CARDS DROP TWO IN PARTIAL DOUBLEHEADER: For the first time in 2024, the Cardinals have lost consecutive games as Springfield fell twice against the Arkansas Travelers on Friday night at Hammons Field. In the continuation of Thursday's contest, the Travelers scored three times in the top of the 9th inning to defeat the Cards 8-5. With the game tied at five going into the top of the 9th, Arkansas rallied for three unearned runs with two outs to take a three-run lead. Pitching controlled the second game, but Springfield came up short by the final of 3-1 in 7 innings. Bryan Torres had two hits for the Birds and Nathan Church extended his hitting streak to 10 games with an RBI double in the sixth.



**DPPDSING STARTER:** Left-hander **Raul Alcantara** makes his 2nd start (5th appearance) of the season for the Travs...Last pitched on Sunday, April 21 against Frisco and got the win in relief, allowing 2 unearned runs on 3 H with 2 K in 4.0 IP...Got the win in his only start of the season, allowing 2 R (1 ER) on 4 H with 4 K over 5.0 IP against the RoughRiders on Tuesday, April 16 at Dickey-Stephens Park...Pitched in relief against the Cards on Opening Night in North Little Rock and allowed 3 R (2 ER) on 4 H in just 1.1 IP...Spent all of last season in High-A Everett's rotation and went 5-6 with a 6.35 ERA...Struck out 140 with 66 BB in 107.2 IP, oppponents hit .224 against him...Pitched exclusively in relief in 2022 with Low-A Modesto in the Cal League, going 1-3 with a 4.09 ERA with a save in 35 appearances...51 K and 29 BB in 50.2 IP...Made just one appearance outside the Dominican Summer and Arizona Complex Leagues from 2018-21...Signed with the Mariners as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic in September of 2017...23 years old

CARDINALS, TRAVELERS CLASH FOR SECOND TIME IN FOUR WEEKS: The Arkansas Travelers (Double-A, Seattle Mariners) make their first of two trips this season to Hammons Field for a six-game series. The Cardinals swept a three-game series in North Little Rock to start the 2024 campaign and went 7-5 against the Travelers at home last season.



#### **CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD**

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

#### **CARDS' RADIO HOME**



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

#### CARDS OFF TO BEST 19-GAAME START IN 8 YEARS: Despite dropping two games on Friday, the Cardinals' 14-5 record is still the best start to Texas League play through 19 games since the Frisco RoughRiders in 2016 when they went 15-4. The RoughRiders that season got out to a 17-4 start, but after reaching their high-water mark at 23-7, the Riders went 40-69 the rest of the way to finish 63-76, missing the Texas League playoffs.

CARDS, BARONS AT TOP OF DOUBLE-A: At 14-5 through 19 games, the Cardinals enter play on Saturday evening tied with the Birmingham Barons (Chicago White Sox) for the best record in all of Double-A. The Midland Rock-Hounds are next at 13-6. The Cards entered Friday with the best mark in all of MiLB, but that honor now belongs to the Modesto Nuts and Spokane Indians who sit at 13-4.

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: Cardinals outfielder Nathan Church was named Texas League Player of the Week after a big series in Amarillo. The UC Irvine product went 9-for-25 with 2 HR and 8 RBIs to go along with 6 BB. Church ranks in the top 5 in the Texas League in batting average (5th; .347), RBI (t2nd; 16), hits (2nd; 25), total bases (t5th; 37), and runs (t4th; 15). In 82 plate appearances this year, he has struck out just 5 times.

#### **REDMOND TIES FRANCHISE RECORD FOR HOME RUNS: With** his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on Tuesday night, Cardinals slugger Chandler Redmond tied the franchise record for most home runs in Springfield's 20-year franchise history. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield

uniform bring him even with Xavier Scruggs (2010-13). Redmond already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 205.

COMEBACK CARDS: Of the Cardinals' 19 games so far this season, they have fallen behind first in 12 of them. Of those 12 games, the Cards have won 9, making them 9-3 when their opponent scores first. Amazingly, despite Springfield's opponent scoring first in 9 of 10 games at home, the Cardinals hold an 8-2 record through 10 games at Hammons Field this season.

BIRDS' BATS TOP TEXAS LEAGUE: Springfield's lineup sits atop the league in several offensive categories. Through 19 games the Cardinals lead the Texas League with a .278 batting average, a mark that also leads all of Double-A; the Birmingham Barons are next with a .265 average. The Cards also lead the Texas League in OBP (.368), OPS (.769), RBIs (104) and runs scored (114). Springfield has also been particularly prodcutive hitting situationally, with a league-high 11 sacrifice flies this season.

**GRINDIN':** Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats and put the ball in play. The Cardinals have struck out just 134 times in 19 games, the second-fewest in all of Minor League Baseball. The Cardinals only trail the Spokane Indians (High-A, Colorado Rockies) who have K'd 125 times, although in two less games than Springfield has played (17). The Birds have struck out 12 less times than any other times in the Texas League (Frisco RoughRiders, 146). The Cards are averaging just 7.1 K's per game.

VICTIMS OF THE LONG BALL: Despite an overall solid season so far in which the Cardinal pitching staff has posted a 4.17 ERA, the Birds have fallen victim to the home run ball early in the 2024 season. Springfield pitchers have allowed 21 HR so far this year, 2nds most in the Texas League behind the Amarillo Sod Poodles (24).

**FAMILIAR FACES:** Of the 28 players on the Cardinals' Opening Day roster, 13 donned a Springfield uniform in 2023. Of the newcomers, only two Cards, Bryan Torres (Richmond, 2021) and Matt Lloyd (Chattanooga, 2021-22), have Double-A experience. Slugger **Chandler Redmond** returns for another season in Springfield after coming up one home run shy of the Springfield franchise record in 2023 with 31 longballs.

Cardinals skpper Jose Leger is back for his fourth year as manager in Springfield.




