NATURALS WIN SERIES OPENER, LANGFORD MAKES DOUBLE-A DEBUT:

The Northwest Arkansas Naturals used three early home runs to build a lead over the Frisco RoughRiders, winning 7-3 on Monday from Riders Field. **Wyatt Langford** made his Double-A debut in Frisco (29-29, 60-66). The fourth-overall selection by the Texas Rangers this year went 0-for-4 with three groundouts and a strikeout. He started in left field and made one putout. The Naturals (28-29, 57-69) led 5-1 in the third inning using a pair of solo homers and a three-run home run. The Riders tied the game at 1-1 in the second inning on singles by Jax Biggers, Frainyer Chavez and Aaron Zavala. Zavala recorded the RBI and added another on a groundout fourth inning. David Garcia scored after his leadoff double. The Riders also scored in the third frame with a two-out rally. Key**ber Rodriguez** doubled and then scored on Biggers' single. Chavez went 2-for-3 with a double. Jax Biggers also had two hits, an RBI and a run. **Noah Bremer** (1-3) started for Frisco and conceded five runs over four innings, taking the loss. **Reid Birlingmair** faced the minimum in a scoreless seventh inning for Frisco and Danny Duffy allowed an unearned run in the eighth. Aidan Anderson struck out two in a three-up, three-down ninth inning. Brad Keller (2-0) collected the win by tossing two scoreless innings in relief for the Naturals. Frisco stranded seven on the bases Monday, six of them left in scoring position.

WELCOME, WYATT:

Wyatt Langford, who was taken with the No. 4 pick by the Rangers in the 2023 draft, was promoted to Frisco on Monday. He is the No. 2 prospect in the Rangers system and No. 13 in MLB.com's top 100 prospects. At the University of Florida, he was a Unanimous First Team All-American selection after leading the Gators to the College World Series Championship Finals, where they fell to the LSU Tigers. On the season, the outfielder hit an astounding .373/.471/.746/1.217 with 21 home runs and 57 RBIs over 64 games. In his Double-A debut on Monday, he went 0-for-4.

START ME UP AND NEVER STOP-

RoughRiders starting pitchers were great in the series against the Hooks. Every pitcher through the first five games went at least five innings with Nick Krauth throwing six innings on Saturday. Jack Leiter went just 3.1 innings while on a pitch count. Overall, in 29.1 innings, they allowed just five runs for a 1.53 ERA. In those 29.1 innings, the Riders ceded just 21 hits while striking out 27 and walking nine. **Noah Bremer** allowed five runs over his four-inning start against Northwest Arkansas to start the new series.

BROKEN BATS

Since the exit of **Thomas Saggese** and **Luisangel Acuña** at the end of July, the RoughRiders have had a tough time scoring runs on the offensive side. Since August 1st, the RoughRiders are last in the Texas League with just 4.5 runs per game, a .236 batting average and 18 home runs over their 31 games.

DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have scored in the first inning in five of the last 10 games. The Riders are tied for the Texas League lead in first-inning runs with 95 over their 126 games. As a team, Frisco is hitting .273/.370/.434/.804 in the first inning with 14 home runs.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

For almost the entire season, the RoughRiders have lead the Texas League in walks as an offense. Frisco has already shattered their franchise record for most walks in a season with 628 and counting (5.0 per game). Frisco's .355 on-base percentage is on pace to set a new franchise record as well. The Riders already have four players who have cracked the top 10 in single-season walks in franchise history: **Evan Carter** (74, 5th), **Trevor Hauver** (71, 6th), **Kellen Strahm** (67, 8th) and **Aaron Zavala** (66, 10th). In 2015, **Drew Robinson** set the single-season record with 83 walks. Strahm is also third in career walks in RoughRiders franchise history with 132. Next up is **Preston Beck**, who walked 143 times over his four seasons with the Riders.

HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 40 games, Hicks is batting .312 (43-for-138)/.423/.406/.829 with eight doubles, a triple, a home run, 22 RBIs, 23 walks and 18 runs scored. In August, he hit .338 (26-for-77) with a .890 OPS.

RoughRiders reliever Antoine Kelly has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He allowed an earned run for the first time on August 17th in his last 21.2 innings. During that stretch, he had 25 strikeouts to three walks while recording four saves. He has converted on all 11 save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with Evan Carter hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of five teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

-Went to Brenham High School in Brenham, Texas (between Austin and Houston). His senior year of high school, he went 5-2 with a 1.79 ERA.

-Acker attended Rice for freshman season, going 5-2 with a 4.20 ERA and earned Conference USA All-Freshman Team honors. From there, transferred to San Jacinto College for sophomore season in 2019, going 10-0 with a 2.36 ERA in 14 starts. He struck out 97 batters in 76.1 IP.

- -Drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 2019 23rd round, but did not sign.
- -For his junior season, he went to Oklahoma University, making four starts in the COVID-shortened season, going 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA. At the Schrines College Classic on March 1st against No.11 LSU, Acker threw the first Oklahoma no-hitter since 1989, striking out 11 batters to just one walk and two hit batters. He threw 117 pitches in the game.
- -Acker was taken by the Oakland Athletics in the 4th round of the 2020 draft, one pick after Braves pitcher Spencer Strider.

2023 SEASON

- -Ranked as the No. 22 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com entering the season.
- -In Double-A debut at San Antonio on July 3rd, allowed two-run inside the park homer in the third inning to Juan Fernandez, but struck out five.
- -When he was promoted to Double-A Frisco on July 3rd, Acker had just thrown 53.1 career MiLB innings over 17 games with only 50.1 innings and 12 games in affiliated ball above the
- -Finished out High-A time with a 1.65 ERA (3ER/16.1IP) in June.
- -Induced ground balls at a 46.9% rate with High-A Hickory over his six starts.
- -Earned first career MiLB win with five strong innings against San Antonio on July 18th.
- -Made best start of MiLB career on August 30th against CC with 5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 5 K.

2022 SEASON

- -Acker returned from rehab in mid-July, throwing in the Arizona League before making four starts with Hickory, debuting with the Crawdads on August 21st.
- -After the season, Acker participated in the Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.

2021 SEASON

-After trade to Rangers, Acker made two starts with the Down East Wood Ducks before his second ended with "Tommy John" surgery.

-Traded from the Oakland Athletics along with OF Khris Davis and C Jonah Heim in exchange for INF Elvis Andrus and C Aramis Garcia and cash on February 6th, 2021.
