## "FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

**LAST TIME OUT:** The St. Paul Saints leaned on five strong innings from Marco Raya to outduel baseball's No. 2 prospect as they walked away with a 5-4 win on Wednesday afternoon against Indianapolis, snapping an eight-game losing streak for the Saints at Victory Field. Pirates top prospect Bubba Chandler struggled with command, walking four Saints in the opening inning, including Anthony Prato to force in a run and make it 1-0 St. Paul. Raya was in control for most of the afternoon and pitched well when getting into trouble. He evaded damage after putting two on with one out in the first and coaxed a comebacker with two on an two out in the third, starting a string of seven in-a-row retired to finish the day. Raya would complete five innings for the first time this season, going 5.0 shutout allowing two hits with three walks and three K's. The Saints didn't collect their first hit until the sixth inning, but turned it into a three-run frame. St. Paul whacked three doubles in the inning off reliever Sean Sullivan, including a two-run scoring hit from Jefferson Morales and another RBI two-bagger from Tanner Schobel. The lead wouldn't last long as Alex Speas gave up four in the bottom of the inning, recording just two outs. The Saints took the lead in the seventh when DaShawn Keirsey Jr. singled with two away. Cody Laweryson and Richard Lovelady combined to record the final eight outs without a run allowed, including an 1.1 perfect frames from Lovelady, who has now retired 16 straight since June 1 for his 6th save.

**WAIT FOR IT, WAIT FOR IT:** The Saints have been held without a hit for the first five innings of the first two games of the series in Indianapolis, including going into the seventh until collecting their first hit on Tuesday night. It marks the first time in franchise history the Saints have been held hitless through five innings in back-to-back games. Opposing teams have now take a no-hitter through five innings against the Saints 21 times the past five seasons, and finished off the no-no twice (vs Indianapolis on April 13, 2022 & @Iowa on July 11, 2021 in 7 innings).

**HOW COME THEY CALL IT VICTORY FIELD?:** The Saints snapped out of an eight-game losing streak at Victory Field with a win on Wednesday afternoon. The Saints have historically struggled in Indy, and have the second-lowest winning percentage at Victory Field of any of their visiting ballparks since going Triple-A, with only a worse mark in Columbus (see below). The Saints went just 1-11 in two visits to Indianapolis last year, including being swept in a six-game series from August 13-18. The Saints have been outscored 209-186 all-time at Victory Field and in particular have struggled to pitch there. The Saints own a 4.90 ERA all-time and the 15 pitchers on the current roster with experience in Indianapolis are a combined 8-8 with an 4.84 ERA at Victory Field (52 ER, 96.2 IP):

**I'M LOVIN' IT:** Left-hander Richard Lovelady has retired the last 16 hitters he's faced out of the bullpen dating back to June 1 after recording his sixth save in as many chances on Wednesday. His current streak of six straight saves is the 3rd-longest active streak in Triple-A. Lovelady is currently one of three Triple-A relievers with an active streak of 16+ batters retired in-a-row, trailing only Gwinnett's Jesse Chavez (17) and tied with Las Vegas's Grant Holman (16). His streak is tied with Kody Funderburk for the most consecutive batters retired by a St. Paul pitcher this year, with Funderburk retiring 16 straight Triple-A batters from a stretch spanning April 4-27, interrupted by a stint with the Twins.

**MCCRUSHER KEEPS MCCRUSHIN':** Saints outfielder Carson McCusker currently ranks 5th in Triple-A in average exit velocity (93.3 mph, min 120 PA). Despite an 0-for-14 slump entering play Thursday, McCusker's longest hitless slump this season, the Sparks, Nevada native still ranks 7-4th in the league in homers (12) and is 2nd among qualifiers in OPS & SLG%. On Thursday vs Scranton, he demolished a 463 foot homer that jumped off the bat at 115.2 mph, marking the third-hardest batted ball in Saints franchise history (Matt Walner-115.6 mph & Trevor Larnach-115.5 mph). It was the 7th-longest tracked homer in the history of CHS Field, the fourth furthest hit by a Saints batter. McCusker has the four hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and five of the top-10, including three batted balls that rank among the top-10 in exit velocity in Saints history.

**ED(WALK) JULIEN:** After drawing three walks on Wednesday, Saints second baseman Edouard Julien leads all of baseball (majors & minors) with 28 free passes since May 11. In that stretch, Julien has drawn at least one free pass in 16 the 26 games he's appeared in and owns a .459 OBP.

**GOING, GOING, GONE:** After hitting just 7 homers in their first 12 games of the season, which ranked tied for the 2nd-fewest in the Int'l League at the time, the Saints have touched off for 67 round-trippers in their last 50 games since April 14, which ranked 4-4th in the minors in that stretch, trailing only Charlotte (81), Greensboro (75), & Everett (74). The Saints recently homered in 10 straight games from May 24-June 3, marking the longest stretch for the club since they homered in 11 in-a-row from April 27-May 10 last year. The Saints have homered in 4-last-6 since and have gone deep in 28 of their last 35 games since May 2.

**HEY MICKEY YOU'RE SO FINE:** Since being optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on May 5, Saints utility man Mickey Gasper has hit .349 (37-106) with 10 doubles, 7 HR, and 18 RBI in 28 games. Gasper is 2nd in the IL in extra-base hits (17) since that date and his OPS ranks 2nd in the International League (min 80 AB) in that stretch. Gasper has quite simply been one of the best hitters in the minors the last two years. Since the start of 2024 with the Boston org, he ranks as the 2nd best hitter in the minors by wRC+ (weight runs created plus, where 100 is league average, a ballpark and league adjusted measure).

**TWINS REPORT:** The Twins (36-31) got an outstanding two-way performance from Byron Buxton to beat David Festa's quality start in a 6-2 win over the Rangers at Target Field yesterday. Buxton's 479-foot, three-run blast in the third gave Minnesota the lead and marked the fourth-longest longball hit by a Twin in the Statcast era. He also made a diving catch to save two runs in the top 3rd for Festa, who completed six innings for the second time in his MLB career while striking out four against two walks and three hits allowed. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (30-29) were blanked 11-0 by Corpus Christi (HOU) at home. High-A Cedar Rapids (34-24) breezed past Peoria (STL) with a 6-0 win. Low-A Fort Myers (27-31) were rained out in Dunedin (TOR).

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Made his 11th start of the year Friday night at CHS Field vs Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, and completed six innings for the second time in the last three starts and despite giving up just one earned run, took a tough luck loss. Helped his own cause by picking off two baserunners. His lone blemish came on a two-out solo shot to Bryan De La Cruz in the second. His second run allowed came in the fifth with the aid of a throwing error by Morris on a potential double-play ball, as well as a wild pitch and a balk in the inning. Threw 20 sinkers (27%), 20 four-seamers (27%), 11 cutters (15%), 10 sweepers (14%), 9 changeups (12%), and 3 curveballs (4%), good for 69% fastball usage. Generated eight swings-and-misses and recorded 2-of-3 strikeouts on the changeup, one on the four-seamer.

**ON THE FAST TRACK:** In just his second full-season in the minors last year, Morris ascended through three levels of the minor league ladder to finish the year making his first seven starts at the Triple-A level. It's not the first time that Morris has accelerated at a faster pace than his peers. He graduated high school at just 16 years old, starting his freshman season of college at just 17. He was born on the cutoff date of September 1 for starting school and his mother chose to start him in kindergarten a year ahead. Not only that, he also skipped second grade as he was being homeschooled in Alaska.

**BUILDING UP TRAVEL POINTS:** Although he was born in New York City, Morris claims Boulder, Colorado as his hometown. He moved from NYC as a child to Oregon, then to Alaska, and then to Colorado, where he attended Monarch High School in Boulder. He tells people Boulder is where he's from as that's where he lived the longest.

**LET'S GET FUNKY:** Lacking the prototypical build of a frontline starter, Morris' unusual delivery has been noted as a reason why hitters have such a hard time picking up his pitches. Fangraphs prospect writer Eric Longenhagen noted in [last year's mid-season report](#) that "Morris' delivery is weird. He has a high front side throughout his delivery and creates a slight crossfire angle with stride direction before throwing out of a high arm slot. It's rare for cross-bodied pitchers to also have a north/south arm slot this extreme and it seems to disorient hitters."

**CLIMBING THE LADDER:** Before transferring to Texas Tech for his senior year, Morris pitched for three years at Division 2 Colorado Mesa University, helping his team reach the DII National Championship Game in 2019 as a freshman (Mesa finished as Runner-up to Tampa that year). Morris was named the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Freshman of the Year for his efforts that season and was a Division 2 2nd-Team All-American in 2021 before transferring to Texas Tech as a redshirt junior.

**MAD MORRIS:** Morris' mound routine can involve arguing with himself or talking to himself on the mound. "I'm really just analyzing the last pitch, moving on to the next pitch and what it should be," Morris remarked. "Sometimes there are not-so-nice words involved, but really it's 'Trust it. Throw it to the mask' Other times, 'it's good left side, how can we work off of that? What's next, and then next?' There's lots of things going through my head."

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Started on Sunday vs Scranton/Wilkes-Barre at CHS Field. Made a spot start on three days rest for the second time in the series because of a major league call-up (David Festa was called up to join the Twins on Wednesday and Simeon Woods Richardson on Sunday). Gave up four runs in the first inning with back-to-back one out walks each coming around to score on a double by Jose Rojas. Allowed a two-run homer to Brennan Davis in the next at-bat. Retired six of the next nine he faced to throw up scoreless second and third innings. Threw 25 sinkers (38%), 14 changeups (22%), 13 sliders (20%), and 13 four-seamers (20%). Recorded three whiffs, two on the four-seamer and one on the slider. K'd a batter apiece on teh slider and four-seamer.

**THAT'S MISTER SAINT TO YOU:** In 2024, Dobnak eclipsed several single-season pitching records for the Saints franchise. Both Caleb Boushley (134.1) and Dobnak (133.1) exceeded the previous record for innings thrown in a single-season (126.1 by Dobnak in '23), while Dobnak set new single-season franchise marks with 12 wins and 134 strikeouts. Dobnak still holds the single season mark for starts in a season, when he began 33 games on the bump in 2023, four more than Simeon Woods-Richardson's total that same season. Dobnak's 281 Career Strikeouts and 297.2 IP in a St. Paul uniform are both the most in the club's short Triple-A history entering 2025.

**KNOW ANY GOOD PIRATE JOKES? NEITHER DO AYYYYE:** Dobnak grew up a huge Pittsburgh Pirates fan and we would often fo to PNC Park. His favorite food to get there was nachos with pulled pork and cheese. He finally pitched at PNC Park on August 5, 2020. The irony was no fans were allowed in, not even his parents. He tossed 6.0 shutout innings allowing three hits and striking out one.

**A BATTLE(R) OF WILLS:** You can be forgiven if you've never heard of the DII school that Dobnak attended from 2014-17. He spent four years at Alderson Broadus (WV) University, located in Philippi, a town of 3,380. During his time with the Battlers he finished his career as the conference's all-time leader in ERA (2.61) and strikeouts (284). In his sophomore season in 2015, Dobnak threw a no-hitter against Bluefield State.

**TWILIGHT SPARKLE, MEET BUTTERCUP:** Upon graduating from Alderson Broadus, Dobnak went undrafted and was looking for a way to continue his career. He got his break with the Utica Unicorns in the United Shore Professional Baseball League (a four team league where all four teams play in the same ballpark in Utica, MI near Detroit). He signed with them because he caught the eye of manager Jim Essian (a one time Cubs manager in 1981 & also played from 1973-84 in the Majors), whose son played with Dobnak at Alderson Broadus. Dobnak would become the only player to reach the Major League's out of the USPBL.

**THERE'S ALWAYS THAT ONE PERSON:** In order to make ends meet in the USPBL, Dobnak drove for Uber and Lyft. He began driving for both in October, 2017. His Uber rating was stellar, but not perfect. He had a 4.99/5.0 rating which meant he received all five-star ratings with the exception of one four-star rating. According to Dobnak, "I have one four-star. I'm hoping it was a mistake. I don't remember doing anything bad."

**NOTE QUITE MIKE ROWE:** Just prior to joining the big leagues, Dobnak worked as a consultant for Jordan Tax & Accounting Services in Bethel Park, PA (2017), an accounting clerk at Accountant and Associates in PA (2017), pizza delivery for Italian Village Pizza in South Park, PA (2012-13) and supermarket stocker at Foodland in Pittsburgh (2010-12).

**WE'RE BETTER THAN YOU, AND WE KNOW IT:** Dobnak got married to Aerial Munson on September 28, 2019, never thinking he'd be in the Major Leagues. He returned home after the Twins finished a series in Detroit and got married on a Saturday. He wasn't exempt from the rookie ritual of having to dress up in a crazy costume. He had to dress up in a Globo Gym outfit and flew commercial home instead of the chartered flight. He showed up to his fiancées in full attire.
