YESTERDAY: The Captains lost to Dayton, 4-1. Captains starter Daniel Espino struck out 10 Dragons and held Dayton to one run on one hit, an Allan Cerda home run, over 5.2 innings. After Cerda's homer gave Dayton the lead in the top of the fifth, Julian Escobedo tied the score in the bottom of the inning on an RBI double. The Dragons retook the lead against Captains reliever Kevin Kelly in the eighth. With men on second and third, Eric Yang drove home Cerda with a sacrifice fly. Ivan Johnson hit a two-run homer for Dayton in the ninth to cap the scoring.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today 3.0 game behind the Cedar Rapids Kernels for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, Great Lakes, the Cedar Rapids Kernels and the Dayton Dragons are all separated by just 4.0 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are 10.0 games ahead of second place. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless of division).

TIEBREAKER WATCH: The following are the tiebreaker scenarios for the High-A Central League Postseason.

- Head-to-head record
 - If the Captains finish the season tied with the Great Lakes Loons for the final playoff spot, Great Lakes clinches the playoff berth via head-to-head record (15-9 vs. Lake County)
 - If the Captains finish the season tied with the Dayton Dragons for the final playoff spot, Lake County clinches the playoff berth via head-to-head record (14-9 vs. Dayton)
 - If the Captains finish the season tied with the Cedar Rapids Kernels for the final playoff spot, the playoff berth will be decided by the second tiebreaker rule.
- Best overall winning percentage over the final 20 games

If the Captains finish the season tied with the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the team with the better winning percentage over the final 20 games of the regular season will win the playoff berth. If this situation arises, the Captains would win the tiebreaker because Lake County trailed Cedar Rapids at the 100game mark. A tie between the two teams at the end of the season means the Captains would have the better record over the final 20 games.

RUNNERS STRANDED: The Captains and Dragons have struggled with runners in scoring position this series. Dayton is hitting .134 (7-for-43) and has stranded 28 runners. The Captains are batting .125 (5-for-41) with men in scoring position and have left 31

SLUMPING: The Captains' offense has the league's lowest team batting average (.190) and on-base percentage (.286) in September

Christian Cairo: 15-for-49 (.306) with two homers and three doubles in 14 games since being promoted from Low-A Lynchburg on August 24

Jhonkensy Noel: Slashing .321/.384/.628 (1.012 OPS) in his first 20 games with the Captains since being promoted from Low-A Lynchburg on August 17. Across three levels this year (Rookie, Low-A & High-A), Noel leads all Cleveland minor leaguers in batting average (.358), wRC+ (173), OPS (1.050), slugging percentage (.646), BABIP (.401) and ISO (.288)

Quentin Holmes: While Holmes is only hitting .167 over his last 10 games, he also has an .813 OPS in that span. Holmes is slashing .167/.355/.458 in that stretch with seven walks, five steals and his first home run since June 11.

José Tena: Tena is 4-for-25 over his last seven games with 10 strikeouts and two walks.

Joe Donovan: Donovan is 3-for-28 (.107) over his last 10 games. Two of his three hits are home runs.

Raynel Delgado: Delgado is 5-for-38 (.132) over his last 10 games with a .353 OPS.

NEW BLOOD: 3B Jhonkensy Noel joined the Captains on August 17. The 20-year old led all of Low-A (minimum 160 PA) with a 393 batting average and a 190 wRC+, while hitting 11 homers. INF Christian Cairo and OF Jonathan Rodríguez joined the Captains on August 24. Cairo led Low-A Lynchburg with 37 walks and held a .364 on-base percentage, which led all Hillcats minimum 200 PA). Rodríguez slashed .314/.363/.450 with the Hillcats, good for an .812 OPS

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

LAST TIME OUT: Hickman turned in arguably the best start of his young pro career on Sunday at South Bend. The right-hander tied a season/career-high with nine strikeouts and held the Cubs to one hit and two walks over six shutout innings. Hickman earned the win in a 1-0 Captains victory, courtesy of an **Aaron Bracho** seventhinning homer.

AIRBORNE: Hickman has allowed the fourth-highest fly ball percentage (49.4%) among Cleveland minor league pitchers with 50+ innings pitched.

COLLEGE ACCOLADES: Hickman was named a Preseason All-American by *Collegiate Game*, and Second Team Preseason All-America by *Perfect Game* before the shortened 2020 season.

2020 DRAFT: Cleveland selected Hickman in the fifth round (154th overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. This was considered a bit of a steal by some outlets with both *Perfect Game* and *Baseball America* ranking Hickman as the 65th best draft prospect entering the draft.

COLLEGE WORLD SERIES CLINCHER: Hickman's shining moment at Vanderbilt came in 2019 as he helped lead the Commodores to their second National Championship in school history. In the series clinching win, Hickman started for Vanderbilt tossing six strong innings, allowing just one run while fanning 10 Wolverines in the 8-2 win. He also started in the CWS semifinals against Louisville throwing six scoreless frames and surrendering just two hits with three strikeouts. In four total NCAA Tournament starts he went 2-0 with a 1.57 ERA in 23 innings.

CAPTAINS AND VANDY: Hickman is just the second Captain ever to come out Vanderbilt. The first and only other Commodore to come to Lake County was catcher on the 2003 Captains and Lake County Manager in 2012, David Wallace.

STAFF LEADER: In 2019 Hickman found himself starting 2019 out of the bullpen despite being the teams Sunday starter as a freshman, appearing out of the bullpen three times in 2018. After coming out of the pen in his first six appearances of 2019 with a 2.50 ERA Hickman rejoined the rotation and thrived. He finished the year with a 2.05 ERA to lead the team and finish 4th in the SEC.

COACHES WORDS: Hickman worked with Tim Corbin at Vanderbilt who has built a powerhouse in Nashville churning out top baseball talent. In recent years Walker Buehler, Sonny Gray and David Price among others have all starred in the big leagues after pitching for Vandy. Corbin says "Mason has turned into one of the most dependable and reliable starting pitchers that we have had in our program. He continues to develop and get better as his craft while taking on a leadership role on our pitching staff. He is a quality young man that excels in the classroom as well. Very competitive in everything that he does."

STRIKEOUT BUMP: After striking out just eight batters per nine innings as a freshman in Nashville, Hickman saw an increase in whiffs towards the end of his sophomore season. In his final six starts of the season he struck out nine or more batters five times. He finished 2019 with 129 strikeouts to finish 13th in the country and struck out 12 per nine innings.

PROFESSIONAL STAFF: The teammates Hickman worked with at Vanderbilt have been highly regarded around baseball. Pitchers that Hickman joined in the clubhouse that have recently been drafted include Tyler Brown (2020, HOU), Jake Eder (2020, MIA), Drake Fellows (2019, SD), Zach King (2019, MIA), Jackson Gillis (2019, MIL), Joe Gobillot (2019, TB), AJ Franklin (2019, KC), Patrick Raby (2019, CIN), Maddux Conger (2018, DET) and Justin Wilson (2018, NYY). In 2021, Commodores Kumar Rocker and Jack Leiter are both expected to be first round draft picks in 2021 and were teammates of Hickman's in 2019 and 2020. Vanderbilt has also had 12 position players since 2018.
