#### JACKSONVILLE AND NASHVILLE POSTPONED

Saturday's scheduled contest between the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp and the Nashville Sounds was postponed due to unplayable field conditions.

#### THE SOUND(S) OF MUSIC

After owning the Nashville Sounds in 2021 with a 5-1 record, the Jumbo Shrimp struggled in 2022 against the eventual IL West Champs. In 18 contests last season, Jacksonville finished six games below .500, winning just six total affairs for a .333 winning percentage. Nashville owned Jumbo Shrimp pitching, slashing .303/.373/.451/.824 with 42 XBHs (21 2B 1 3B 20 HR) Of the 10 International League teams the Jumbo Shrimp matched up against in 2022, the pitching staff owned the second-worst ERA (5.52) against Nashville.

#### GO C.J., GO C.J., GO C.J., GO

On Jacksonville's slugging offense, perhaps no one has shined more than C.J. Hinojosa. Through 14 games thus far in 2023, Hinojosa is 21-for-61, slashing a robust .344/.379/.656/1.035 with two doubles, one triple, five home runs, 17 RBIs and eight runs scored. The Houston native ranks tied for fifth in the International League in RBIs, tied for 13th in batting average, 12th in slugging, tied for 12th in home runs, 16th in OPS and tied for 13th in hits. The Houston. Texas native has hits in seven of his last nine games entering play on Sunday.

#### THE \*START\* OF SOMETHING?

Jacksonville starting pitchers have ceded three runs or fewer in nine of their last 10 games. During that span, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have yielded 19 runs, 17 earned, on 45 hits in 50.2 innings for a 3.02 ERA. This stretch has not seen Jacksonville starters strike out many opponents, with the club's rotation registered just 33 punchouts (5.9 K/9). However, they have only issued 12 walks during this run, a rate of 2.1 per nine innings.

#### RUBBER MATCHES

The Jumbo Shrimp are looking for their first series win since Opening Weekend against the Stripers. Jacksonville lost their rubber match at home against Durham. With a win today, they'd clinch their first home series win of 2023.

#### BYF-BYF BURDICK

Coming into 2023, Peyton Burdick hadn't recorded a multihomer game since bashing two in Biloxi on August 4, 2021 while playing for Double-A Pensacola. The Cincinnati native has already registered two multi-homer games this season , and his eight on the season lead the International League. Burdick is third in the IL in extra-base hits (12), tied for eighth in hits (23), tied for second in RBIs (18), tied for eigth in runs scored (17), eighth in slugging (.689) and 14th in OPS (1.067). Without recording a hit on Friday. Burdick's teamleading 15-game hitting streak came to a close.

#### LEADERS. NOT FOLLOWERS

The Jumbo Shrimp weren't able to get a first inning tally on April 14, which ended their streak of five consecutive games with a first inning run. Still though, over their 18 games played, the Jumbo Shrimp have struck for at least one tally in their first at-bats 10 times. Jacksonville has scored first over their opponent in nine of their 18 games thus far in 2023, going 7-2 (.778) when doing so. Conversely, the club has struggled when falling behind, going just 1-5 (.167). The Jumbo Shrimp scored the game's first run 83 times during the 2022 season (55.7 percent) and had a 62-21 (.747) record when doing so.

#### CHUGGA CHUGGA CHI CHI

Chi Chi González makes his fifth start of the season tonight and fifth career start against the Nashville Sounds. Tonight will be just the second time he faces them as a member of the Marlins organization. In four career starts. González owns a 3-1 record with a 2.57 against the Sounds. In his first start on Tuesday, González tallied seven scoreless frames with four strikeouts on 93 pitches, his longest start in 2022 and longest since his June 5, 2015 where he tossed a threehit shutout on the road against the Kansas City Royals.

#### SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has 13 stolen bases over the last seven games since April 11, tied for the most in the International League during that span. The Jumbo Shrimp are 13-for-14 (92.9 percent) on their stolen base attempts during that span... Jacksonville's 39 walks over the last week, since April 11 are second in the circuit. The Jumbo Shrimp mustered just 25 in their first eight games, the second-fewest in the league.

-GONZAALEZ was called up to the majors for the first time on May 30, 2015, and made his major league debut that day. He faced the veteran lineup of the Boston Red Sox and began the game pitching 5 2/3 innings without surrendering a hit. It was the longest no-hit stretch to begin a career for a Rangers pitcher since 1992.

-The Baltimore Orioles selected González in the 11th round of the 2010 Major League Baseball draft. Rather than sign with the Orioles, González attended Oral Roberts University, where he played college baseball for the Oral Roberts Golden Eagles.

-GONZÁLEZ starred at Oral Roberts University, where he is now in the University's Hall of Fame. He earned many accoldaes such as 2011 Collegiate Baseball and NCBWA Freshman All-American, 2x Pitcher of the Year (Summi League and Southland Conference) and finished second in the NCAA in 2013 with 126 strikeouts.

#### -GONZÁLEZ posted an 0-1 record with a 5.87 ERA in the 2022 regular season.

-GONZÁLEZ made Colorado's Opening Day roster and began season in Rockies bullpen.

-GONZÁLEZ then made a move to the starting roatation starting April 10, making seven starts for the Rockies.

-In his first stint in the rotation, Chi Chi went 1-4, 8.23 ERA (50.1 IP, 46 ER) through his last 11 starts (Rockies 4-7) from June 10 through his final start on Sept. 7. He was then placed on Injured List with a right oblique strain Sept. 8-Oct. 2 before electing to free agency.

-GONZÁLEZ made four starts and two relief appearances in his second season with Colorado. posting a Went 0-2 with a 6.86 ERA (19.2 IP, 15 ER), 10 walks and 16 strikeouts
