Today: It's a Capital City Market Kids Day with postgame Kids Run the Bases and an Extra Inning with free ice cream at Capital City Market, as the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the finale in a six-game series with the Lake County Captains, High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. The Nuts have won four of the first five games of the series and are 8-3 overall against Lake County this year; in contrast, the Captains are 18-9 against the rest of the league.

On the Air: Today's game is available on MiLB TV or listen in via StreamGuys with **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** and **Adam Jaksa** on the call.

Yesterday: Lugnuts 15, Captains 11. Trailing 8-2 entering the bottom of the 3rd inning, the Lugnuts knocked out **Parker Messick** with a nine-run rally, added a **Colby Halter** two-run homer in the 4th, and topped the Caps in a slugfest lasting three hours and 50 minutes. **Jonny Butler** and **Danny Bautista, Jr.** added home runs of their own in a 14-hit attack.

On Deck: The Lugnuts head on the road to battle the Fort Wayne TinCaps in a six-game series at Parkview Field, returning home May 28 to host Peoria.

LUG•NOTES

Here Come the Nuts: As recently as nine days ago, the Lugnuts were seven games out from the Midwest League East Division lead, but Lansing has won seven of its past eight games and now trails division leaders Lake County and Great Lakes by only one game entering today.

Epic: Last night's game, the longest of the season, featured 423 pitches, 30 total hits, 26 total runs, and 17 total walks. The Captains stranded 14 runners on base and were not set down in order until a 1-2-3 ninth inning. Every Lugnuts batter scored at least one run but no more than two, and every Lugnuts batter collected one hit but no more than two.

Pride of Palo Alto: 20-year-old **Henry Bolte**, the youngest player on the team, is tied for 1st in the Midwest League in runs scored (33), tied for 3rd in steals (17), tied for 6th in total bases (66), tied for 5th in extra-base hits (16) and tied for 7th in home runs (6). Overall in May, he has drawn 17 walks and scored 17 runs in 16 games, going 2-for-4 with two singles and a walk yesterday.

Captains Killer: **Euribiel Ángeles** is slashing .417/.440/.667 vs. Lake County this season, with 20 hits (seven extra-base hits, including three triples) and scoring 10 runs while knocking in 16 runs in 11 games. Euribiel has nine RBIs this series alone against the Caps, supplying a key triple yesterday with three RBIs. Other notable Lugs vs. Captains pitching: **Henry Bolte** has a .350 average and a 1.183 OPS, scoring 12 runs in 10 games; **Brayan Buevas** has a .333 average and an 1.032 OPS, with 12 runs scored in 11 games; and **Will Simpson** has a .381 batting average and a 1.119 OPS, with eight runs scored in six games.

Streaking: **Euribiel Ángeles** enters today on a seven-game hitting streak, while **Cameron Masterman** comes in on a 17-game on-base streak.

Team Effort: Lansing's offense tops the Midwest League in hits (325), runs (212), OPS (.747), triples (16), walks (190) and total bases (501).

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster includes three MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10) and first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 28). In Eric Longenhagen's Top 32 A's prospects for Fangraphs, he gives a nod to Morales at No. 3, Simpson at No. 28 and **Will Johnston** at No. 32. Keith Law placed Morales at No. 7 and Bolte at No. 17, giving a nod to Morales as his sleeper prospect of the organization, writing "Morales is a wild card given his age and lack of experience, yet those also make it easy to dream on the package of stuff and tools, and he offers as much upside as anyone in this system."

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2012: Lake County out-hit the Lugnuts, 10-2, but the Lugnuts beat the Captains, 2-1, at Classic Park. In the sixth inning, Kevin Pillar's sacrifice fly and Andy Burns's RBI double supplied all of the scoring the Lugnuts needed. The Caps left 12 runners on base and went 1-for-9 with runners in scoring position.

2022: The Great Lakes Loons (21-15) collected 13 hits in the first five innings, building an eight-run lead before holding off the Lansing Lugnuts (15-21), 8-5, on Thursday night at Dow Diamond. Lansing catcher Jared McDonald swatted a 442-foot home run and Brayan Buevas reached base four times on two walks, a single and a double, spearheading a late rally that ultimately fell short.

First Team All-State as junior (0.95)... 2022 - junior year at Hawai'i: First Team All Big West, ranking 3rd in the conference in ERA (1.90) and leading Hawai'i in strikeouts (88)... notable Rainbow Warriors in the pros include Cleveland's Cade Smith, Seattle's Josh Rojas, longtime infielder Kolton Wong and former Brewers closer Chuck Crim.

The Aloha State: The most career MLB games for any Hawaiian: former A's catcher Kurt Suzuki, 1,635, who also owns the most career homers (143); among pitchers, Charlie Hough's 25-year career stands alone. Former Lugnuts from Hawai'i include Dustin Antolin (also from Mililani) and Bryson Namba. 2009 lights-out closer Matt Daly is the only other Lugnut in team history to play ball at the University of Hawai'i at Manoa.

Minor League Path: Made pro debut in the Arizona Complex League in 2022 with a pair of scoreless innings, moving up to Stockton for two relief appearances by year's end... spent all of 2023 with the Ports, serving as their relief ace (11 saves in 15 chances) and only allowing three home runs in 61 1/3 innings... limited left-handed batters to .198 batting average / .530 OPS; right-handers hit .305 with .753 OPS.

Stockton Sensation: Made two relief appearances and two starts in 2024, facing 46 batters and whiffing 26 of them ... debuted with 4 2/3 hitless IP, 8 K on 4/6... followed up with three perfect innings with 7 K on 4/12.

Gig 'Em: Majored in finance at Texas A&M... pitched primarily out of Aggies' bullpen; career stats: 6-4, 5.77 ERA, 66 G, 8 GS, 8 SV, 98 1/3 IP, 57 BB, 132 K... finest year at College Station was in 2022: 3.25 ERA, 23 G, 2 GS, 4 SV, 36 IP, 2 HR, 18 BB, 49 K... struggled in 2023 to 5.89 ERA due to 9 HR and 31 BB in 47 1/3 IP, though he struck out 70 batters... drafted following his fourth season at A&M... joined fellow Aggies Micah Dallas (8th round, 2022) and Nathan Dettmer (5th round, 2023) as Aggies drafted by the A's, and one of seven Aggies drafted overall in 2023... signed for \$150,000... notable Aggies in the pros include Chuck Knoblauch, Davey Johnson, Wally Moon, Michael Wacha, Ross Stripling and A.J.
