Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland A's, play the third and fourth games in a six-game series against the Beloit Sky Carp, making up a doubleheader from yesterday's postponement. This is the second leg of the Lugnuts' 12-game, 13-day road trip to Great Lakes and Beloit; the Nuts are 2-6 thus far on the trip, losing four of six at Dow Diamond before dropping the first two games of this series.

Wednesday Night: Sky Carp 11, Lugnuts 4. In torrential rain, Beloit rallied from a 4-3 deficit with eight runs in the bottom of the seventh inning to defeat the Lugnuts for the second straight day, keyed by a Dalvy Rosario grand slam. In defeat, the Nuts received home runs from Austin Beck and Tyler Soderstrom as well as the first quality start of the year for Osvaldo Berrios (6 IP, 3 R, 0 BB, 8 K).

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Sky Carp through Sunday before driving back around Chicago and returning home. The Nuts' last home game was on May 15; their next home game is on May 31, opening a six-game series with the Minnesota Twins-affiliated Cedar Rapids Kernels at Jackson Field.

Goose Fact of the Day: Geese honk. Cars honk. And when the Sky Carp and the Lugnuts come together, we can't help but think about famous cars named after geese, like the 1947 Tucker '48 Prototype, nicknamed the Tin Goose, a member of the National Historic Vehicle Register inspired by the 1941 Oldsmobile, and the De Tomaso Mangusta, built from 1967-1971 and nicknamed "The Goose" (even though "mangusta" means mongoose in Italian).

Familiar Terrain: Lugnuts who once suited up for the Beloit Snappers include former Beloit pitching coach/current Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze, pitchers Joe DeMers, Angello Infante and Daniel Martinez, outfielders Austin Beck (a 2018 Midwest League All-Star) and Lazaro Armenteros, and manager Phil Pohl, who played three games for the Snappers in 2013 and 72 games for the Snappers in 2014.

Among the MWL Leaders: 3B Brett Harris ranks 2nd in the Midwest League in OBP (.415), 3rd in slugging (.578), 3rd in OPS (.993) and 4th in batting avg. (.304). Additionally, 1B Tyler Soderstrom is tied for 4th with eight homers, INF Euribiel Ángeles is tied for 5th with 42 hits, reliever Kumar Nambiar is tied for 2nd with 15 appearances, and starter Osvaldo Berrios is 5th with 41 1/3 innings pitched.

166 Major League Nuts: Pitcher **Danny Young** (2016 in Lansing) debuted for the Seattle Mariners on May 9 with 2 1/3 scoreless innings in relief, becoming the 166th all-time Nut to reach the Majors and the fifth this year, joining Oakland A's relievers **Zach Logue** and **Zach Jackson** and infielder **Christian Lopes** and Toronto Blue Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra**.

Talent Rich: The Nuts boast the No. 2 prospect in the Athletics' organization in Tyler Soderstrom, a 20-year-old catcher drafted 26th overall in 2020 who is considered MLB Pipeline's No. 56 prospect in all of baseball. Soderstrom is one of seven Top 25 A's prospects on the roster, joining outfielder Brayan Buelvas (No. 9) and infielder Euribiel Ángeles (No. 10), injured starting pitcher Joey Estes (No. 15), first baseman/outfielder Lawrence Butler (No. 17), pitcher Jeff Criswell (No. 18) and injured starting pitcher Grant Holman (No. 30).

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bull-pen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

Draft Day: Selected 157th overall in the 5th round, 2020 from the University of Washington (the "Huskies")... scout: Jim Coffman, who also signed Joe DeMers, Jared McDonald and current Oakland A's outfielder Seth Brown... signed for \$400,000... drafted three picks before the end of the draft... one of three of Oakland's five 2020 draft picks on the Lugnuts (1st round - Tyler Soderstrom; 2nd round - Jeff Criswell).

Personal: Born in Seattle... played three years in Little League for, coincidentally, the A's, and still has his old A's baseball cap... younger brother, Josh, is currently a pitcher at Washington, standing 6'3... uncle, Jake, also played baseball for Washington.

Hometown: Bellevue is the third largest city in the Seattle metropolitan area... "belle vue" in French means "beautiful view"; it's situated across Lake Washington from Seattle... Amazon was founded in Bellevue in Jeff Bezos's garage on July 5, 1994... many companies are headquartered in Bellevue, notably T-Mobile USA, the North American headquarters for Pokémon, QFC, Expedia Group, Coinstar and Eddie Bauer... Russell Wilson and Ciara are currently seeking to sell their house in Bellevue (with amazing tree hosue) for \$36 million.

Glory Days: Attended Interlake High School... rated by Baseball Northwest as Washington's No. 1 baseball recruit in the Class of 2017... rated by Perfect Game as Washington's No. 4 right-handed pitcher... Interlake's alumni includes John Olerud, Larry Andersen, Jim Mora Jr., and actor Timothy Omundson.

Life as a Huskie: Ascended from setup man to closer to ace starting pitcher from freshman to junior year at Washington... broke the Washington freshman record with 34 relief appearances, tied for second most in school history for a single season; led all freshmen in the Pac-12 in appearances... also led Washington as a freshman in wins (8-2, 4.37, 45 1/3 IP, 2 HR, 28 BB, 32 K)... followed up a sophomore in 2019 with 31 appearances (2.35 ERA, 6 saves, 53 2/3, 3 HR, 22 BB, 65 K)... made four starts as a junior, including 13-K, 6-IP gem vs. Fresno State, before season was shut down (0.79, 22 2/3 IP, 2 ER, 0 HR, 9 BB, Pac-12 leading 38 K)... 15.1 K/9.0-IP ranked 16th in the country... named a 2020 3rd Team All-American by The Collegiate Baseball.

2021 Professional Debut: Opened season as the Lugnuts' Sunday starter... excelled in pro debut, May 9 vs. Lake County: 4 1/3 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 5 K... followed up five two-hit scoreless innings at Dayton, May 16... season curtailed due to injury, however, after four starts in May and three appearances in June... set Lugnuts franchise single-game record in last appearance, June 20 vs. Great Lakes, allowing four home runs: two apiece by Andy Pages and Deacon Liput in back-to-back innings... made one scoreless appearance in Arizona Complex League before season's end.

2022 - Back in Lansing: Piggybacked Jeff Criswell in season debut, Sunday, April 10, striking out six Lake County Captains in three innings... earned win as Lugnuts topped Caps, 6-5, avoiding a three-game sweep... made first start of the year in the fourth game of the series at West Michigan, pitched scoreless 1st and 2nd inning and recorded two outs into the 4th, but in between, gave up five runs on six hits in the 3rd inning, including doubles by Parker Meadows, Colt Keith and Jake Holton and a triple by Andrew Navigato... that supplied the lion's share of the Whitecaps' offense in a 6-3 victory over Lansing... April 23 vs. Fort Wayne, Game 2: tied his own franchise single-game record, giving up four home runs to the TinCaps (Corey Rosier leading off the game, Robert Hassell III hit two, Ripken Reyes hit one) in six innings in Lugnuts' 6-2 defeat... May 11 vs. Dayton: dominated the Dayton Dragons with five scoreless innings... four of the five were perfect, with a double (Justice Thompson) and two walks allowed in the third inning before he bore down and stranded the bases loaded... tied career high with seven strikeouts... Lugnuts won comfortably against the first-place Dragons, 6-1... May 17 at Great Lakes: started the first game of the series against the Loons, allowing six hits and four runs (three earned) in 3 2/3 IP... gave up one run in the 1st, one in the 2nd and two in the 3rd... allowed four extra-base hits, including a pair of triples to Jorbit Vivas and a triple to Jose Ramos... trailing 4-1 when he exited, Lugnuts came back to beat the Loons, 7-4.

Last Appearance, May 22 vs. Great Lakes: Relieved Hogan Harris with two outs in the 2nd, recording the final out, and then proceeded to pitch four more scoreless innings, striking out six while allowing two hits and one walk... after departing, however, Lugnuts bullpen allowed three runs in 7th and four in the 8th in an 8-3 loss.

A Second Zag: Lardner played at Gonzaga at the same time as current Lugnuts teammate Brett Harris, overlapping in 2019 and 2020 in Spokane.

Midwest League – uh, High-A Central – Experience: Lardner was signed as an undrafted free agent by the St. Louis Cardinals in 2020 following the five-round draft, spending his professional debut season with the Peoria Chiefs (0-6, 5.91 ERA, 21 G, 14 GS, 67 IP, 22 BB, 73 K... opened season as the Chiefs' No. 3 starter and turned in four scoreless innings, allowing one hit, vs. Cedar Rapids on May 6, 2021, in his pro debut... longest outing was his last: 6 2/3 IP on Sept. 18 vs. the Kernels... finished with 0.87 GO/AO ratio... allowed .305 avg. to left-handers, .253 to right-handers... pitched at both Pohlman Field and ABC Supply Stadium last year.

The Next Step: Released by the St. Louis Cardinals on March 28, Mac signed with the Washington Wild Things on April 7... said Washington manager Tom Vaeth, "Mac is an important signing for us, being a rookie and left-handed he helps fill the void left by Hennen's departure. Mac was very successful while at Gonzaga with a reputation as a strike thrower with a three-pitch mix.
