

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY: On July 19, 2001, Joe Jiannetti scampered around the bases for the first inside-the-park home run in Cyclones history...In 2012, the Cyclones scored the game's only run on a 28 Richie Rodriguez sacrifice fly in the top of the 15th inning in a 1-0 win at Staten Island...Brooklyn won the game in the bottom of the inning on a 3-2-6 double play...in 2013, INF Justin Turner went 1-for-3 in a 2-1 loss vs. Mahoning Valley, the first of three games with the Cyclones on a Major League rehab assignment...In 2014, OF Michael Conforto made his professional debut going 1-for-4 with Brooklyn as the designated hitter against Williamsport...The 10th overall pick in the 2014 MLB Draft became the highest-chafted player to ever suit up for the Cyclones in an 8-4 win...In 2017, Brooklyn came away with a 3-1 victory vs. Staten Island on Coney Island to earn the 700th win in franchise history.

NEXT STOP: CONEY ISLAND: With the 2024 MLB Draft fully in the books, the Mets organization added a wealth of new talent...All told, 20 players heard their name called by New York, headlined by a pair of highly touted college products, Oklahoma State OF Carson Benge (1st round) and Duke LHP Jonathan Santucci (2nd)...Benge spent time in Stillwater with 2024 Cyclones TWP Nolan McLean, and profiles similarly...While Benge is technically listed as an outfielder, the Yukon, Okla native also pitched in college, like McLean...Benge clobbered 18 home runs for the Cowboys in 2024, while notching a 1109 OPS in 64 games...Santucci was a standout in the ACC, being named to the All-Conference First Team...The southpaw recorded 90 strikeouts in his 58.0 innings of work, and will rejoin former Duke teammate RHP Jimmy Loper as a member of the Mets farm system...Mississippi State RHP Nate Dohm (3rd), North Carolina State OF Eli Serrano III (4th), and Liberty (Mo.) North High School INF Trey Snyder (5th) rounded out the Mets' top five selections.

SHUT IT: Brooklyn is no stranger to tossing shutouts as of late...The Cyclones tied a franchise record with its 11th shutout win of the season in last Sunday's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The 11 shutout performances match the 2023 mark for the single-season all-time record...The 11 shutouts are two behind Rome (13) for the most in the South Atlantic League...The Cyclones are also tied for third in all of Minor League Baseball in shutouts...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park... The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively.

THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Over his last four starts since June 20, the 2I-year-old is 2-1 with an 0.82 ERA (2 ER in 22.0 IP), allowing only eight hits and six walks (7.40 BB%), while striking out 32 (39.51 K%)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native has led the circuit in strikeouts (70)...He is also second in ERA (2.85), WHIP (1.14), and batting average against (1.89), and ninth in innings pitched (53.2)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season... Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 70.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.10), fourth in strikeout rate (36.1%), fifth in strikeout-towalk rate (26.5%), and seventh in strikeouts (106).

'TALK 2 'EM: RHP Kade Morris has started to find his stride at the High-A level... Since his start on June 21 vs. Jersey Shore, the 22-year-old holds a 2-1 record with a sparkling 1.85 ERA (5 ER in 24.1 IP) in four appearances (three starts)...He has yielded just 15 hits and 10 walks (10.2 BB%) while striking out 21 (21.4 K%)...Since June 20, Morris and RHP Jonah Tong have been two of the best arms in the South Atlantic League... In that span, Tong is second in the circuit in ERA (0.82) and Morris (1.85) is sixth... Additionally, Kade is third in innings pitched (24.1) and batting average against (.174), and sixth in WHIP (1.03)...Since making his SAL debut on May 22, Morris is third in the league in innings pitched (48.0), fourth in batting average against (.219), fifth in WHIP (1.21), and eighth in ERA (3.56).

TAKING KELLUM 123: OF Kellum Clark snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game last Saturday at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since...The 23-year-old had a four-game multi-hit streak snapped on Saturday, during which he went 9-for-14 (.643) with three runs scored, a double, an RBI, and two walks during the streak...Clark had just one multi-hit game in the first 48 contests of his career before the four-game multi-hit streak...In nine games during the month of July, the Brandon, Miss. native is hitting .357/.486/.393 with a .879 OPS...His .486 on-base percentage is fourth in the South Atlantic League during the month.

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn opens a nine-game homestand with three contests against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...The BlueClaws boast three of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF Aidan Miller (2), INF William Bergolla (11), OF Emaarion Boyd (16), OF Hendry Mendez (22), and RHP George Klassen (28)... INF Bryan Rincon (7) is on the 7-day injured list...The Cyclones split both series played in 2024 at ShoreTown Ballpark, going 6-6 in 12 contests... Brooklyn does not return to Jersey Shore in the 2024 regular season, hosting the final 15 meetings...Through six games, Jersey Shore leads the series at Maimonides Park, 4-2... Dating back to 2021, Brooklyn leads the all-time series, 54-47 (.535).

TRAVELING CIRCUS: Starting with the June 25 game in Aberdeen, the Cyclones have just six home games in 28 days...Brooklyn's next full six-game home series will take place from July 23-28 vs. Rome...So far, Brooklyn is 5-12 in the stretch...The Cyclones played three games at home vs. Hudson Valley from July 1-3 and will play another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 19-21 immediately following the All-Star break...The stretch also includes a 12-day run without a day off (June 25-July 6), the longest of the season for Brooklyn.

WIZARD OF PA2: OF **Karell Paz** is in the midst of one of his best offensive stretches of the 2024 season...Since clubbing a go-ahead two-run home run in the ninth inning on June 30 at Aberdeen, the 24-year-old is hitting .333/.429/.500 with a .929 OPS in 12 games... Paz has scored four runs and picked up three doubles, a home run, five runs batted in, six walks, and seven stolen bases.

MORABITO FUEL: OF Nick Morabito has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The 21-year-old is 11th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (38)...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito is tied for third in the circuit in hits (62), tied for second in stolen bases (27), and tied for sixth in runs scored (39)...On the year, the former second-round selection is tied for eighth in the SAL in stolen bases (27)...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.307) and stolen bases (38)...He is also first in on-base percentage (.403), second in hits (93) and runs scored (53) and tied for fourth in triples (3).

OMAR-I-GONE: OF Omar De Los Santos rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League with 31 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT Jaylen Palmer's (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (68) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (68) and is fifth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (140).

LOCATION, LOCATION: The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...OF Nick Morabito loves his time on the road...He is hitting .302/.385/.396 with a .781 OPS, adding two home runs, nine RBI, and 25 stolen bases in 36 road contests... He is seventh in the circuit in road batting average (.302) and, since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old has had the most road hits (45) and stolen bases (25) in the circuit...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .224/.289/.250 line with a .539 OPS, two extra-base hits, two RBI, and two stolen bases over 18 games...INF Junior Tillen has thrived at Maimonides Park, posting a .309/.366/.455 mark with a .821 OPS, three home runs, and 14 RBI in 31 games...On the road, Tillen is hitting .171/.272/.243 with a .515 OPS, a home run, and nine runs batted in over 38 contests...O Chris Suero is hitting .250/.418/.442 with a .860 OPS, three home runs, and 11 RBI in 16 games on Coney Island...The 20-year-old is batting .170/.284/.250 with a .534 OPS, a home run, and 16 RBI in 33 affairs in visiting ballparks.

LARRUPIN' LORUSSO: INF Nick Lorusso was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Wednesday...During his time in the South Atlantic League, the 23-year-old was tied for eighth in total bases (123), ninth in walks (40), and 10th in OPS (834)...Lorusso also dominated at Maimonides Park...The former Maryland Terrapin hit .367/.444/.661 with a 1:05 OPS in 30 contests on Coney Island...Lorusso led the SAL in home batting average (.367) and on-base percentage (.444) while trailing only Greenville OF Brayan González in slugging (.661) and OPS (1:105)...The Connecticut native is the 12th Cyclone to join the Rumble Ponies in 2024.

ONE-TWO MISSTEP: The Cyclones have struggled in games decided by one or two runs...Brooklyn is 5-15 in one-run games and 5-6 in two-run games for a combined record of 10-21 (.323)...The Cyclones hold a record 30-26 (.536) in games decided by three runs or more.

WALK-OFF WOES: Brooklyn's 3-2 loss at Wilmington on Friday night marked the team's seventh walk-off defeat of the season...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 17 walk-off losses, accumulating 15.32% of all defeats...Brooklyn has one walk-off win this year on **Nick Lorusso**'s game-winning home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Asheville on April 14.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to Baseball America and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF Jesús Báez (9), RHP Jonah Tong (15), RHP Kade Morris (23), RHP Jack Wenninger (26), and Calvin Ziegler (29)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season injured list...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Báez (22), Ziegler (23), Wilfredo Lara (24), and OF Nick Morabito (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his second loss of the season last Wednesday night at Wilmington...Earned a quality start, posting 6.0 innings of three-hit, one-run ball...Did not issue a walk and struck out seven...Tossed 80 pitches and 53 strikes (66.25%)...Relieved by LHP **Julian Smith** to start the bottom of the seventh inning with Brooklyn behind 1-0...Blue Rocks would score fifth in the seventh before the Cyclones broke up the shutout with runs in eighth and ninth...Wilmington defeated Brooklyn, 6-2.

PROSPECT RADAR: Tong is considered the New York Mets' No. 15 prospect in 2024 according to *Baseball America* and No. 20 by MLB Pipeline...The 20-year-old is the consensus highest-rated pitching prospect on the Cyclones' roster.

THE TONG SONG: Over his last four starts since June 20, the 21-year-old is 2-1 with an 0.82 ERA (2 ER in 22.0 IP), allowing only eight hits and six walks (7.41 BB%), while striking out 32 (39.51 K%)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native leads the circuit in strikeouts (70)...He is also second in ERA (2.85), batting average against (.189), and WHIP (1.14), and ninth in innings pitched (53.2)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 70.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.10), fourth in strikeout rate (36.1%), fifth in strikeout-to-walk rate (2.65%), and seventh in strikeouts (106).

JONAH'S WHALE OF A START: The 21-year-old earned his first High-A and South Atlantic League victory on May 26 vs. Hudson Valley, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball...The 6.2 innings of work is the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year...It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP **Jordany Ventura** tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023...The 20-year-old's stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames.

2023: After he did not pitch in 2022 after being drafted, Tong started the campaign and made his professional debut in the Florida Complex League...Registered an 0-1 record with a 6.39 ERA (9 ER in 12.2 IP), 13 walks, and 25 strikeouts in seven appearances (five starts)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 22...Composed an 0-1 mark with a 5.40 ERA (5 ER in 8.1 IP), nine walks, and 13 strikeouts in three starts...Returned to the FCL Mets on September 7.

TRAVELING MAN: A native of Canada, Tong's journey to professional baseball has included a lot of travel...After attending Bill Crothers Secondary School in Unionville, Ont., Tong moved on Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Ga. for his final high school season... Prior to the 2022 draft, Tong participated in the MLB Draft League as a member of the Frederick (Md.) Keys...Accumulated an O-1 record with a 10.80 ERA (14 ER in 11.2 IP), 10 walks, and 14 K's in four outings (three starts)...Was a teammate of Aberdeen's RHP **Zach Fruit**, teammate RHP **Jonathan Pintaro**, and former Cyclones and current Double-A Binghamton RHP **Jordan Geber**, whose rotation spot he took...He was also committed to North Dakota State University before signing his professional contract.
