Justin Crawford has 14 stolen bases since

May 17<sup>th</sup> and leads the team with 24.

Last Time Out... Greensboro scored three runs in the 10<sup>th</sup> inning on a wild pitch, error, and walk, and topped the BlueClaws 4-2 on Thursday night at ShoreTown Ballpark...The BlueClaws got a run back in the bottom of the inning but Aidan Miller flew out to center with two men on base to end the game ... Erick Brito had two hits for the BlueClaws...Casey Steward, in his Jersey Shore debut, gave up one run in five innings and struck out a career high nine.

State of the BlueClaws...The BlueClaws are 1-2 this week but are 13-6 since June 6th, a stretch that began with four straight wins in Greensboro to move into first place with nine games left in the first half (though GBO would go on to win the first half)...Since May 1s, the Blue Claws are 32-18, and only two Minor League teams (Omaha, AAA Royals and Kannapolis, A White Sox) have more wins in that period.

Hopping Into ShoreTown...Greensboro makes their lone visit to Lakewood this season (Greensboro leads 2-1)...The BlueClaws went 4-2 in North Carolina from June 4<sup>th</sup> - 9<sup>th</sup> but the Grasshoppers then went 8-1 to finish the first half and nose out the BlueClaws for a playoff spot...GBO went 5-1 against Hudson Valley last week and won 10 of 12 games entering this series...Greensboro was a Marlins affiliate from 2003-2018 and became a Pirates affiliate in 2019

Go Go Brito...Erick Brito is 6-14 in this series and enters today on a five game hitting streak over which he is 9-20 with two doubles and an inside-the-park home run...He is up to .272 on the season after hitting .208 with the BlueClaws last year across 65 games after joining on June 13th from Clearwater...He turned 22 on May 25th

Drive 'Em In Felix ... Felix Reyes hit his fourth home run of the season on Thursday - three of them have come since June 16<sup>th</sup>...He has driven in nine runs in his last eight games including a go-ahead three-run home run on June 16' against Wilmington, a solo home run June 21st at Brooklyn, and then drove in four runs in a win on June 22nd at Brooklyn...He had 14 RBIs in his first 38 games this season before the current stretch...His three recent home runs were his first since April 9th at Hickory, the fourth game of the season...He hit 10 last year, nine with Clearwater and one with the BlueClaws.

Hot Start for Keaton...Keaton Anthony had two hits on Wednesday, including an RBI single, in his BlueClaws debut...He was hitting .322 in 44 games with Clearwater, joined the BlueClaws on Tuesday...Anthony added four home runs and 21 RBIs with the Threshers, and drew 28 walks in 186 plate appearances while striking out only 28 times...At the time of his promotion, led the Florida State League in OBP (.446) and OPS (.916) while third in SLG (.470) and fourth in BA (.322)...He signed as an NDFA from the University of Iowa in 2023 after three years with the Hawkeyes.

Dissin It Over the Wall...Jordan Dissin hit his team-best ninth home run of the season on Tuesday night after homering on Saturday in Brooklyn...Six of his home runs have come since May 31<sup>st</sup> and five have come since June 9<sup>th</sup>...He hit a grand slam in a June 11<sup>th</sup> win over Wilmington and another home run on Father's Day...He is 16-50 since May 31<sup>st</sup> with six home runs...Dissin was a 12<sup>th</sup> round pick in 2022 from Saddleback College in California after playing at Malvern Prep outisde of Philadelphia and spent one season at the University of Richmond

Hello Aidan...Aidan Miller had two hits on Sunday in Brooklyn and has drawn nine walks in 60 appearances with the BlueClaws already...He hit his first Sally League home run on Father's Day and hit five with Clearwater before his promotion... Miller joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater on June 11th, where he was hitting .275 with five home runs, 26 RBIs, 16 doubles, and 10 stolen bases...His .483 SLG and his .884 OPS were both second in the Florida State League at the time of his promotion...Miller, the 27 overall pick in last year's draft, played at Mitchell High School in Trinity, Florida, 19.6 miles from Baycare Ballpark, home of the Clearwater Threshers, and was the 27<sup>st</sup> overall pick in the 2023 draft.

King George Wins SAL Pitcher of the Week...George Klassen's five hitless innings on Saturday night earned him South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week and marked the fifth time a BlueClaw has thrown at least five hitless innings since the team became a High-A affiliate in 2021: Mitch Neunborn (twice, 8/31/23 vs ABD and 8/17/23 vs ASH), Tyler McKay (six innings on 8/14/21 at HV), and Kevin Gowdy (six innings on 6/24/21 at BRK)...Klassen was a 6<sup>th</sup> round pick last year out of the University of Minnesota...He has struck out 13 in nine innings over two games with the BlueClaws.

Walk This Way ... So far in June: Erick Brito has 17 walks in 93 plate appearances... William Bergolla has 11 walks in 72 plate appearances (against just three strikeouts)... Aidan Miller (BlueClaws-only) has nine walks in 60 plate appearances.

Welcome to the Claws, Jaydenn Estanista ... RHP Jayden Estanista, a pitcher from Curacao, joined the BlueClaws on June 20th from Clearwater and threw a scoreles inning in his BlueClaws debut on Sunday, striking out two...The righthander was 1-0 with a 3.77 ERA with the Threshers, striking out 44 and walking 21 in 31 innings pitched...He pitched for the Netherlands in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

William The Kid ... William Bergolla is 45-122 (.371) since he entered the April 30th game at .145 for the year ... In June, Beroglla is 24-57 with 11 walks and three strikeouts...He had two hits and two SBs in the win on Wednesday night...He is the BlueClaws youngest player (19) and tied the BlueClaws record with five hits in the win on June 9th (he is the 10th BlueClaw with five hits in a game and first since Emmanuel Marrero in 2016)...He hit his first professional home run on June 8th ... He is 37-92 (.405) in his last 26 starts... The #12 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline. Bergolla is one of just six 19 year olds to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A affiliate (including teammates Justin Crawford and Bryan Rincon who were 19 when they debuted with Jersey Shore last year and have since turned 20).

Crawford on a Tear...Justin Crawford is 23-75 in his last 17 games with nine multi-hit games (two stretches of four

Going Going Gone...The BlueClaws (20 HRs in Lakewood and 28 on the road) got a home run from Jordan Dissin and an inside-the-park home run from Erick Brito on Tuesday and a solo blast from Felix Reves on Thursday against Greensboro...Dissin leads the team with nine and Leandro Pineda has seven...Felix Reyes has four, three since June 16th ... William Bergolla hit his first professional home run on June 8th at Greensboro.

Hitting Triple Digits ... A South Atlantic League starting pitcher has thrown 100 pitches seven times in a game this season - all seven are BlueClaws...Sam Aldegheri has done it three times (including 103 on June 13th), Jean Cabrera has done it three times (including a league-high 110 on Wednesday at Brooklyn), and Braeden Fausnaught has done it once...Cabrera's 110 pitches are the most by a BlueClaw since Nick Fanti threw 113 in two no-hitters in 2017 (7/17 vs CHA, 26 outs in a 5/6/17 no-hitter at COL), not incluing Matt Russell, who threw 125 pitches in eight innings against ABD in 2022 but pitched three innings in April and the remaining five in June after the game was suspended.

Save Index...Daniel Harper (now with Reading) leads the BlueClaws with seven saves and earned his seventh on June 19th at Brooklyn...Andrew Walling earned his third save of the year in the win on June 22<sup>nd</sup>... Gunner Mayer has three...Andrew Walling and Charles King each have two.

The Comeback Claws...Jersey Shore erased a 5-0 deficit on June 8th at Greensboro and a 4-0 deficit on June 15th to come back and beat Wilmington...On June 15th, Troy Schreffler doubled home two runs to tie the game and Justin Crawford gave the BlueClaws the lead with a line drive RBI single to centerfield...Their largest comeback win last year was six (5/24/23 at Aberdeen in a game they trailed 8-2 and won 12-10).

Just Grand...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they have three grand slams since May 30<sup>th</sup> - one by Justin Crawford (May 30<sup>th</sup>), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9<sup>th</sup>), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11<sup>th</sup>)...Boyd's home run was the second of his career while Dissin's was his sixth home run of the season.

Strike 'em Out Danny...LHP Danny Wilkinson, a Scotch Plains native, has 34 strikeouts in just 19.2 innings this season...Last year, he fanned 106 batters in 56.2 innings with Clearwater...Wilkinson signed with the Phillies in 2022 out of Villanova.

Go Go Gunner...Gunner Mayer has earned his first three professional saves over the last few weeks (two at Aberdeen between May 21st and 26<sup>th</sup> and May 28<sup>th</sup> against Brooklyn)...He has moved to the bullpen this year and struck out 36 batters in 28 innings (36 of the 114 batters he faced)...Last year as a starter, Mayer had a 5.47 ERA with 79 strikeouts in 77.1 innings pitched...He was a 5<sup>th</sup> round pick in 2019 from San Joaquin Delta JC (CA).

Trying For Back to Back ... The BlueClaws have only made the playoffs in back to back years once - in 2009 and 2010, both SAL Championship seasons...They have a chance to do so again this year after reaching the SAL Northern Division Championship Series last year.

Youth Is Served ... Per Baseball America, the BlueClaws have five of the 25 youngest players in the South Atlantic League (based on Opening Day rosters of 360 players): William Bergolla (3rd youngest), Bryan Rincon (9<sup>th</sup>), Justin Crawford (11<sup>th</sup>), Hendry Mendez (17<sup>th</sup>), and Emmaarion Boyd (21<sup>st</sup>).

In the First Round ... Aidan Miller is the 16th former first-round pick to play for the and the fifth to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A team)...(his teammate Justin Cr 2024, Andrew Painter and Mick Abel in 2022 and Bryson Stott in 2021)... Since 2000, the only two Phillies first round picks not to play for the BlueClaws are Joe Savery (2007) and Aaron Nola (2014) plus 2023 first-round pick Aidan Miller, who is currently with Clearwater.

Go Phils...The BlueClaws have several players that grew up Phillies fans: C Jordan Dissin (went to Malvern Prep in Philadelphia, 27 miles from Citizens Bank Park), OF Troy Schreffler (from Harrisburg), and LHP Braeden Fausnaught (from Danville and went to West Chester University)

# Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws had an Opening Night walk-off win when Emaarion Boyd scored on a wild pitch...They had eight walkoff wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run

to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

From The Shore to the Show...123 players have now gone From the Shore, to the Show including one this year (Ben Brown, Cubs)...Three debuted in 2023 – James McArthur with the Royals, Johan Rojas with the Phillies, and Orion Kerkering with the Phillies...Kerkering, who was with the BlueClaws from May 9th through July 6th, is the only player to play for the BlueClaws and Phillies in the same year.

On the Staff...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2024 after leading the BlueClaws to the playoffs and a league-best 73-58 mark in 2023...Pitching coach Brad Bergesen is in Lakewood for a third time (2018 and 2022) and is joined as a pitching coach by first-year Phillies coach Matt Ellmyer...Hitting coach Adam Lind hit 200 big league home runs and is in his first year as a coach...Position coach Orlando Munoz is in his first year with the BlueClaws after managing the DSL Phillies since 2017... Development coach Beth Greenwood is the first BlueClaws female position coach and a member of Team USA Women's National Baseball Team.

How Acquired: Amateur Free Agent, signed 7/2019

Season Notes: Earned win with six scoreless innings, eight strikeouts on 6/19 at BRK...Fanned a career-high 14 on 6/12 vs WIL (tied for the 2nd most in Claws history)...Threw seven innings (one run) for the second straight start on 5/7 vs BG (only Andrew Painter, 2022, has done so as a BlueClaw since the team moved to High-A in 2021)...Gave up three runs over career-long seven innings on 4/30 vs BG (the first BC pitcher to throw seven innings in April since Adonis Medina on 4/21/2017)...Threw six scoreless innings, matching US long, on 4/18 vs BRK...Struck out 10 over five scoreless innings to earn second win on 4/12 at HIC...Gave up one run in five innings of Claws debut on 4/6 vs ABD, earning win...On Opening Day roster.

Career Notes: Spent 2023 with Clearwater, going 5-7 with a 4.32 ERA, adding an 86/22 K/BB ratio in 81.1 innings...His 3.9 K/BB ratio was second in the FSL among pitchers with at least 80 innings pitched...Gave up one run in 12.1 innings over two postseason starts...In 2022, went 2-4, 5.24 with Clearwater...Won the Paul Owens Award in 2021 after he went 3-2, 1.54 in the Dominican Summer League...Was the first 19 year old pitcher to win the Paul Owens Award since Carlos Carrasco in 2006.

Had two hits and two RBIs in 6/1 win vs BRK...Had three hits and two RBIs in 5/26 win at ABD...Had three hits and three RBIs in 5/18 win at HV...Had four hits and scored three runs in 4/6 win vs ABD...Entered the season as the Phillies #12 prospect per MLB Pipeline...Opening Day age of 19 years, 5 months, and 17 days makes him the second youngest BlueClaw debuter since the team moved to High-A in 2021 behind only Andrew Painter (19 years, 2 months 2 days in 2022).
