THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this day in 2019, the Sounds plated five runs in the top of the ninth, wiping out a three-run deficit and clinching a 9-7 win over Round Rock at the Dell Diamond. Patrick Wisdom's three-run homer tied it before Hunter Cole's two-run blast gave Nashville the lead for good.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds take on the Durham Bulls in game four of the six-game series. The Sounds exploded for eight runs late in last night's contest to earn an 8-4 victory. Southpaw Robert Gasser earns the start for Nashville against right-hander Sean Hunley, who is making his Triple-A debut for Durham.

Robert Gasser: 23-year-old Robert Gasser will make his seventh start of the season. The left-hander is 1-0 with a 5.17 ERA (31.1 IP/18 ER) in seven appearances with Nashville. Gasser allowed two earned runs on three hits in his last start vs. Gwinnett on May 13, taking a no-decision in a 4-3 loss. The current No. 7 prospect in the Brewers system, Gasser rose from High-A Fort Wayne to Nashville last season. He was acquired by Milwaukee in the trade that sent Josh Hader to San Diego on August 1, 2022. Gasser attended the University of Houston and was drafted by the Padres in the second round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft.

Sean Hunley: 23-year-old Sean Hunley makes Triple-A debut tonight for Durham. The right-hander was 2-1 with a 1.04 ERA (34.2 IP/4 ER) in seven starts for Double-A Montgomery. In game two of an April 16 doubleheader vs. Tennessee, Hunley tossed the first 4.0 innings of a combined seven-inning no-hitter. In 2022, he went 7-2 with a 3.55 ERA in 25 games (10 starts) with Montgomery. A native of Hermitage, Hunley went 18-8 with a 2.71 ERA in four seasons at the University of Tennessee. He was selected by Tampa Bay in the 19th round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft.

Turn Up The Stereo: Andruw Monasterio pushed his on-base streak to 20 games with a double last night. It's the third-longest streak by a Sounds player this season, trailing Abraham Toro (31) and Jon Singleton (27). Over the span, he is hitting .315 (23-for-63) with 18 runs scored, two doubles, three homers, 14 RBI and more walks (17) than strikeouts (16).

No Small Feat: Ethan Small struck out four over 3.1 innings of relief last night. Over his last eight outings dating back to April 15, the southpaw has a 0.59 ERA (15.1 IP/1 ER), 0.91 WHIP, .100 opponent average (5-for-50) and 12.91 K/9. Small has struck out two or more hitters in seven of those eight games.

The Life of Brian: Brian Navarreto had four RBI in Nashville's win last night, his third such performance of 2023. He is among five players in the International League with three games of 4+ RBI this season (also Zack Collins and Bo Naylor of Columbus, Josh Lester of Norfolk and Josh Palacios of Indianapolis). Navarreto ranks fourth (tied) among Sounds players with 16 RBI.

Pitcher Perfect: The Sounds pitching staff boasts the second-best ERA in the league at 3.95, trailing only Norfolk's mark of 3.68. Nashville hurlers also boast the best WHIP at 1.34 and the fewest walks with 163. The bullpen has the lowest ERA among relievers at 3.40 (203.2 IP/77 ER).

Take a Walk, Take a Walk: First baseman Jon Singleton drew another walk last night, bringing his season total to 32. The first baseman has earned six free passes in his last four games. He is tied for fifth in the International League and tied for seventh in Triple-A in base on balls. Singleton led all of Minor League Baseball with 117 walks last season, which also set a Sounds single-season record.

Good Luck Lucas: Reliever Lucas Erceg was acquired via trade by Oakland for cash yesterday. Erceg, who pitched in parts of last and this season for the Sounds, went 5-2 with a 4.28 ERA (54.2 IP/26 ER) across 46 appearances and two starts in his career with Nashville.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects, which has been updated due to the recent graduations of INF Brice Turang and OF Joey Wiener. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 621-538 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Gasser's last start came on May 13 vs. Gwinnett, when the young southpaw allowed two earned runs over 5.0 innings. He allowed three hits, walked four and struck out five. Gasser did not factor into the decision as the Sounds fell 4-3.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Gasser's first career appearance against Durham.

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Is on Nashville's Opening Day roster for the first time in his career.
- Did not allow a run in 4.0+ innings in first start of season against Memphis.
- Was first Nashville starter to pitch into the sixth in a start this season with 5.1 frames on April 12.
- Is averaging 5.2 strikeouts a start and has the most strikeouts by a Sounds starter this season (4/25 vs. OMA, 8).
- Allowed a career-high three home runs on April 30 vs. Omaha - one each in the third, fourth and fifth innings.
- After posting 2.77 ERA (13.0 IP/4 ER) over first three starts, has 6.87 ERA (18.1 IP/14 ER) in four games since.
