TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Reno Aces (Arizona Diamondbacks affiliate) get set for the series finale tonight at Dell Diamond. The game went to extra frames and after neither team struck for a run in the 10th inning, Reno grabbed an 8-7 lead in the 11th on SS Jose Fernandez's RBI groundout. In the bottom half, with SS Keyber Rodriguez starting on second, CF Jarred Kelenic launched a first-pitch, walk-off two-run homer to lift Round Rock to a 9-8 victory.

WHERE WE STAND

The Express have won three consecutive games and eight of their last nine... with their win last night have won all three series since the All-Star break (10-4)... can win the season series over Reno with a victory today... remain 5.0 games back of first place and in sole control of second place in the second half standings behind first-place Sugar Land... are 9-5 in home games to start the second half after going 12-24 in the first half at Dell Diamond... 7 games below .500 or better for the first time since May 3 when they were 13-20.

KELENIC CRUSHING

OF Jarred Kelenic went 3-for-6 with 4 RBI, a walk-off homer, a stolen base and 3 runs on Saturday...is now batting .459 (17-37) with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs, 10 RBI, 15 runs and 4 stolen bases in 10 games against the Aces this season... has also recorded multiple hits in 7 of his last 9 games, slashing .450/.463/.825 in that span... Kelenic's batting average (.382) is the highest among Express hitters with at least 100 plate appearances since 2005... his 1.132 OPS ranks third behind INF Chris Davis (1.229) and OF Yordan Alvarez (1.185)... in 26 games with Triple-A Charlotte to start the year, Kelenic slashed .202/.346/.464/.810.

HERE COMES THE BRIDE

INF Jonah Bride gave the Express their first lead of the game with a two-RBI single in the bottom of the 7th last night as he finished 2-for-5 with two RBI and a strikeout... the single marked Bride's 39th hit this season with 2 outs, which is the most in the PCL... Bride also leads the league with 54 H this year with two strikes.

COMEBACK KINGS

The Express have 10 comeback wins (when trailing entering the seventh inning or later) this year which is fourth-most in the PCL. Five of those comeback victories have been in the second half and seven have been since June 1. They have four comeback victories in their last 14 home games.

MONTY ON THE MOUND

LHP Jordan Montgomery is scheduled for his sixth rehab start with the Express. He is 0-1 with a 5.63 ERA (10 ER/16.0 IP) with two walks and 12 strikeouts. The 2023 World Series Champion with the Rangers is returning from Tommy John surgery. He has not appeared in the big leagues since September 22, 2024. This will be the third time he has faced Reno this year. He allowed one earned run over two starts and 7.0 innings on July 7 & 12 at Greater Nevada Field.

THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - THURSDAY, AUGUST 2, 1973

Nolan Ryan limited the Angels to two runs on eight hits and earned his 12th win of the 1973 season as California beat the Texas Rangers, 3-2. Despite the win, Ryan was still being ridiculed for his poor 12-13 record. The next day, in the Anaheim Bulletin, Sports Editor Dennis Beets wrote: "A victim of non-support or his own wildness on too many occasions this year, Ryan went into Thursday's twilight game against the Texas Rangers with an unimpressive 11-13 record." While many discussed his record, Ryan lowered his season ERA to 2.90. In the final two months of the 1973 regular season, he went 10-3 with a 2.75 ERA while posting 144 strikeouts in 114.2 innings. "More than anything, I liked Ryan's endurance. It's been quite a while since he's been that strong," manager Bobby Winkles said postgame. "As long as we get pitching performances like that, we've got a chance." Winkles said this despite Ryan owning a 3.00 ERA in July and pitching at least 8.0 innings in four of his seven starts. In June, he tossed five complete games in seven starts. Davey Nelson homered for Texas in the third to make it 1-0. A Sandy Alomar sacrifice fly and an Al Gallagher RBI single gave California a 2-1 lead in the bottom half of the inning. Billy Parker added a sacrifice fly in the sixth to make it 3-1. The Rangers scored in the seventh on a Dick Billings RBI single. In the ninth inning with one out, Ryan motioned for two of his outfielders, Ken Berry and Bob Oliver, to move in several steps, figuring that if there was a play at the plate, they would have a better chance to throw the runner out. There was a play at the plate, and Bob Oliver threw out Jim Mason to keep the Angels in front. Ryan then struck out the next batter to end the game.

MANAGER KYLE MOORE

The 2026 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kyle Moore's first season with the E-Train. In 2025, Moore served as the bench coach for Triple-A Iowa of the Chicago Cubs organization. He previously served as the skipper in the Baltimore chain with Short-Season Aberdeen (2018), Low-A Delmarva (2019), High-A Aberdeen (2021) and Double-A Bowie (2022-23) - combining for a 321-286 (.529) record over five seasons. The 2019 Delmarva Shorebirds were named the 2019 MiLB Team of the Year, finishing with a 90-48 record, the most wins across all of MiLB that season.

A catcher in his playing days, Moore signed with the Orioles as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He played collegiately at University of Alabama after winning three high school state titles with Edgewood (Ala.) Academy. Moore transitioned to coaching in 2012 as a strength and conditioning coach with Delmarva.

PITCHING COACH DAVE BORKOWSKI

Former MLB pitcher Dave Borkowski (Boar-COW-ski) enters his fourth season on Round Rock's staff and 17th year in coaching. He will serve as the Express' pitching coach in 2026, reprising the role he held from 2023-24 after spending the 2025 campaign as the club's bullpen coach. Borkowski spent five seasons as a minor league instructor in the Los Angeles Dodgers' farm system.

His tenure also includes an 11-year stint as a minor league coach for the Houston Astros. Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Borkowski enjoyed a 15-year professional playing career that saw him post a 13-20 record and 5.87 ERA across seven MLB seasons with the Detroit Tigers (1999-2001), Baltimore Orioles (2004), and Houston (2006-08). He was originally selected by Detroit in the 11th round of the 1995 MLB Draft out of Sterling Heights (Mich.) High School.

BENCH COACH CHASE LAMBIN

Lambin enters his sixth year on the Express staff and will reprise his role as bench coach for the fifth straight year (beg. 2022). The 2026 campaign will mark Lambin's 12th in the Texas organization. He has previous stops as a hitting coach for High-A Down East (2019), Low-A Hickory (2018), Short-A Spokane (2017), and the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers (2016). He first joined the Rangers as a member of the Spokane coaching staff in 2015.

Lambin was selected by the New York Mets in the 34th round of the 2002 June draft out of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette and played in the Mets, Marlins, Nationals, Twins, and Royals organizations. He also has international experience, spending the 2009 season with Chiba Lotte in Japan. The versatile defender appeared at every position except catcher over the course of his career.

BULLPEN COACH JULIO VALDEZ

Valdez enters his seventh year in the organization and first as the Rangers' Triple-A pitching coach after serving in the same role with Double-A Frisco (2025), High-A Hickory (2024), Low-A Down East (2023), Rookie-level ACL Rangers (2022), and DSL Rangers (2020-21). During the canceled 2020 campaign, Valdez worked with pitchers at the Dominican Republic complex and Fall Developmental League in Arizona.

The Florida native played baseball at Alabama State University from 2012-16. He attended Lake Howell (Fla.) High School, where he posted a career 15-4 record and 2.20 ERA, and earned all-conference honors as a junior and senior. Valdez transitioned to an assistant coach role at Alabama State in 2017 before becoming Director of Pitching at the Texas Pitching Institute in El Paso, Texas. He spent two years at TPI before taking the same role at Baseball Rebellion in Durham, N.C., before joining the Rangers.

HITTING COACH MATT LAWSON

Former Rangers farmhand Matt Lawson returns for a fifth straight season as Round Rock's hitting coach. Lawson previously served as an assistant coach, hitting instructor, and recruiting coordinator at his alma mater, Missouri State University, from 2014-21. The Missouri native was selected by the Rangers in the 14th round of the 2007 MLB Draft and played seven professional seasons as an infielder in the Texas (2007-10), Seattle (2010), and Cleveland (2011-13) organizations. With Texas, he was named Short-A Spokane's team MVP as a rookie in 2007 and a league All-Star for High-A Bakersfield (2009) and Double-A Frisco (2010) before he was involved in the 2010 trade that brought Cliff Lee to the Rangers.

He holds a degree in psychology and a graduate degree in sports management.

DEVELOPMENT COACH KAWIKA EMSLEY-PAI

Emsley-Pai enters his sixth year in the Texas organization and returns to the Express as a development coach, this after beginning his Rangers tenure in the same role during the 2021 season. He has also served as Double-A Frisco's bench coach (2025) and was a development coach with Frisco (2023-24) and High-A Hickory (2022). He served as the Centralia (Wash.) College head coach and education advocate from 2019-21. Prior to his stint at Centralia, Emsley-Pai had a three-year stint as an education advocate at a maximum-security juvenile rehabilitation facility.

A former catcher in the minor leagues, Emsley-Pai spent six seasons with the Diamondbacks (2010) and Pirates (2011-15) organizations, topping out at Double-A Altoona in 2014. He was originally selected by Arizona in the 10th round of the 2010 June draft out of Lewis-Clark State College in Lewiston, Idaho after spending his freshman year at the University of Texas in 2008.

- Owns a 46-41 record, 4.03 ERA (390 ER/872.0 IP), 3.85 FIP, 1.268 WHIP, and 788 strikeouts over 251 walks in 166 Major League appearances/161 starts for New York-AL (2017- 22), St. Louis (2022-23), Texas (2023), and Arizona (2024).
- Was originally selected in the 4th round of the 2014 MLB Draft by the Yankees from University of South Carolina.
