Looking to Bounce Back

Reading fell to Binghamton 3-1 in 10 innings last night. Reading scored in the second thanks to an Ethan Wilson single and the Ponies tied it up with a run in the seventh, then two in the tenth. David Parkinson was excellent, as the southpaw tossed 6.2 innings, giving up one run on three hits with six strikeouts. Tommy McCollum, McKinley Moore and Orion Kerkering each had scoreless outings prior to extra-innings.

Skipper Milestone Watch

Reading Manager Al Pedrique sits just seven wins shy of 1,000 in his Major/Minor League managerial career. Pedrique's win totals with each organization have been: Royals (102), Astros (158), Diamondbacks (225), Yankees (394), Miami (75) and Phillies (39).

One-Hit Wonder

Friday night was the first time Reading pitching tossed a one-hitter since they did it on Apr. 25, 2019 against New Hampshire. Mauricio Llovera started for Reading, and he was followed by JD Hammer and Garrett Cleavinger in the 2019 game. The one-hit allowed was also a season-low in hits around for Reading in 2023.

Remember Me for Centuries

Carlos De La Cruz is the first player in the Eastern League to register 100 hits on the season. His 108 hits rank first in the league, with 98 from Johan Rojas being the second most. Matthew Kroon's 88 hits are the next most by an active player in the league. De La Cruz also has the following league ranks: AVG (8th), HR (3rd), RBI (T10th), SLG (7th), OPS (8th), 2B (6th), XBH (3rd), TB (1st), R (3rd).

Snapped Decision Streak

With a no-decision last night, David Parkinson's streak of six-straight starts with decisions was snapped, which was the longest streak of such by a Reading starter in 2023. Parkinson was 4-2 over that stretch and in seven starts dating back to June 17, he owns a 3.54 ERA. Parkinson missed all of the 2022 season and has proven to be a steady arm in the Reading rotation as of late.

Around the Organization

The Phillies fell 7-6 to the Pirates last night as Johan Rojas had a hit and RBI, in addition to a diving catch. Lehigh Valley beat Syracuse 4-3 last night as Brett Schulze, Taylor Lehman and Tyler McKay were all strong out of the bullpen. Jersey Shore and Aberdeen were suspended due to rain. Clearwater shutout Jupiter 5-0 thanks to seven-shutout innings from Estibenzon Jimenez, while Justin Crawford doubled and had three RBI.

Ponies Rumbling into Town

Binghamton enters today with an 11-14 record in the second half and 46-48 overall record in 2023. Binghamton split a six-game series last week at home against Erie, posting wins on Wednesday, Thursday and Sunday. After this week, the Rumble Ponies return home for a six-game series against New Hampshire. Jose Peroza leads the team offensively with a .263 average and 47 RBI entering today. Binghamton ranks last in the Eastern League with a .224 average and is 8th with a 4.35 ERA. Luke Ritter is currently with triple-A Syracuse after a strong start with Binghamton.

Righty Jose Chacin will make his second-start of the week for Binghamton, after pitching just one-inning in a rain-shortened contest Tuesday. In 2023, Chacin is 2-5 with a 4.90 ERA. Acorss 60.2 innings, he's allowed 54 hits, walked just 17 batters and has 53 strikeouts. He also made one appearence with triple-A Syracuse, allowing four-earned runs over four innings. Chacin split 2022 between high-A Brooklyn and Binghamton, combining to go 4-10 with a 5.05 ERA, which included a 4-9 record with Binghamton. He signed with the Dodgers in 2015 as an International Free Agent at 18-years old out of Venezuela. He was then released by the Dodgers in April of 2021 and later signed with the Mets in June of 2021. The now-26-year old worked his way up to high-A Brooklyn in 2021.
