GETTING ALL THE SMOKE: Friday's scheduled series opener between the Whitecaps and Great Lakes Loons (51-33) at Dow Diamond was postponed due to insufficient air quality from the Canadian Wildfires moving across the region throughout the week. In consultation with local weather and health officials for the safety of fans and players and per MLB safety guidelines, the decision was made to postpone Friday's contest. Throughout the day, the City of Midland registered air quality readings between 230 and 300, putting the surrounding air in a 'Very Unhealthy to Hazardous' category, according to AccuWeather. This became the first Whitecaps game to be postponed due to air quality since a game was shelved between the Whitecaps and Dayton Dragons at LMCU Ballpark on June 27, 2023.

'CAPS FALL SHORT LAST SUNDAY, 9-1: The West Michigan Whitecaps couldn't get the bats going as part of a 9-1 loss to the Fort Wayne TinCaps in front of 6,257 fans Sunday afternoon at LMCU Ballpark, entering the MLB All-Star Break with a second-half record of 12-9. TinCaps catcher Oswaldo Linares and infielder Justin DeCrisio combined to drive in all nine Fort Wayne runs while the team went 6-for-12 with runners in scoring position. Meanwhile, the 'Caps went 0-for-8 with runners at second and third base and hit into three double plays in the defeat.

BABY STEPS: The Month of May saw the Whitecaps post a combined record of 4-23, but June is starting to see a turnaround of sorts. However, the 'Caps were able to right the ship in June, finishing 14-9 while their parent club, the Detroit Tigers went 6-22 in May and finished the month of June 15-11. In July, the Whitecaps are 6-5.

SKUBAL'S WEST MICHIGAN CAMEO: Defending two-time American League Cy Young Award-winner pitcher Tarik Skubal dazzled in a Major League Rehab Assignment with the West Michigan Whitecaps as they blanked the Dayton Dragons 8-0 in front of 8,967 fans on June 7 at LMCU Ballpark. Skubal saw his first live game action since undergoing arthroscopic surgery on May 4, and he didn't skip a beat, throwing 44 of 54 pitches for strikes while completing five shutout innings with six strikeouts in the victory. West Michigan secured its first series win since completing a six-game sweep of the Lansing Lugnuts with a 12-4 win on April 19. Skubal is now back and pitching for the Detroit Tigers.

RAINER, JACOBS LEAD TIGERS PROSPECTS IN WEST MICHIGAN: Infielder Bryce Rainer (No. 2, MLB Pipeline) was added to the Whitecaps roster on April 21 after a strong showing during spring training. The 20-year old is fully recovered from a shoulder injury that limited him to just 35 games last season after becoming the #11 overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft -- taken just two spots behind Pirates SS and MLB's No. 1 Prospect, Konnor Griffin. The California native currently sits as the No. 46 MLB Prospect by MLB Pipeline. The left-handed hitting shortstop that's drawn comparisons to Corey Seager joins left-handed pitcher Ben Jacobs (No. 6, Baseball America), righty Lucas Elissalt (No. 17) and OF Jackson Strong (No. 26) as the other MiLB Prospects listed inside the Detroit Tigers Pipeline Top-30.

STILL GOT THAT PITCHING: Despite the Whitecaps early-season struggles, the 'Caps still sit with a Top-4 team ERA in the Midwest League. Last year, the 'Caps posted the lowest earned run average in the Midwest League (3.17) with the next closest team in the Quad Cities River Bandits coming in at 3.29. Pitching Coach Dan Ricabal, now back for his third season with West Michigan, has guided his pitching staff to a Top-5 team ERA in each of his three seasons with the club.

LORD OF TWO RINGS: The Whitecaps won the 2025 Midwest League Championship on September 16, 2025 with a 3-1 win over the Cedar Rapids Kernels. Coincidentally, the Lakeland Flying Tigers won the Florida State League title the exact same night, leading a handful of Whitecaps players who played for both teams throughout the season to collect a second championship ring, including infielders Woody Hadeen and Garrett Pennington, and outfielder Jackson Strong. The rings were given out before a Detroit Tigers Spring Training game by President of Baseball Operations Scott Harris back in March.

AWARDS SEASON: To finish off the historic 2025 season, the Whitecaps had numerous players collect postseason honors. Infielder Kevin McGonigle, now playing for the Detroit Tigers, was named the Midwest League Prospect of the Year, while infielder Izaac Pacheco became the 4th player in franchise history to win Midwest League MVP. Pacheco joins Robert Fick, Gorkys Hernandez, and Wynton Bernard as league MVP's. Infielder John Peck and Pitcher Colin Fields both made the Post-Season All-Star Team, while manager Tony Cappuccilli was named Midwest League Manager of the Year. Moreover, René Rivera, the 2026 Whitecaps skipper, collected the Florida State League Manager of the Year honors while leading the Lakeland Flying Tigers to a Florida State League Title.

FOR WEST MICHIGAN: RHP Carlos Marcano makes his 10th start and 16th appearance of the season for the Whitecaps after giving up four runs through just two innings with three walks, taking the defeat in a 6-3 loss to the Fort Wayne TinCaps on July 10th. Marcano got off to a terrific start this season, allowing a combined seven earned runs from the beginning of the season through the end of May, but has struggled since, most recently posting an 18.56 ERA in July (11 ER in 5.1 IP) (MORE INFO ON PAGE 2). RHP Charlie Christensen makes his third start for the Whitecaps after giving up one run through four innings pitched and five strikeouts in a narrow 6-5 loss to the Lake County Captains on July 4th. The Tigers 15th-round selection in the 2025 MLB Draft out of Central Arkansas posted some eye-popping strikeout numbers with the Lakeland Flying Tigers - collecting 56 strikeouts to eight walks through 35.1 innings pitched while posting a sub .200 BAA (.181) on the season between both Lakeland and West Michigan (MORE INFO ON PAGE 3). **The Whitecaps have a scheduled bullpen day for the series finale on Sunday.**

Marcano, who was signed by the Tigers as an international free agent in 2021 (the same class that featured Cristian Santana) was the youngest pitcher in the Florida State League to surpass 20 innings pitched in 2023.

2025: Marcano enjoyed his best season with the Whitecaps last year, going 2-1 while posting a 3.19 ERA through 36.2 innings of work. Despite posting some of his best numbers last year, Marcano still struggled to generate swing-and-miss, only registering a 19:24 walk-to-strikeout ratio while allowing consistent contact (.263 BAA).

2024: Marcano had a very up-and-down season as the youngest starter in the Midwest League - finishing 3-11 with a 3.86 ERA (lowest mark of his career) but he struggled with hard contact, finishing with a WHIP of 1.41. However, he controlled the strike zone well, allowing, on average, just three walks per nine innings pitched.

2023: After being a full-time member of the Flying Tigers bullpen the year prior, Marcano pitched well once again, limiting toe Peoria Chiefs to just two runs (one aired) in five innings in earning the win in the 'Caps 5-3 win over the Peoria Chiefs on May 22 at Dozer Park.

2022: Marcano came out of the bullpen in his first season with the Flying Tigers but struggled with hard contact, posting a 4.68 ERA while giving up 47 hits through 42.1 innings pitched. However, his strikeout-to-walk ratio stood out, generating 41 punchouts to just 18 walks on the season.

2021: Marcano enjoyed his breakout in the Dominican Summer League. Despite a 5.25 ERA, he displayed his ability to rack up his strikeout totals, punching out 41 hitters while allowing just 10 walks through 36 innings of work.

Scouting Report: His repertoire includes a sinker/fastball, two breaking balls, and a changeup. The fastball/sinker is his primary pitch that sits in the low 90s which he's able to generate a ton of ground balls with. The two breaking balls are a curveball and a slider. The slider posted a 54% whiff rate in 2023, while the curveball posted a 36%.
