Sept. 14: Senators 5, RubberDucks 4: Akron ran out to a 4-1 lead behind RBI hits by Christian Knapczyk, Ralphy Velazquez and two RBI by Jake Fox, but Harrisburg scored four in the eighth to take the 2025 finale.

Duck tales of 2025: The Akron RubberDucks finished the regular season 77-60, which was the third best record in the Eastern League. Despite finishing the overall regular season 17 games over .500 the RubberDucks did not qualify for the Eastern League playoffs after going 34-35 in the second half of the season, which was 5 games back of Altoona. Akron missed the first half playoff spot by just a game and a half being eliminated from the division race by Erie on the second to last day of the first half. Akron's 77 wins were second to only the Guardians' 88 victories for most in the organization.

Akron arms: The RubberDucks pitching staff was third in the Eastern League and eighth in Double-A with a 3.63 ERA in 2025. Trenton Denholm paced the pitching staff for most of the season leading the team in wins (11), innings pitched (126.2) and strikeouts (109) while ranking top 10 in the EL in ERA (third, 3.77), wins (third), strikeouts (ninth), innings pitched (fourth), average against (sixth, .253) and WHIP (third, 1.19). The RubberDucks bullpen collected 37 saves, which ranked third in the EL and sixth in Double-A. Zane Morehouse led the Ducks and finished eighth in the EL in saves with eight. He was one of 12 RubberDucks pitchers to record a save during the season.

RubberDucks at the bat: Akron's offense scored the second most runs in the Eastern League in 2025 with 623 runs scored and 578 RBI. Akron fifth in the EL in batting average, .231 despite that mark being the lowest in franchise history. Cooper Ingle led the team in batting average with a .273 average while Jorge Burgos led the team in home runs and RBI with 14 homers and 73 RBI. Akron led the EL in walks working 583 this year (4th in Double-A), which was the most by an Akron club since the 1997 Aeros worked 593. It also marked the first time Akron led the EL in walks since 2015. Ingle led the team with 65 walks. The RubberDucks offense showed off some impressive speed in 2025 leading the EL with 43 triples, which marked the most by an Akron club since the 2005 Aeros hit 44 of them and were three shy of tying the franchise record of 46 set in 1996 and 2004. Jake Fox led the team with six triples. When on the bases, the RubberDucks swiped 159 bags, which was the most since the 2006 Aeros stole a franchise record 176 bases. Three different Ducks stole 20+ bases in 2025 with **Alex Mooney** leading the way with 25.

How about some defense: Joe Lampe's 13 outfield assists were second most in the Eastern League in 2025 and most by an Akron outfielder since Carlos Moncreif's 16 assists in 2013. Jake Fox was also impressive in the outfield, finishing the season on an 80-game errorless streak. Akron's defense turned the only triple play in the Eastern League in 2025 to close out a win in Somerset on May 31.

RubberDucks on the prospect list: Multiple of the Guardians top prospects appeared in Akron during the 2025 season. That list includes:

Ingle the All-Star: Cooper Ingle was named an Eastern League postseason All-Star by Eastern League field staffs and broadcasters. Ingle was selected as the Eastern League's DH after batting .273/.391/.441 with 55 runs scored, 29 doubles, nine home runs, 45 RBI and 65 walks in 92 games. His .273 average, 29 doubles, 65 walks, .391 OBP and .832 OPS led qualified Akron hitters during the 2025 season. At the time of his promotion to Triple-A Columbus on August 11, Ingle led the Eastern League in OBP, doubles and walks. He also ranked top 10 in batting average (ninth), RBI (eighth), slugging percentage (seventh), OPS (sixth), hits (ninth), extra-base hits (sixth), total bases (eighth) and runs scored (sixth).

Wreck-it-Ralphy: Ralphy Velazquez did not skip a beat after being promoted to Double-A. Velazquez hit .330/.405/.589 in 28 games with Akron with 16 extra-base hits, 22 RBI and 18 runs scored. Velazquez had a hit in 23 of the 28 games he played with the RubberDucks. In his time in the Eastern League, Velazquez ranked top five in RBI (tied fourth), hits (fifth), triples (tied first), extra-base hits (third) and total bases (third). His 22 home runs between Akron and Lake County led the Guardians organization.

Ducks in the AFL: Five members of the 2025 RubberDucks will play for the Surprise Saguaros in the Arizona Fall League. Pitchers Trenton Denholm. Rorik Maltrud. Zane Morehouse and outfielders Wuilfredo Antunez and Joe Lampe will head west to represent the Guardians organization. Former RubberDucks pitcher and current Guardians pitching coordinator Michael Peoples will serve as the Saguaros pitching coach.

Can't start a fire without a spark: The RubberDucks outscored opponents 80-57 in the first inning and 158-120 over the first two innings during the 2025 season. Akron was 60-19 when scoring first (second most wins in the Eastern League when scoring first).

Akron to the show: CJ Kayfus made his MLB debut for the Guardians on August 2 marking the fifth consecutive season a member of the RubberDucks roster has gone on to make his MLB debut later that same season (Kayfus was in Akron from Opening Day - April 28). Kayfus was one of seven former RubberDucks to debut for the Guardians in 2025 joining Doug Nikhazy, Nic Enright, Parker Messick, George Valera, Petey Halpin and Chase DeLauter.

Ranked Top-3 in the Midwest League in winning percentage (fist), wins (tied-first), opposing average (second), WHIP (second), strikeouts (tied second) and ERA (third) at the time of his promotion.
