an RBI single to Joey Loperfido in the sixth, settled in to retire 7 of the next 9 batters, including five straight to end his outing. Threw 12 sliders (31%), 11 cutters (28%), 7 four-seamers, 5 sinkers, and 4 changeups. Induced four swings-and-misses and used fastballs for all four of his strikeouts (2 on the sinker, one each on the four-seamer and cutter).

PITCHING LAB PAYING DIVIDENDS: Adams credits his success to a relationship built on trust with the Twins player development staff, who helped him add a cutter as well as convert his sweeper into a true slider with big swing-and-miss numbers (a 40.6% whiff-rate in four Triple-A appearances last season), helping him round out his six-pitch arsenal in 2024.

NOT ALL HEROES WEAR CAPES: Travis helped save the life of a stranger from a burning house in Fort Myers in March of 2024 during Spring Training. He heard a loud bang from the house across the street from where he was staying. He and another man ran out, and saw that the hosue was on fire. They started to bang on the door to see if anyone was inside. Three other people came out who knew the man inside and started yelling, "Howard, your house is on fire , get out!" Gaining entrance to the house was difficult because of so many objects around the outside of the house, but Travis went around the side of the house, tearing up a part of the fence down to get back to the area where another door was. He ended up opening the door, and safely escorting the man out of the burning building.

SIGHT-SEERS: Adams traveled through Kyoto, Osaka and the outskirts of Japan with fellow Twins minor leaguer Jaylen Nowlin following the 2024 season. It was a leisure trip, but the duo took time away from their vacation to travel two hours from Shibuya (on the outskirts of Tokyo) to meet their old coach in the Twins organization, Takashi Miyoshi (now a Minor League instructor with the Reds) at his youth clinic. Adams and Nowlin spoke to a group of 8-16 year olds about their journey through American baseball and the mental side of the game.

HORNET PRIDE: Adams played his college baseball at Cal-State Sacramento in the Western Athletic Conference. He was a three-year starter for the Hornets, regularly pitching as their Saturday night guy as a junior and forming a dynamic 1-2 punch atop the rotation with Scott Randall, who went nine picks after Adams in that summer's June 2021 Amateur Draft to the Pirates (the two have yet to face each other in a professional game entering the season). While at Cal-State Sacramento, Adams was known for his pinpoint control, issuing just 25 walks in 151.0 career innings, the lowest BB/9 rate in program history (min. 100 IP). The program has produced nine Major Leaguers entering the 2025 season, headlined by Rhys Hoskins and James Outman.
