**Last Game:** Whitecaps 12, Lugnuts 6. **Jackson Strong** and **Bryce Rainer** homered on Jorge Marcheco's first two pitches of the game, native Michigander **Nolan McCarthy** added a grand slam in an eight-run fifth, and West Michigan built a 12-0 lead in the Sunday finale and withstood a **Jake Reinisch** two-run homer, **Daniel Bucciero** two-run double and **Breyson Guede** two-run single late to win their fifth straight game in the series at LMCU Ballpark.

**On Deck:** Tomorrow is Summer Fun Day, a 1:05 p.m. matinee on a Dog Days of Summer! ### LUG-NOTES

**Streaking:** Outfielder **Jake Reinisch** went 1-for-5 with a home run on Sunday, extending his on-base streak to 28 games, the longest of the Nuts' season. Reinisch is batting .295/.442/.516 with 28 base hits and 23 walks during the streak.

**Power Disparity:** No team in the Midwest League has hit fewer home runs than Lansing's 71 or more home runs than Peoria's 151. However, no team in the league has allowed more home runs than Peoria's 153; Lansing is next closest at 134, aided by 15 home runs allowed in six games at West Michigan.

### Movin' on up:

- Infielders **Ali Camarillo** and **Jared Sprague-Lott** earned promotions up to Double-A Midland to start the week. Camarillo, 23, had just been named to the A's Top 30 Prospects list in MLB Pipeline's re-ranking of the organization, incorporating the 2026 Draft class and breakout prospects. He exits the High-A level with the following Midwest League ranks: No. 4 in doubles (23), No. 6 in base hits (97), No. 7 in batting average (.284). Camarillo further leads the Lugnuts in at-bats (342), total bases (135), RBIs (58), HBPs (8) and steals (20 in 21 attempts), all the while drawing 32 walks and striking out only 56 times in 86 games. slashed .284/.355/.395 with 23 doubles, five home runs and 20 stolen bases. Over two stints with the Lugnuts in 2026, Sprague-Lott hit .250/.365/.357 with 10 doubles, one triple, five home runs and 17 stolen bases. Both players were hot in July, with Camarillo hitting .313 and Sprague-Lott batting .306.

- Lansing alumni are also moving up the chain. 2024 Nut **Luke Mann** and 2026 Nut **Justin Riemer** recently received promotions to Triple-A Las Vegas. Mann played in 71 games with the Midland Rockhounds this season, hitting .230/.300/.437. In 31 games (two stints) with the Rockhounds, Riemer hit .333/.487/.389.

**Major League Lugnuts:** Ten former Nuts have made their MLB debuts this season: **Daniel Susac** for the Giants, **Junior Perez** for the White Sox, **Eduardo Rivera** for the Red Sox, and **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**, **Kade Morris**, **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**, **Tommy White** and **Yunior Tur** for the Athletics, and – on August 9 with two scoreless innings in relief – 2021 Lugnut **Jack Weisenburger** with the NY Mets. In all 48 Lugnuts have appeared in a Major League game this season.

**Filling the Squad:** On the current Athletics active roster, there are eight former Lugnuts: **Brady Basso**, **Hogan Harris**, **Gage Jump**, **Jack Perkins**, **Max Muncy**, **Tommy White**, **Henry Bolte**, **Lawrence Butler**.

**Cooperstownian Nut:** A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** was inducted on July 26 into Cooperstown alongside Jeff Kent and Andruw Jones. In his 11th game with the Lugnuts (batting .143, 6-for-42, with one walk and 11 strikeouts), Beltrán suffered a right knee in an outfield collision. He flew back to the Royals' complex in Florida and never returned to Lansing, making his MLB debut on September 14, 1998, against the Oakland Athletics. A year later, Carlos was voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, and was on his way to a 20-year MLB career with 2,725 hits, 565 doubles, 78 triples, 435 homers, 312 homers, nine All-Star appearances, three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and a 2017 World Series ring as a member of the Astros.

## AUGUST 18 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2009:** Down 3-1 late to Great Lakes, the Lugnuts tied the game in the 7th on a Kenny Wilson RBI single and a Chris Emanuele RBI groundout. An inning later, Johermyn Chavez hit a two-run homer, his 20th of the year, and the Lugnuts beat the Loons, 5-3, at Oldsmobile Park. Chavez finished the game 4-for-4 with three RBIs.

**2016:** The Great Lakes Loons finished off a four-game sweep of the Lugnuts at Cooley Law School Stadium with a 5-1 victory, going from 4.5 games back of the Nuts for the second and final Eastern Division playoff berth to 0.5 games back. The Loons would pass the Lugnuts on the way to the postseason – and the 2016 Midwest League Championship, the first title in franchise history.

**2024:** Jonny Butler singled home pinch-runner Cole Conn with the game-winning run in the bottom of the seventh inning, helping the Nuts split a doubleheader with the West Michigan Whitecaps, losing 6-1 and winning 2-1, on a long Sunday at Jackson® Field™. Team personnel arrived for both the Lugnuts and Whitecaps by 9 a.m. for an expected 1:05 p.m. start, but first pitch for Game 1 was pushed back nearly four hours due to a series of pop-up storms, moving from the scheduled 1:05 p.m. to the actual start time of 5:03 p.m. When Conn raced home to conclude the night, it was 9:42 p.m.

**In a Nutshell:** Began the season on the Lugnuts' Opening Day roster... making his fifth straight start after 23 relief appearances opened the year, moved into the rotation on July 25 following the promotions of Ben Hansen, Zane Taylor and Nathan Dettmer to Double-A Midland.

**Last Start, August 12 at West Michigan:** Tossed third career quality start and second consecutive quality start: 6 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 5 K on 90 pitches, 60 strikes... picked off Edian Espinal from second base... departed with the game still scoreless... Whitecaps scored one run in the 7th, Lugnuts countered with three in the 8th, 'Caps tied it with two in the bottom of the 8th... the game went to extra innings... Lugnuts took a 5-3 lead on a Daniel Bucciero 2-R HR, but 'Caps walked off in the bottom of the 10th, 6-5, on a Samuel Gil sac fly..

**Hometown Hero:** Attended Park of Cottage Grove, where he lettered in baseball, basketball and bowling (yes, he has bowled a 300 game)... Mr. Baseball finalist, ranked Perfect Game's No. 5 player in Minnesota and No. 1 LHP... as a senior: 10-1, 1.26 ERA, 78 1/3 IP, 11 ER, 25 BB and 114 K.

**College Days:** Chose the Golden Gophers over Alabama, USC, Illinois and Wichita State... majored in accounting at Minnesota's Carlson School of Management... spent his summer ball days with the Minnesota Mud Puppies (2021), Willmar Stingers (2022), Cotuit Kettleers (2023)... ascended to Minnesota's Friday starter as a sophomore in 2023 and was named Dave Winfield Pitcher of the Year... ranked 5th in the Big Ten in K/9 in 2024 (10.7), with 62 K in 52 IP, and was named All-Big Ten Third Team... named D1 Baseball's No. 26 Draft Prospect in the Big Ten.

**Off to Pro Ball:** Signed for \$125,000 as the first pick of the 18th round in 2018... dominated out of the bullpen for the Stockton Ports, and was sporting a 1.63 ERA when he moved to the starting rotation on July 13... whiffed nine Modesto Nuts in five innings in his first California League start, following up with six scoreless innings against Modesto on August 10... in total: 1.67 ERA as a reliever (37 2/3 IP, 15 R, 7 ER, 20 BB, 52 K), but a 5.85 ERA as a starter (40 IP, 27 R, 26 ER, 17 BB, 45 K)... joined the Lugnuts to begin 2026 and allowed only two runs in his first six appearances, but gave up five runs at South Bend on May 8 and four runs vs. Quad Cities on May 15... Midwest League base-stealers are 3-for-6... lefties are hitting just .203; righties are batting .279 with a .397 OBP (23 BB), but have hit into nine (of 10) double plays.
