COLUMBUS, OHIO – The Omaha Storm Chasers dominated the Columbus Clippers Saturday afternoon, with an 11-5 win at Huntington Park.

- The Chasers came out the gates strong as **Tyler Tolbert** led the game off with his first of three singles on the day ... **Drew Waters** and **Nick Pratto** followed with a pair of walks to load the bases and **CJ Alexander** singled Tolbert home for Omaha's first run ... **Cam Devanney** popped an infield fly behind second base and Waters tagged from third base to score the team's second run ... **Devin Mann** then ripped a double to left field and brought Pratto home for a 3-0 Storm Chasers lead.
- In the bottom of the 2nd inning, Columbus cut into Omaha's lead as **Bryan Lavastida** homered to left field to make the score 3-1.
- Omaha answered right back as Alexander hammered his second home run of the season to right-center field in the top of the 3rd inning to extend his team's lead to 4-1 ... the Chasers added more in the top of the 5th inning as Alexander doubled to center field to bring **Logan Porter** home ... Devanney then unleashed his first homer of the season to right field to extend the lead to 7-1 ... the runs kept coming in the 6th inning as Porter singled up the middle to plate two and the lead grew to 9-1.
- Omaha continued its run parade into the 7th inning as the team scored in its third consecutive inning ... Tolbert started the damage as he singled up the middle to score Devanney, then with bases loaded, Mann scored from third base on a wild pitch to extending Omaha's lead to 11-1.
- Starting pitcher **Daniel Lynch IV** earned his first win of the year and held the Clippers to one run over 5.0 innings, surrendering only a home run in the second.
- After **Evan Sisk** fired a scoreless 6th inning, the lefty ran into trouble in the bottom of the 7th and **John McMillon** came to get the final out of the inning ... McMillon could not get the last out as he issued four straight walks and forced in three runs to bring Omaha's lead down 11-5.
- Sam Long** finished the 7th inning behind McMillon and fired a scoreless 8th inning before **Will Klein** pitched a scoreless 9th inning to secure the win.
- As a team, Omaha's 11 runs and 17 hits were both season highs, as were seven extra-base hits, seven walks and four steals ... eight players recorded hits, including seven multi-hit efforts. Tolbert and Alexander led the way with three hits each.

NOTES AND NUGGETS YOU CAN COUNT ON ME

- The Storm Chasers struggled to offer their starting pitchers run support in the first few games of this season, but things are headed in the right direction as of late.
- Through the first five games of the season, the Storm Chasers did not offer the starters any run support ... across 20.0 innings of work, the offense failed to score when the starting pitchers were in the game.
- In the last three games, Omaha has combined to offer 16 runs of support behind 10.0 innings from its starting pitchers (1.6 runs of support/starter inning).
- 9 runs of support yesterday of **Daniel Lynch IV** was a season-high for the offense ... Omaha's hitters only gave their starters that much run support in 5 games last year, all of them wins.
- In 2023, Storm Chasers starters averaged of 2.7 runs of support per game, 392 runs in total over the 392 games of the season ... the 2023 Chasers were 12-0 when giving their starter at least 7 runs of support, 28-4 when giving at least 5 runs of support.

GETTING OFFENSIVE

- After Omaha's first three wins of the season were dramatic, come-from-behind one-run victories, Saturday's triumph was a breath of fresh air, a loud offensive showing.
- Yesterday, Omaha set season-highs in runs scored (11), hits (17), total bases (28), doubles (5), extra-base hits (7), runs batted in (10), walks (7) and stolen bases (4).
- In the first three wins of the season, Omaha combined for 17 runs, 26 hits, 41 total bases, 3 doubles, 4 home runs, 7 extra-base hits, 12 walks and 5 steals.

CLIPPING COLUMBUS

- Omaha needs a win today to secure a series split with the Columbus Clippers.
- Since the Storm Chasers joined the International League in 2021, they've played 9 series against Columbus ... Omaha has won 5, split 3 and lost 1 of those series.
- The Storm Chasers did not lose a series to Columbus last year, sweeping the Clippers 6-0 in their one trip to Werner Park, while winning their first trip to Huntington Park 4-2, then splitting the second trip to Columbus 3-3.
- Omaha has not lost a series to the Clippers since August 2021 ... in 2022, the Chasers won 2 of 3 series with Columbus and split the other one ... in 2021, Omaha won a series, split a series and lost a series: August 17-22 at Werner Park, the Clippers took 4 of 6 from the Chasers.

FLEM IS THEM

- Right-hander **William Fleming** makes his Triple-A debut today, the 4th Storm Chaser to make their Triple-A debut in 2024.
- On March 29, **Tyler Tolbert** went 0-for-4 in his first AAA game ... on March 30, **John McMillon** allowed 4 runs in 0.1 IP in his AAA debut, while **Jacob Wallace** threw a scoreless inning on March 30 and earned the win in his first AAA game.

TODAY'S START

- Fleming is making his 1st start of the season and his Triple-A debut today.
Named to the breaking roster for Double-A Northwest Arkansas on April 3, but assigned to Omaha on NWA's Opening Day, April 5.

LAST OUTING

Making his first start of the 2024 regular season ... made one appearance in the Cactus League on February 27 vs. Colorado.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Made his first MLB Spring Training appearance on February 27 vs. Colorado, a 1-2-3 9th inning to earn a save against the Rockies.

CAREER NOTES

- 2023: Split his season between Quad Cities (A+) and NW Arkansas (AA), combining for a 4.11 ERA (49 ER in 107.1 IP) over 23 appearances (19 starts) ... cut his home run total in half, giving up 9 long balls in 2023 (0.75 HR/9) after surrendering 18 homers in 2022 (1.32 HR/9).
Struck out a season-high 8 (and tied a career-high) in his first start of the season, on April 8 vs. South Bend (CHC) ... allowed 2 runs on 3 hits and 1 walk with the 8 strikeouts, but did not receive any run support and took the loss.
Turned in 3 quality starts, including back-to-back starts July 16 and July 22, his last in High-A and first in Double-A ... on July 16 vs. South Bend (CHC), held the Cubs to 2 runs over 6.0 innings with 0 walks and 7 strikeouts ... on July 22 vs. Tulsa (LAD), pitched 6.1 scoreless innings, his only start of the season pitching into the 7th inning, with just 2 hits, 1 walk and 7 strikeouts.
While he was called up to Double-A on July 18, his 2023 game log shows his first outing with NWA on July 9, the same day he started for Quad Cities ... NW Arkansas and Arkansas (SEA) had their July 9 game suspended in the middle of the 4th inning and did not resume until September 12, when Fleming took over on the mound ... he pitched the final 5.0 innings of the game and allowed just one run to earn what is "technically" his first Double-A win.
Compiled 5 scoreless appearances, including 3 starts with Quad Cities, 1 start with NW Arkansas and 1 NWA relief appearance.

- 2022: Opened the 2022 season where he ended 2021, with the Modesto Nuts (A) ... ended the year in the Royals organization with Quad Cities (A+) ... between the two levels, combined to go 9-10 with a 5.00 ERA (68 ER in 122.1 IP) across 25 starts.
Made 14 starts in the California League before he was traded to the Royals on June 27, 2022 alongside RHP Wyatt Mills for 1B Carlos Santana and cash ... earned a promotion to High-A upon being traded and finished the year in the Quad Cities (A+) rotation, making 11 starts for the River Bandits.
In the month of April, twice struck out 8 batters in a game to set and then tie a career-high ... in back-to-back outings on April 21 vs. Rancho Cucamonga (LAD) and April 27 @ San Jose (SF), Fleming struck out 8 over 6.0 innings with 1 hit allowed.
Threw a career-high 7.0 innings on August 11 vs. Cedar Rapids (MIN) and did not allow a run, surrendering just 5 hits and 1 walk with 7 strikeouts to earn a win ... was one of four scoreless outings on the season and one of five quality starts, his first of two quality starts with Quad Cities.

- 2021: After being drafted by Seattle in the 11th round, of the 2021 MLB draft, made his professional debut with the ACL Mariners (R) in the Arizona Complex League ... made two starts in the ACL and finished the year in the California League with the Modesto Nuts (A).
Over 7 outings (2 starts) with Modesto, had 4 scoreless appearances and allowed 5 of his 6 earned runs of the season in one start, on September 14 @ Stockton (OAK).
Slowly built up as the season progressed and threw 3.0 innings in his final five outings of the year with the Nuts ... threw between 30 and 50 pitches in all 7 outings with Modesto.

- COLLEGE (2018-2021): Pitched four seasons at Wake Forest University, where he posted a career record of 7-12 over 60 appearances (18 starts) with a 5.39 ERA (93 ER in 155.1 IP) ... struck out 125 batters in his career to 52 walks.
JUNIOR (2021): Started 13 games on the mound for the Demon Deacons, including every ACC series ... went 4-6 with a 6.03 ERA and set career highs in strikeouts (65) and innings pitched (74.2).

- MISCELLANEOUS: His mother, Amy, was a world record holder, ACC champion and NCAA national champion swimmer at North Carolina ... his grandfather, Dr. Cecil Pless, Jr., ran track at UNC.
Member of the National Honor Society and is an Eagle Scout.
