FROM THE CROWS NEST

LAST TIME OUT: **Braylon Bishop's** three-run home run in the seventh inning lifted the Bradenton Marauders to a 3-2 victory over the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels on Wednesday night. **Antwone Kelly** allowed just one run in five innings of work to start. **Mike Walsh** threw another scoreless frame to earn his first win of the season, **Magdiel Cotto** picked up his third save of the year.

DON'T MESS WITH THE BULL: Since last Tuesday (May 21), the Bradenton Marauders bullpen has allowed just nine earned runs in 34.2 innings, which is good for a 2.34 ERA, the third-best in Single-A and 14th-best in MiLB during this span. The bullpen has allowed just one run in seven frames this week against Fort Myers.

BEST OF MAY: Entering Thursday, the Bradenton Marauders' pitching staff owns the best ERA in the Florida State League at 3.24 in the month of May. The 3.24 ERA is the fifth-best in Single-A. They also rank third in the FSL with 252 strikeouts in 222.1 innings, trailing the Dunedin Blue Jays who have racked up 279 in 222.1 frames.

HE JUST GETS ON BASE: With a pair of walks on Wednesday, **C Omar Alfonzo** extended his on-base streak to 14 games. During his streak, the Pirates' No. 28 prospect is slashing .289/.484/.356 with three doubles, five RBIs, 17 walks, two intentional walks, and six runs scored. Since May 11 when the streak began, only Brock Vradenburg (JUP) has more walks in the FSL with 19. It's also good for the third-most in Minor League baseball.

FLYING AROUND: Last Wednesday night, the Marauders stole a season-high five bases against the Dunedin Blue Jays. In the series against the Blue Jays, Bradenton finished a near perfect 14-for-15 in stolen base attempts, the 10th-most in MiLB during this span. The Lynchburg Hillcats (Single-A, CLE) swiped 19 in 23 attempts to lead the way last week. The lone man caught was Keiner Delgado on Sunday on their only attempt of the game. Since last Tuesday, Bradenton is 16-for-17 in stolen base attempts with only Lakeland swiping more bags in the FSL (21).

HELLO AGAIN: The Marauders continue their first road trip to Hammond Stadium of the season. Bradenton won five of six games against Fort Myers at the beginning of May as a part of their franchise-record 11-game winning streak that began on May 2. Last season, Bradenton recorded a 7-5 record in Fort Myers and won the last two games to end the year.

CHECKMATE: Over the last seven games, **Of Braylon Bishop** has been a tough out at the plate. The Marauders outfielder is 10-for-28 with two doubles, a triple, two HRs, 10 RBIs, and seven runs scored. Bishop played in just four games before being placed on the injured list on April 12. He was activated last Monday and played in two games during last week's series. The home run last Tuesday was Bishop's first since 8/21/23 against the FCL Rays.

HERE COMES THE POWER: The Marauders clubbed a home run on Wednesday to bring their team total up to a 20 home runs in 25 games during the month of May, the second-most in the FSL with the Dunedin Blue Jays in front at 24. It's also the fourth-most HR in Single-A with Dunedin in first.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Wednesday's victory marked the Marauders 20th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own a 11-9 record in those games with 35 of their first 47 (74.5%) games having been decided by three runs or less.

GOT EM!: **Hunter Furtado** picked off Poncho Ruiz in the seventh inning on Tuesday night for the Marauders 14th pickoff of the season. As of Thursday, the Marauders are currently tied for third in MiLB, with the Quad Cities River Bandits (High-A, KC) leading the way with 17. Bradenton had 23 last season, which ranked the second-most in the FSL and 11th-most in MiLB.

Last Time Out: Allowed a season-high three runs in four innings against Dunedin last Thursday. After a scoreless first, a walk and error began the inning before a steal of home scored first run. In the third, a one-out single led to an inside the park home run from Cristian Feliz to tie the game at three.

2024 Highlights:

- Named Opening Day starter. Struck out a career-high six batters in four innings of work. Four of the five runners left on-base were in scoring position.
- Struck out a career-high eight vs DAY (4/20)
- In a career-high six innings, allowed just one run in a 3-1 win vs Tampa (5/16)...also needed just 69 pitches in his outing. Became second Marauder this season, joining Michael Kennedy, to toss six innings.
- **Enters start on 5/30 with the second-best GB% in the Pirates org. and seventh-best in the FSL among pitchers who at least 30.0 innings thrown. Dominic Perach (GBO) owns a 55.8 GB% to lead the org.**

Personal:

- Enters the 2024 season as the Pirates' No. 26 prospect per Baseball America...moved up to No. 25 in May re-rankings.
- Became the first player from WVU to be drafted by the Pirates since Kim West in 1972.
- Became the highest-drafted Mountaineer since Alek Manoah was selected 11th overall by the Blue Jays in 2019.
- At WVU: Was an All-Big 12 first-team selection in 2023...went 2-1 with seven saves, a 2.61 ERA (38.0 IP, 11 ER) and 60 strikeouts in 25 appearances in 2023.
- Made three appearances (three starts) for the WV Black Bears and the Trenton Thunder in the 2023 in the MLB Draft League.
- Named to 2023 National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Stopper-of-the-Year Award watch list.
- Was West Virginia's Opening Day Starter in 2022 against Central Michigan.
- Inspiration to become a pitcher came from older players such as Satchel Paige. Read a few books about him growing up and took an interest.
- Grew up playing the saxophone.
