

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones returned to the win column with a 4-1 triumph over the BlueClaws on Thursday night...Brooklyn tallied 3 runs in the bottom of the first on a 2-run 3B William Lugo home run and an RBI double from LF Omar De Los Santos...SS Junior Tilien added a solo shot in the 2nd...RF Stanley Consuegra went 1-for-4 with a double in his first game since being reinstated from the injured list...3B Nick Ward and DH Wilfredo Flores each tallied multi-hit games to account for 4 of Jersey Shore's 5 hits...RHP Tyler Stuart tossed 7.0 innings of 1-run ball to earn his 3rd win...RHP Jace Beck and LHP Quinn Brodey each hurled a scoreless frame of relief to collect a hold and save, respectively.

PITCHING IN: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Friday, Brooklyn has posted an MiLB-low 2.57 ERA (96 ER in 336.0 IP) over their last 39 games, holding a 21-18 record in that span...The Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley (2.79) is 2nd in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 5 shutouts in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 27.8% and a walk rate of 11.8%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching has permitted the fewest home runs (10) in MiLB over that time period...The Cyclones are also 2nd in MiLB in opposing OPS (.594), and 3rd in hits-per-9 innings (6.67)...RHPs **Blade Tidwell** (1.35) and **Tyler Stuart** (1.43) hold the 4th and 5th best ERA's in MiLB during that time.

RELIEF READY: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Friday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.08) in the entire South Atlantic League and among all High-A teams...The Brewers' High-A Wisconsin is 2nd (3.24) in the classification, while Hudson Valley (3.42) is 2nd in the circuit...The Cyclones' relief RA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 2nd best in all of MiLB...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia leads MiLB (3.07).

BLADE RUNNER: RHP **Blade Tidwell** is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 22-year-old has tossed consecutive quality starts dating back to last Saturday at Aberdeen...Tidwell has earned the win in both outings, permitting just 1 run on 7 hits over 13.0 innings...He has walked 4 and struck out 15 in those contests...He tied a career-best with 10 strikeouts on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 7 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 4-0 with a 1.35 ERA (5 ER in 33.1)P) with just 17 hits allowed... The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 24 and struck out 48 (12.96 K/9)...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 35.0% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager 150 batting average (17-113) against him... Tidwell leads the South Atlantic League in batting average against (150) and is 37 in ERA (1.35) and strikeouts (48) since that date (min. 30.0 IP)...On the season, the Loretto, Tenn. native is 9th in the SAL in punch outs (75).

STU-PENDOUS: RHP **Tyler Stuart** tossed 7.0 more innings of 1-run ball on Thursday, earning his 3rd win...He set career-highs in innings pitched (7.2) and strikeouts (11), in his previous start on June 22 vs. Hudson Valley...The 23-year-old was the first Cyclone to record 11+ strikeouts in a single game since RHP **Carson Seymour** accomplished the feat on July 15, 2022, vs. Greensboro... Stuart was also the first Brooklyn arm to work into the 8th inning since RHP **Conner Grey** tossed 8.1 innings vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...The Southern Miss alum was the first Cyclone to work 7.0+ innings and record 10+ strikeouts in a single game since LHP **Kevin Canelon** whiffed 10 over 8.0 frames at Hudson Valley on August 25, 2015...Stuart leads all qualifiers in the SAL, High-A, and all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (1.42)...Wilmington's LHP Jake Bennett (1.77) is 2nd in the minors...The Kankakee, III. native leads the league in LOB% (89.1%), is 2nd in FIP (3.03), 4th in xFIP (3.39), WHIP (1.06), batting average against (.206), and innings pitched (69.2), 5th in strikeouts (79), 8th in strikeout rate (28.4%), 9th in strikeouts-per-9 innings (10.21), 10th in walk rate (7.9%),

CAPTAIN KEVIN: C Kevin Parada has picked up the pace offensively over the last few weeks... Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .333/.389/.591 with a .980 OPS and 165 wRC+ in 17 games..Parada has accrued 8 runs scored, a double, 2 triples, 4 home runs, 14 RBI, 5 walks, and a hit-by-pitch...Additionally, the Pasadena, Calif. native enters Friday on an 9-game hitting streak (14-for-35; .400/.447/.800) and a 14-game on-base streak (.340/.407/.604)... The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Friday tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in doubles (15), 7th in extra-base hits (25), tied for 7th in total bases (106), and tied for 9th in hits (64).

WALK THIS WAY: OF Alex Ramírez is tied for 3rd in the South Atlantic League in runs scored (16) and is 4th walks (17) during the month of June...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Friday, the Dominican native is 4th in franchise history in RBI (65) and is 26 behind INF José Peroza (91) for the all-time mark...He is also 4th in doubles (26) and tied for 6th in hits (118) and total bases (176).

MARATHON MEN: Brooklyn is in the midst of their longest stretch without an off day for the 2023 season...The Cyclones will play 12 games in 12 days from Wednesday, June 28, until Sunday, July 9...Brooklyn completes their 2-week homestand with a 6-game series at Maimonides Park vs. Jersey Shore until Monday, July 3...The 'Clones will then travel south to Wilmington for a 6-game set at Frawley Stadium against the Blue Rocks starting on Tuesday, July 4...Following the 12 games in 12 days, Brooklyn will have a 4-day break for the Major League All-Star Game before returning to Coney Island on Friday, July 14, to open up a brief 3-game home series vs. Greensboro.

ON THE MEND: Brooklyn currently has 3 players on their roster undergoing rehab assignments: RHP Elieser Hernández, RHP Sean Reid-Foley, and OF Abraham Almonte...Hernández joined the Cyclones on Sunday and has made 2 relief appearances...The 28-year-old has permitted 2 runs on 3 hits over 2.0 innings, striking out 3 (33.3 K%)...Reid-Foley was added to the roster on Wednesday and made his first appearance later that day...The 27-year-old posted a perfect frame of relief, striking out 2...Almonte joined Brooklyn on June 20...The 34-year-old is 2-for-10 (.200) at the plate in 5 games with 3 RBI and 7 walks (38.9 BB%)...LHP José Quintana recently made a rehab start for the 'Clones on Sunday, tossing 4.0 innings of 1-run, 5-strikeout ball.

OH MY, OMAR: OF Omar De Los Santos has added 28 stolen bases in 2023 and remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 98 stolen bases in that span, which is tied for 4th most in MiLB...Only Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (105), Marlins farmhand INF Masim Núñez (103), and D'Backs prospect OF Wilderd Patiño (99) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 57 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 41... Omar is already 4 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

DOWN TO THE WIRE: RF Omar De Los Santos provided Brooklyn their 6th walk-off win of 2023, scoring on a wild pitch in Sunday's victory vs. Hudson Valley...DH Kevin Parada delivered a baseses-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th on June 7 vs. Greenville...C José Mena's added

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn continues their 12-game homestand, finishg with 6 contests against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...The BlueClaws possess 5 of new York's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: RHP Orion Kerkering (6), INF Hao Yu Lee (7), OF Gabriel Rincones (10), C Caleb Ricketts (19), and RHP Tommy McCollum (23)... Brooklyn and Jersey Shore are meeting at Maimonides Park for the first time since the opening series of 2023... Brooklyn captured 2-of-3 games...The Cyclones are 6-8 against the BlueClaws in the first 14 meetings of the campaign... Dating back to 2021, Brooklyn is 42-31 all-time against Jersey Shore (.575).

game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26...1B **Chase Estep** provided a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 11th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF **Alex Ramirez** registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF **Omar De Los Santos** garnered a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year..Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaigm...In addition to 6 walk-off wins, the Cyclones have suffered 9 walk-off defeats after June 16's loss at Aberdeen...214% (15-of-70) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion, including 23.7% (9-of-38) of all defeats and 42.9% (9-of-21) of road losses...371% (26-of-70) have been determined by just 1 run.

CONEY BOARDWALK SHUFFLE: In addition to Palmer joining Double-A Binghamton, Brooklyn made a series of other roster moves on Wednesday...OF Rhylan Thomas — INF D'Andre Smith's college teammate at Southern California — has joined the roster from Single-A St. Lucie...Additionally, INF César Berbesi and OF Stanley Consuegra were reinstated from the 7-day injured list, and OF Eduardo Salazar was transferred back to Single-A St. Lucie...OF Scott Ota was placed on the development list on Wednesday and transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on Friday...In 35 games in the Florida State League, Thomas slashed 308/375/442 with an 817 OPS, adding a home run and 9 RBI with more walks (14) than strikeouts (12)...Consuegra appeared in 4 rehab games with the Florida Complex League Mets and St. Lucie...He was 2-for-12 (167) at the plate with a double.

DINKY DONUTS: RHP Joshua Cornielly (3.0 IP), RHP Dylan Tebrake (2.1), LHP Eli Ankeney (1.2), and RHP Wilkin Ramos (2.0) combined on a 4-hit shutout in Brooklyn's 2-0 win vs. Hudson Valley on Saturday evening...That marked the Cyclones' 1st donut of an opponent since a 5-0 victory at Aberdeen last Saturday...RHP Blade Tidwell (7.0 IP) and Tebrake (2.0) united on a 4-hit blanking of the IronBirds...It was also the Cyclones second shutout of Hudson Valley this season...RHP Tyler Stuart (6.1 IP) and RHP Jace Beck (0.2) picked up a 4-hitter in Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 21... The 'Clones have accumulated 6 shutouts through the first 67 games of 2023...Brooklyn pitching tallied 7 shutouts throughout the entirety of the 2022 campaign.

DYLAN THROWS HOT FIRE: RHP Dylan Tebrake has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 11 relief appearances...Tebrake has a 0.95 ERA (2 ER in 19.0 IP) on 7 hits and 9 walks, registering 28 strikeouts (13.26 K/9)...That equates to a 38.4 K% (28/73).

WILKIN'S WAY: RHP Wilkin Ramos has been exquisite in relief for the Cyclones in 2023...Over his last 4 outings, Ramos has not permitted a run over 91 innings, earning a save and allowing only 3 hits, 4 walks, and striking out 9...For the season, the right-hander is averaging 10.29 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 28.6% strikeout rate with a 11.4% walk rate.

POWER OF PAUL: RHP Paul Gervase garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless innings of relief on June 9 vs. Greenville and has tossed 5-straight scoreless outings since that date (9.0 IP)...Among South Atlantic League relief pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched in 2023, Gervase has the league's lowest ERA (17)...Fellow Cyclone RHP Wilkin Ramos (1.54) is 2nd...Gervase averages 13.79 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 34.3% strikeout rate.

HOMER HAPPY: Last Friday night, the Cyclones set a team season-high with 4 home runs vs. Hudson Valley...Brooklyn's previous high water mark was 3 on June 13 at Aberdeen...It was the first time the 'Clones had clubbed at least 4 home runs in a single game since July 31, 2022, at Hudson Valley...RF Alex Ramirez homered twice on a solo shot in the 4th and a 2-run blast in the 6th...C José Mena and 1B Joe Suozzi went back-to-back in the 7th...Brooklyn's 3-home run 3rd inning on Friday was also the first for the franchise since the team smashed a trio in the top of the 5th on July 27, 2021, at Jersey Shore...DH Edgardo Fermin (2-run) and SS Ronny Mauricio went back-to-back before 2B Luis González added a 2-run shot of his own later in the frame...Friday also marked the first time the Cyclones have poked 4+ home runs at Maimonides Park since a 5-home rub araketo. DH Francisco Álvarez, and 1B Wilmer Reyes all went deep.

YO-JOANDER: RHP Joander Suárez continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...The 23-year-old set a new-career-high with 6+ innings of work in last Tuesday's defeat and added another scoreless inning in relief, earning the win, on Sunday...Suárez allowed just 1 run on 2 hits, walking 3 and striking out a season-high-matching 8 on Tuesday... Over his last 3 appearances (2 starts). Suárez has a 1-1 record and a 3.00 ERA (4 ER in 12.0 IP)... Cumaná, Venezuela native has punched out 16 and walked 6, allowing just 6 hits...Suárez holds a rate of 12.0 strikeouts-per-9-innings and a strikeout rate of 33.3% (16/48) in that span.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on June 14...6 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C Kevin Parada (No. 2), OF Alex Ramírez (5), RHP Blade Tidwell (7), RHP Raimon Gómez (15), RHP Christian Scott (16), and RHP Tyler Stuart (18)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 1), RHP Mike Vasii (4), OF Matt Rudick (13), RHP Dominic Hamel (14), RHP Junior Santos (19), RHP José Butto (23), RHP Luis Montas (24), OF Rowdey Jordan (25), and RHP Matt Allan (30)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.



TOP PROSPECT: Comes at No. 5 overall on the Top 30 list by MLB Pipeline...The 21-year-old is considered the organization's No. 7 overall farmhand by Baseball America...Only Cyclone alum RHP Matt Vasil is a higher-ranked pitcher on their list...Selected as having the "Best Fastball" and "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2022 draft class.

2022: Selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft... Signed for \$1.85 million on July 27...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 9...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning vs. FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Made 4 starts, registering an 0-1 record with a 2.16 ERA (2 ER in 8.1 IP) and 9 strikeouts... Hurled 9.2-scoreless innings for St. Lucie in the Florida State League playoffs, helping the Mets to their first league title since 2006...Earned his first professional win in the decisive Game 2 of the Championship Series on September 20 vs. Dunedin (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 BB, 7 SO).

LORETTO LIGHTNING: Tidwell is no stranger to being around talent... At Loretto (Tenn.) High School, the former second-round selection was teammates with 2018 first-round pick (No. 7 overall) and current San Diego Padres LHP Ryan Weathers...Ryan's father, David, who pitched for the Mets (2002-04) is also a Loretto High School alum.
