LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped Tuesday's series opener vs. Wilmington, 11-9, in 10 innings...Blue Rocks scored 4 in the 10th on a 2B Viandel Peña single and a 3-run home run by CF Jeremy De La Rosa...Brooklyn stranded the tying runs on base in the 10th after RBI's from SS Junior Tilien and CF Alex Ramírez...Blue Rocks trailed, 7-5, entering the 9th...Tied the game on a De La Rosa triple and a run-scoring single from LF Jared McKenzie...LF Rhylan Thomas picked up a game-high-tying 4 hits for the Cyclones...Peña finished with 4 hits, 3 doubles, and 5 RBI for Wilmington...Ramírez collected 3 hits and 3 RBI, while Tilien drove in 4...C Kevin Parada, 3B William Lugo, and DH Omar De Los Santos all accrued multi-hit nights for the 'Clones...De La Rosa added 3 hits and 4 RBI for the 'Rocks...DH Will Frizzell added 2 hits, including a solo home run in the 8th...McKenzie also posted a multi-hit effort... In all, 20 runs were scored on 32 hits in the contest.

CUTTING 'EM DOWN: With 4 strikeouts last Thursday night, RHP Blade Tidwell set the Cyclones' single-season strikeout record (107)...The 22-year-old surpassed RHP Junior Santos' mark of 105 set in 2022...His 107 K's sit 4th overall in franchise history and is 6 behind RHP Alec Kisena (113) for 3rd...Tidwell has earned the win in 5 of his last 6 outings with Brooklyn winning all 6 games...He has permitted just 7 runs on 25 hits over 38.0 innings...He has walked only 10 (6.9 BB%) and struck out 47 (32.4 K%) in those contests...Tidwell punched out a career-high and team-season-best-matching 11 in consecutive starts on July 6 at Wilmington and June 30 vs. Jersey Shore...This comes after he tied a then-career-best with 10 strike-outs on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 11 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 7-0 with a 1.70 ERA (11 ER in 58.1 IP) with just 35 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 30 and struck out 80 (34.0 K%)...Tidwell's holding opponents to a meager .172 batting average (35-204) against him... In that time, Tidwell is 2nd in the South Atlantic League and is 4th in Minor League Baseball in strikeouts (80)...He is also 2nd in ERA (170) and 3rd in batting average against (172) since that date (min. 55.0 IP)...On the season in the SAL, the Loretto, Tenn. native leads in batting average against (195), is tied for 2nd in wins (7), 3rd in strikeouts (107), and 4th in ERA (3.29).

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Brooklyn has won 12-of-17 (706) and 18-of-26 (.692) going into Wednesday's matinee...The Cyclones have won 5-consecutive series dating back to June 20-25 vs. Hudson Valley and have not dropped a set since Greenville won 4-of-6 on Coney Island from June 6-11...The Cyclones are 17-8 in the second half and are tied atop the North Division of the SAL with Aberdeen (16-7)...Brooklyn is a half-game behind Hickory (17-7) for the best record in the circuit during the half.

COMEBACK 'CLONES: Brooklyn earned their 18th come-from-behind victory with a 7-4 win at Hudson Valley on Sunday...The Cyclones matched their largest comeback of the year, erasing a 4-run, 4-0 deficit entering the 4th inning... The Cyclones came from 4 runs down to earn the victory on July 4 vs. Wilmington and on Opening Day, April 7, vs. Jersey Shore... Friday marked the 11th win in their final at-bat with an 8-7 win at Hudson Valley...It was also Brooklyn's second win in 2023 when trailing after 8 innings.

I GOT YOUR SIX: OF Alex Ramírez became the first player in Cyclones history to record a 6-hit game with a 6-for-6 performance on Friday night at Hudson Valley...The 20-year-old also stole 3 bases, scored 3 runs, drove in a tally, and robbed 3B Marcos Cabrera of a home run in the 2nd inning...Ramírez is 1-of-5 players in Minor League Baseball to compose a 6-hit game in 2023...Alex is the first player in Minor League Baseball since the stat portal began in 2005 to record 6+ hits and 3+ stolen bases in a single game...Only two players in Major League history have accomplished the feat in the modern era (since 1901)...OF Sammy Sosa (Chicago-NL, 7/2/93 at Colorado) and OF Max Carey (Pittsburgh, 7/7/22 vs. New York-NL)... Since the start of June, Alex is 2nd in the South Atlantic League lead in runs scored (32), 3rd in pitches-per-plate appearance (4.011), and tied for 6th in walks (24) (min. 180 PA)...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4... Entering Wednesday, the Dominican native is 3rd in franchise history in RBI (75) and is 16 behind INF José Peroza (91) for the all-time mark and 5 behind INF Luke Ritter (80) for 2nd... He is 2nd in doubles (32), 3rd in hits (138), 3rd in total bases (202) and 4th in runs scored (72).

PARADA POWER: C Kevin Parada registered his 2nd multi-home run game of the season on July 15 vs. Greensboro, tallying solo shots in the 1st and 5th innings...The Pasadena, Calif. native also accrued multiple blasts on June 23 vs. Hudson Valley...Kevin poked a solo home run in the 3rd and a 2-run inside-the-parker in the 6th...Since 2005, Parada is 1 of 2 Cyclones to record a pair of multi-homer games in the same season...INF Nick Evans powered a pair of jacks on July 22, 2005, vs. Jamestown and again on August 24, 2005, at Williamsport... Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .304/.366/.536 with a .902 OPS and 141 wRC+ in 35 games...Parada has accrued 18 runs scored, 5 doubles, 3 triples, 7 home runs, 22 RBI, 11 walks, and 3 hit-by-pitches...The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Wednesday tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (33) and doubles (19), 6th in total bases (141), and tied for 6th in hits (84)...Since June 6, Parada is tied for 1st in triples (3), tied for 3rd in total bases (74) and hits (42), 9th in slugging (.536), tied for 9th in extra-base hits (15) and home runs (7), and 10th in OPS (.902).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF Omar De Los Santos entered as a pinch-runner and stole second base last Friday night at Hudson Valley, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 34 swipes breaks INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 3rd in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 104 stolen bases in that span, which is tied for 5th most in MiLB... Only Mariners farmhand OF Jonatan Clasé (109), D'Backs prospect OF Wilderd Patiño (108), Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (108), and Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (106) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 61 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 43.

THE RHY-T STUFF: OF Rhylan Thomas made a spectacular game-saving catch to close out Brooklyn's 4-3 win at Hudson Valley last Thursday night...The 23-year-old also picked up a career-high 4 hits and scored a run on Tuesday and enters Wednesday on an 8-game hitting streak since July 8...Thomas is 14-for-29 (.483) at the plate with a 1.102 OPS, 6 runs

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn returns to Coney Island for a 6-game homestand against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks posses 6 of Washington's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: LHP Jake Bennett (8), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (10), OF Daylen Lile (11), INF T.J. White (12), and RHP Andry Lara (15)...C Israel Pineda (19) is with the squad on a Minor League rehab assignment...Brooklyn and Wilmington are meeting at Maimonides Park for the 2nd time in 2023...The Cyclones dropped 3-of-5 to the 'Rocks from April 18-23...The final game was postponed due to wet grounds...In the last meeting in Wilmington, Brooklyn won 5-of-6 contests from July 4-9...The Cyclones are 9-10 (.474) in 19 meetings against Wilmington in 2023...Overall, the 'Clones are 35-34 (.507) all-time against the Blue Rocks since their first meeting in 2021.

scored, a home run, 4 RBI, 2 walks and a 206 wRC+...In 11 games since July 4 at Wilmington, the former USC Trojan is 17-for-40 (.425) at the dish with a .955 OPS and 163 wRC+, 6 runs scored, a home run, 6 RBI, and 3 walks to only 2 strikeouts...Among players with 45 or more plate appearances since the start of July, Thomas ranks 2nd in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.395).

LUGO LAND: INF William Lugo has been scalding hot with the bat over the last few weeks... Since June 22 vs. Hudson Valley, the 21-year-old is slashing .287/.356/.517 with an .873 OPS and a 131 wRC4...In 23 games, Lugo is hitting .287 (25-87) with 9 runs scored, 6 doubles, a triple, 4 home runs, 20 RBI, and 9 walks (8.9 BB%) to only 14 strikeouts (13.9 K%)...In that time, the right-handed swinger has raised his batting average by 38 points (181 to .219)...Among SAL players, Lugo is 2nd in RBI (20) and tied for 7th in extra-base hits (11) since that date.

JUNIOR MINT: INF Junior Tilien clubbed a go-ahead 3-run home run with 2 out in the 9th on July 7 at Wilmington as part of a multi-hit night and added a 4 RBI night against the Blue Rocks on Tuesday...In his last 16 games dating back to June 28 vs. Jersey Shore, Tilien is 18-for-his-last-62 (.290) with 10 runs scored, 5 doubles, 3 home runs, 12 RBI, and 5 walks...During the streak, Tilien is slashing .290/.343/.516 with a .936 OPS and 109 wRC+.

SUPER STAFF: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball... Entering Wednesday, Brooklyn has posted a Mil.B-low 2.92 ERA (167 ER in 515.0 IP) over their last 59 games, holding a 34-25 record in that span...The Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley (3.19) is 2nd in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 6 shutouts in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 28.0% and a walk rate of 11.2%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 2nd lowest opposing OPS (.623), in addition to the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (6.90) in that time period... RHPs Blade Tidwell (1.70) and Tyler Stuart (1.71) hold the 2nd and 3rd best ERA's in MiLB during that time (min. 55.0 IP).

RED HOT RELIEF: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Wednesday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.28) in the entire South Atlantic League and 3rd-lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.14) is leads MiLB, while Hudson Valley (3.47) is 2nd in the circuit...The Cyclones' bullpen is also 6th in batting average against (.214) and hits-per-9 innings (7.08).

YO-JOANDER: Suárez continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...The 23-year-old hurled a quality start on Saturday at Hudson Valley and set a new career-high with 7.0 innings of work in a July 8 defeat at Wilmington...Over his last 7 appearances (6 starts) since June 14 at Aberdeen, Suárez holds only a 2-3 record, but a 3.82 ERA (13 ER in 30.2 IP), 12 walks (9.8 BB%), and 43 strikeouts (35.0 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 3 starts, to Cumaná, Venezuela native holds a 2.65 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with 5 walks (7.7 BB%) and 24 strikeouts (36.9 K%)...In his first 9 appearances (8 starts), the right-hander was 1-4 with an 8.02 ERA (30 ER in 33.2 IP), 28 walks (16.5 BB%), and 39 strikeouts (23.1 K%).

AROUND THE CAROUSEL: 2B D'Andre Smith picked up his first home run as a Cyclone with an inside-the-parker in the 7th on Friday night at Hudson Valley...It was the 2nd inside-the-park home run clubbed by Brooklyn in 2023...C Kevin Parada capped his first career multi-home run game with a 2-run inside-the-park home run in the 6th inning of June 23's win vs. Hudson Valley...They are the first 2 inside-the-park home runs by Cyclones players since Minor League Baseball's stat portal began in the 2005 season...The first one in franchise history was clubbed by Joe Jiannetti on July 19, 2001.

THE .500 CLUB: With Brooklyn's victory on Friday night, the Cyclones jumped over .500 on the season at 44-43...Brooklyn had not been over .500 since the 3rd game of the season... The Cyclones moved to 2-1 with a 4-2 win vs. Jersey Shore to close out the season-opening homestand on April 9.

HIT 'EM UP: The Cyclones tallied a season-high 18 hits in their 8-7 win at Hudson Valley on Friday night...The 18 knocks were the most by Brooklyn in a single game since they accrued 19 hits in a 20-6 win at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on Monday...7 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C Kevin Parada (No. 2), OF Alex Ramírez (5), RHP Blade Tidwell (7), RHP Christian Scott (9), RHP Raimon Gómez (16), RHP Tyler Stuart (17), and RHP Jordany Ventura (24)...-Former Cyclones listed include: INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 1), RHP Mike Vasil (4), OF Matt Rudick (13), RHP Dominic Hamel (14), RHP Junior Santos (20), RHP José Butto (25), RHP Luis Moreno (26), and OF Rowdey Jordan (27)... Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 9...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning vs. FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Made 4 starts, registering an 0-1 record with a 2.16 ERA (2 ER in 8.1 IP) and 9 strikeouts... Hurled 9.2-scoreless innings for St. Lucie in the Florida State League playoffs, helping the Mets to their first league title since 2006...Earned his first professional win in the decisive Game 2 of the Championship Series on September 20 vs. Dunedin (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 BB, 7 SO).
