No Triskaidekaphobia Here!

Corpus Christi Hooks

Triskaidekaphobia is "extreme supersition regarding the number thirteen" ... and it was Friday the 13th ... but there was no triskaidekaphobia at the ballyard. A crowd of more than 5,500 watched the RockHounds break open a close game for a 9-5 win over the Corpus Christi Hooks at Momentum Bank Ballpark.

Zack Gelof, Jordan Diaz and Kyle McCann each had three hits to lead a 14-hit attack as the Hounds won their second straight game ... and their third in the first four games of the (six-game) series.

Both clubs got on the board in the first inning, each loading the bases, with the Hooks scoring once and the Hounds twice (on a sacrifice fly from Diaz and a wild pitch). Corpus Christi's Grae Kessinger launched a two-run home run in the top of the second to put the Hooks up, 3-2, but the RockHounds answered with an RBI double from Gelof in the home half of the inning.

Diaz led off the third with a single and McCann sent a two-run home run (his second in his last three games) onto the right field grass berm to break the 3-3 lie.

The Hooks drew within 5-4 in the fifth and tied the game on back-to-back swings in the seventh on Justin Dirden's double (his third hit of the game) and Cesar Salazar's RBI single to center.

Back-to-back singles from Logan Davidson and Diaz opened the home half of the seventh and McCann followed with his third RBI ... the eventual game-winner ... with a single to right-center.

The Hounds opened the eighth with a hat trick of singles from Shane Selman, Max Schuemann and Gelof and all three scored (with RBI from Davidson and Diaz and one wild plich), building the lead to 9-5

TCS ARE TO BASEBALL WHAT A FLARY CRUST IS TO MOM'S APPLE PIE" - HARRY R Jordan Diaz went 3-for-4 with a double, a run and two RBI, extending his on-base streak to 21 games. Jordan is hitting .329 in the streak, with 11 doubles, five home runs and 16 RBI.

He also has hits in 13-of-14 games (20-55, 364) with seven doubles, four HR and 15 RBI.

Zack Gelof was 3-for-5 with a double, two runs and a run batted in. It was his fifth game with three or more hits and extended his current hit streak to eight games. He is 16-for-34 (.471) in the eight-gamer (and a .550 on-base pot.). The RockHounds now have two of the Texas League's top three hitters. Zack is third at ,359 for the season and ...

Max Schuemann continues to lead the TL, hitting .381, and has now reached base in 13

He has just one hit in his last nine at bats (so he's "only" hitting .479 in the 13-game on-base streak ... with a .556 on-base percentage).

Max is sixth in all of Minor League Baseball in both batting average and OBP (.489) and is tied for fourth in the minors with 31 runs scored

► The pitch clock continues to impact the time of game. Both clubs loaded the bases in a first inning that saw 58 pitches and lasted aimost exactly 30 minutes. The next eight Innings ... with 11 runs and 26 baser unners ... took just two hours, 18 minutes (total time was 2.48).
