LAST TIME OUT: A wild pitch uncorked by Barons reliever Anderson Severino brought in leftfielder Dalton Pompey with the winning run as Rocket City defeated Birmingham 8-7 in 10 innings Wednesday night to move to 36-35 and two games out in the Northern Division. The Trash Pandas took leads of 2-0, 6-3 and 7-6 with the Barons coming back each time, including an RBI triple from leftfielder Ian Dawkins to tie the game with two out in the ninth. The top four hitters in the Rocket City's lineup combined to go 9-17 with three homers and six RBI. Shortstop Luis Aviles provided two of the homers with three RBI and a single. Second-baseman Brendon Davis went 2-4 with a solo jack and single. Rightfielder Orlando Martinez had two doubles and two runs scored. First-baseman David MacKinnon finished 2-3 with a double and two RBI. Reliever Adrian Almeida got the win despite blowing the save in the ninth. He allowed a run on a hit over two innings with two walks and three strikeouts, the last two coming with the go-ahead run at third in the top of the tenth.

GETTING K'S: The pitchers are racking up the strikeouts against opposing hitters whiffing 749 batters through the first 70 games. That is good enough for first in AA-South. The most the Trash Pandas have struck out in a game was 19, which happened on 6/26 against Chattanooga when former starting pitcher Reid Detmers set a new season-high for Rocket City pitchers with 16Ks followed by reliever Ryan Clark who punched out three more Lookouts. Twice the Trash Pandas have struck out 16 batters. First on 5/11 when they K'd 16 Smokies in a 10-inning loss, then on 6/16 when they shutout Biloxi. The also struck out 15 Smokies in a shutout win on 5/13, 15 more against Birmingham on 5/25, another 15 against Chattanooga on 6/5, then 15 more on 7/22 against Tennessee. Detmers leads the way with 97K's after his 16-strikeout performance. He and closer Oliver Ortega combined to strike out 15 Biloxi batters in the seven-inning game as Ortega tossed a 1-2-3 seventh for the save with one strikeout. The Trash Pandas also struck out 14 Birmingham hitters on 7/16 and appeared to be well on their way to setting a new season-high before rain shortened the game to seven innings.

READY FOR LAUNCH: The Trash Pandas have lived up to the Rocket City moniker by launching 112 homers, which is tops in all of AA. 13 of those dingers came in the 7/20-7/26 series against Tennessee, which is the most in any series this season. Earlier in the year, Rocket City lifted 12 longballs against the Smokies in the 5/11-5/16 series, including two grand slams in the series finale on 5/16. Another 12 came in the series against Montgomery (7/6-7/10) with six provided by infielder Luis Aviles Jr. Rightfielder Izzy Wilson is tied for the league lead in homeruns with 17, with teammate and third baseman Mitch Nay right behind him at 16. In fact, the Trash Pandas possess four of the top 10 homerun hitters in AA-South on the team. Designated hitter Ibandel Isabel is seventh with 13 dingers and outfielder Orlando Martinez clocks in a tie for ninth with 11. Rocket City became the first AA team to hit 100 homers in 2021 on 7/21 when Brendon Davis slung a solo-homer over the elevator shaft in left field in the seventh inning.

HR = RBI: Because of all the homeruns the Trash Pandas have hit, it also leads to plenty of representation in the RBI column. Currently, Rocket City has four players in the top 10 of RBI in AA-South. Rightfielder Izzy Wilson leads the team with 41 RBI, which is good enough for second in the League. After that, first-baseman David MacKinnon is tied-for-fifth at 37, third-baseman Mitch Nay and outfielder Orlando Martinez are tied for tenth at 35.

PANDAS POUNCE AT HOME: Toyota Field has become quite the launching pad for the Trash Pandas. Of the 112 homers hit on season, Rocket City has blasted 69 of them at home. After hitting 12 in the first series against Tennessee, the Trash Pandas hit 18 dingers during an 11-game homestand against Chattanooga and Birmingham. In fact, the home team had at least one homer in 10 of the 11 games. Rocket City tied the 12-homer mark with a dozen in the series against Montgomery, six of which were hit by Luis Aviles Jr. The Trash Pandas' highwater mark came in the 7/20-7/26 series against the Smokies as they blasted 13 homeruns over five games.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: Southpaw Jhonathan Diaz will take the hill tonight after he got the win on 7/22 against Tennessee by allowing only two runs on four hits over five frames with eight strikeouts. Diaz missed about a month of the season as he pitched with the Venezuelan National Team in the qualifiers of the 2021 Olympics. He went 1-1 with them and a 0.00 ERA after allowing three unearned runs in 3.1 innings. At the start of the season, Diaz came out of the pen in his first two games with Rocket City before striking out 11 batters over 5.2 shutout innings on 5/13 in a win over Tennessee. He is 3-1 on the year with a 2.48 ERA having allowed nine ER over 32.2 innings with 49 strikeouts. A native of Valencia, 2021 is Diaz's first season with the Angels after spending the previous five seasons in the Red Sox system where he went 36-29 with a 3.33 ERA and an opponents' .242 batting average.

WHAT IS A TRASH PANDA?

The name was chosen in a name-the-team contest and is a reference to the area's association with the space industry and the determination and ingenuity of raccoons, aka trash pandas.

Trash Pandas, slang for raccoon, was included in the original 10 nominations following several Brandiose-led focus groups in Madison and Huntsville. The ballot descriptor read: Our community is known for engineering, and no creature in our galaxy is as smart, creative, determined and ingenious a problem solver - dedicated to the challenge at hand - as our local raccoons!

In July 2018, after the results from several focus groups in Madison and Huntsville, 10 names were selected, based on their uniqueness and how each name relates to the characteristics of the area: (Alphabetically) Army Ants, Comet Jockeys, GloWorms, Lunatics, Moon Possums, Puffy Head Bird Legs, Space Chimps, Space Sloths, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas. The focus groups were led by San Diego-based Brandiose, the Minor League Baseball industry's premiere branding partner.

Over the next few weeks, two rounds of online voting took place. The first round narrowed the list to Comet Jockeys, Moon Possums, Space Chimps, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas.

Trash Pandas won the final round with 44.75 percent of the vote to ThunderSharks 19.25 percent. Moon Possums was third (12.57 percent); Space Chimps fourth (12.05 percent); and Comet Jockeys fifth (11.38 percent).

By the way, Trash Pandas dominated both rounds.

More than 28,500 nominations and votes were recorded. According to Brandiose, this represented - by far - the largest community participation in a Name the Team contest in the history of Minor League Baseball. The team name was announced in a local microbrewery in September 2018 with nearly 1,500 fans on hand. Trash Pandas was nominated by Matthew Higley of Lacey's Spring, Ala. He received two box seats for the first five seasons and will throw out the ceremonial first pitch at a Trash Pandas home game.

The regional identifier was also chosen by the community. Out of 13,559 votes cast, 67.4 percent chose Rocket City over North Alabama (18.09 percent) and Madison (14.51 percent).



NEW MiLB RULES FOR 2021

Press Release From Major League Baseball - March 11, 2021

Major League Baseball (MLB) announced today the testing of a variety of experimental playing rules at various levels of the Minor Leagues during the upcoming 2021 season. These experimental playing rules have been approved by the Competition Committee and the Playing Rules Committee. MLB will closely monitor and analyze the impact of each rule change throughout the 2021 season and report to Clubs on their effects for further analysis. Consistent with the preferences of our fans, the rule changes being tested are designed to increase action on the basepaths, create more balls in play, improve the pace and length of games, and reduce player injuries.



Below is a summary of the experimental rules that will be tested during the 2021 Minor League season:

Double-A (Defensive Positioning): The defensive team must have a minimum of four players on the infield, each of whom must have both feet completely in front of the outer boundary of the infield dirt. Depending on the preliminary results of this experimental rule change, MLB may require two infielders to be positioned entirely on each side of second base in the second half of the Double-A season. These restrictions on defensive positioning are intended to increase the batting average on balls in play.

NOTEWORTHY

THE DIAZ FILE: LHP Jhonathan Diaz makes 5th start (8th appearance) of the season for Rocket City tonight. Diaz is currently in his first season with the Angels organization after spending the first seven years of his career in the Boston Red Sox system. He appeared in long relief on Opening Day in Chattanooga on May 5 and threw 4.0 innings before a scoreless outing on May 9. In his first start, Diaz set a new career-high with 11 strikeouts while taking a no-hitter into the sixth inning on May 13 vs. Tennessee to earn the first win by a Rocket City starter this year after throwing 5.2 scoreless frames. He then gave up one run over 5.0 innings at Pensacola on May 20. He then made a relief appearance on June 11 at Tennessee and threw 3.0 scoreless innings. He took the loss against Biloxi on June 17 after giving up three runs over 5.0 innings. Following a stint on the IL from June 30-July 16, Diaz has won his last two appearances. First in the completion of a suspended game with 4.0 scoreless relief innings at Birmingham on July 16 before a solid start against Tennessee where he tied his career-high with 11 strikeouts on July 22. He is 2-1 with a 2.61 ERA (6 ER/20.2 IP) over four starts and 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA (3 ER/12.0 IP) over for relief outings.

VS. BIRMINGHAM: Diaz threw 4.0 scoreless relief innings in his only career outing against the Barons to earn the win in the completion of a suspended game from July 15 at Regions Field.

MORE NOTES

OLYMPIC QUALIFIERS: Diaz pitched for Venezuela in the 2021 Olympic Qualifying tournament, held in Port St. Lucie and West Palm Beach, Florida. Over two appearances (one start) for his country, he was 1-1 with a 0.00 ERA, giving up three unearned runs over 3.1 innings along with three strikeouts and three walks as Venezuela was unable to qualify for the Tokyo Games.

LEAGUE LEADER: He spent the 2019 season with High-A Salem and ranked among the Carolina League leaders in starts (1st, 27), strikeouts (4th, 118), ERA (7th, 3.86) and innings (8th, 128.1). He went 7-2 with a 1.62 ERA (14 ER/78.0 IP) in 14 starts during the second half after going 2-6 with a 7.33 ERA (41 ER/50.1 IP) in 13 first half starts for Salem that season. In 2018 for Class-A Greenville, he tied for the South Atlantic League lead with 147 strikeouts and 11 wins.

TOP SOX: In 2018, he ranked among the Red Sox minor league leaders in (2nd, 3.09), wins (T-2nd, 11) and strikeouts (2nd, 151). He was named Red Sox Minor League Starting Pitcher of the Month for August/September 2018.
