YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox swept the doubleheader against the Portland Sea Dogs, winning game one 4-3 in eight innings and winning game two 2-1. Tavian Josenberger notched a pair of RBI, including a go-ahead RBI single in the eighth in game one. Preston Johnson struck out five in three scoreless innings of relief. In game two, Adam Retzbach drove in the go-ahead run with a double and the bullpen of Edgar Portes, Yaqui Rivera, and Gerald Ogando combined for 4.1 shutout innings.

CREED CRUSHES

C Creed Willems is on a six-game hit streak and has hit safely in 16 of his last 17 games. The Orioles No. 12 prospect has a .968 OPS over his last 10 games and is tied for third in the league in doubles with nine on the regular season. The Aledo, TX native has not struck out in his last 26 plate appearances. The 21-year-old is the youngest position player on the team.

ACTION JACKSON

IF Jeremiah Jackson is second on the team in hits (25) and is tied for fifth in the league in doubles (8). Jackson has struck out only 18 times in 112 total plate appearances (16.1% strikeout rate), while averaging a 27.5% strikeout rate in his career. The former Angels and Mets farmhand is three homers away from 100 on his career.

WALK THIS WAY

C Silas Ardoin leads the Eastern League in walks (24). In game one of Wednesday's doubleheader, Ardoin matched his career-high with four walks drawn. No player has drawn more walks in the Eastern League since April 23 than Ardoin. Last season, he drew 47 walks in 104 games.

TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE

OF Doug Hodo has collected a hit in five consecutive games and is batting .417 (5-for-12) with a double, two homers and four RBI to start the month of May. The 24-year-old began the season on a 16-game on-base streak, which is tied for the longest in the Eastern League. The Orioles 6th rounder in 2022 is tied for fourth in the league in walks (19) and is 11th in OBP (.396).

GOING LONG

RHP Ryan Long is set to make his sixth start of the season. The 25-year-old owns the lowest ERA by a qualified Baysox starter this season at just 2.35. The Orioles 17th rounder in 2021 faced Portland twice in 2023 and holds a 8.00 career ERA in nine innings pitched against the Sea Dogs.

BULLPEN BEASTS

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 2.84 ERA, which is third-best in the Eastern League and fourth-best in all of Double-A. The relievers have thrown 13.1 consecutive scoreless innings over the last three games, dating back to Sunday.

ONE RUN WONDERS

Despite having scored the third-fewest runs in all of Double-A (93), Chesapeake currently leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in one-run victories with 11 so far this season.

SIZING UP THE SEA DOGS

The Portland Sea Dogs are the Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. The Sea Dogs played two doubleheaders last week in New Hampshire and won five of eight in Manchester. Portland's active roster features six Red Sox Top 30 prospects (MLB. com): OF Jhostynxon Garcia (No. 6), RHP David Sandlin (No. 9), LHP Connelly Early (No. 10), IF Mikey Romero (No. 12), RHP Yordanny Monegro (No. 24), and RHP Blake Wehunt (No. 28).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Blake Wehunt makes his fifth start of the season for Portland. The Red Sox No. 28 prospect has a 3.57 ERA in 17.2 innings pitched and has only walked five hitters. The 24-year-old split last season between Single-A Salem and High-A Greenville and punched out 110 batters, which was 9th-most in the Red Sox system. Wehunt was drafted by the Red Sox in the 9th round of the 2023 Draft out of Kennesaw State.

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. The New Britain, CT native also managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he led them to a league-best 18-10 record and a Fall League Championship Game appearance.

Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

JORDIE HENRY

Pitching Coach

Jordie Henry enters his first season as Baysox Pitching Coach in 2025 and his third season as a member of the Orioles' system. Previously, Henry served as the pitching coach at High-A Aberdeen where his staff recorded 1,357 strikeouts last season – 2nd-most in the South Atlantic League and 2nd-most in IronBirds franchise history. Before joining the Orioles, Henry was the Director of Pitching at Prime Sports Performance in Baltimore – a private athletic development training facility. He also worked as a pitching coach and instructor at the high school and summer collegiate levels. Henry pitched collegiately for four seasons at Wayland Baptist University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Josh Bunselmeyer returns for his second season as Baysox Hitting Coach in 2025 and his sixth as a member of the Orioles' system. He joined the Baysox as hitting coach in 2024, after filling the same role for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, in 2023. He spent the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. Bunselmeyer played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at St. Louis University.

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
