NEWS AND NOTES:

- Last Time Out:** The Peoria Chiefs earned their fourth consecutive win Tuesday as they pulled away from the Great Lakes Loons 7-1 in the series opener. **Todd Lott** and **Wade Stauss** combined for five of the nine Chiefs hits and drove in four runs as a tandem. **Inohan Paniagua** earned his first career High-A win after logging a quality start.
- Stay Hot!:** The Peoria offense remains one of the Midwest League's best since the All-Star break. Since July 22, Peoria is near the top in every major offensive category. The Chiefs have scored 102 runs over 16 games since the break, most in the Midwest League. Peoria also leads the MWL in OBP (.376). Additionally, the Chiefs rank second in batting average (.272), OPS (.811) and are third in SLG (.435). Their 20 home runs are tied for fourth most over that time frame. Since the All-Star break, the Chiefs are 11-5. Only the Beloit Sky Carp have more wins since July 22.
- Streaks Galore:** In the midst of perhaps their best stretch of the season, the Chiefs will put a myriad of streaks on the line Wednesday. Peoria will most notably put their four-game winning streak to the test. Over the course of their four-game stretch, the Chiefs have outscored their opponents 31-8. The Chiefs will also look for their seventh consecutive victory over Great Lakes Loons and their 12th road win in 14 tries as Peoria aims for its third straight road series win.
- Leaders of the Pack:** While the Chiefs have enjoyed plenty of team success, a couple of individuals have keyed Peoria's fine run of baseball of late. Since the All-Star break, **Todd Lott** has been the driving force for the offense. In 14 games, Lott has slashed .375/.412/.563 with three homers and 12 RBI's. The outfielder has quietly driven in a run in six of his last seven contests. Meanwhile, **Nick Trogrlic-Iverson** has been lights out in the Peoria 'pen. Dating back to July 6, the right-hander has a 2.57 ERA and has converted all three of his save attempts.
- About the Chiefs:** The 2022 season marks the Chiefs 20th year of affiliation with the St. Louis Cardinals. Additionally, Dozer Park is celebrating its 20th year of operation after it opened in May of 2002. As a franchise, the Chiefs have sent more than 200 players to the majors, including Rafael Palmeiro, and current Cardinals Albert Pujols and Yadier Molina. The organization has also retired four numbers- #6 for Wally Joyner, #17 for Mark Grace, #23 for former manager Ryne Sandberg and #31 for Hall of Fame pitcher Greg Maddux.
