Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds look to clinch a series win and take their sixth-straight triumph against the Charlotte Knights tonight. Owen Miller and Brian Navarreto homered in a 5-0 victory last night. Julio Teheran gets another rehab start for the Sounds. Opposing the veteran will be Charlotte's Johan Domínguez.

Julio Teheran: 32-year-old Julio Teheran makes his fourth rehab start with Nashville tonight. The right-hander is 2-5 with a 4.74 ERA (62.2 IP/33 ER) in 11 starts with Milwaukee. Teheran is on the Brewers' 15-day injured list with a right hip impingement. In the series finale vs. Memphis on September 10, he picked up the win with 5.0 three-run innings. Teheran threw 72 pitches (48 strikes) and struck out five for his second win of the series against the Redbirds. He began the season with Triple-A El Paso in the Padres organization, posting a 4-2 record and 5.63 ERA in eight starts before opting out and signing a major league deal with Milwaukee on May 25. The two-time National League All-Star has appeared in 12 Major League seasons, first with Atlanta (2011-19), then Los Angeles-AL (2020), Detroit (2021) and Milwaukee (2023). Teheran was originally signed by Atlanta out of his native Colombia on July 2, 2007.

Johan Domínguez: 27-year-old Johan Domínguez makes his 12th start of the season and seventh for Charlotte tonight. The right-hander is 0-2 with a 4.58 ERA (19.2 IP/10 ER) with the Knights and is 0-4 with a 3.82 ERA (30.2 IP/13 ER) in the minors in 2023. Domínguez took his second loss of September in his last start on September 8 vs. Durham. He allowed three runs (all earned) on five hits and a walk in 5.0 innings. He threw a season-high 88 pitches and 58 strikes in the loss. Domínguez began the season on the injured list and made five rehab starts with High-A Winston-Salem. He was acquired by the White Sox from Milwaukee along with LF Bryan Connell for LHP Xavier Cedenó on August 31, 2018. He was originally signed as an international free agent on May 8, 2016 out of the Dominican Republic.

2023 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in the second half of 2023: First: 7 (Tied 6), Second: 26, Third: 19, Fourth: 10, Fifth: 4, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

Shut it Down: Janson Junk (6.0 IP) and Jason Alexander (3.0) combined to toss Nashville's ninth shutout of the season, the most at the Triple-A level this season. The Sounds have had 31 shutouts since joining the International League in 2021, also the most at the Triple-A level. Junk's 6.0 scoreless innings last night was the most in a start since he also tossed 6.0 scoreless on July 14, 2022 at Las Vegas with Salt Lake in the Angels organization. His win also snapped a streak of seven starts without a win. Alexander picked up the three-inning save, his first save since August 25, 2017, with Orem vs. Grand Junction.

Toro Gets On-Base: Abraham Toro extended his on-base streak to 31 games with a couple of walks last night. It's his second on-base streak of 31 games this season, tying the team's previous high which he set from April 4 to May 14. It's also tied for the fourth longest on-base streak by a Sounds hitter since 2011. Dating back to the streak's commencement on July 9, Toro is batting .369 (45-for-122) with 29 runs, 17 doubles, a triple, four home runs, 22 RBI, 17 walks and a 1.077 OPS. He is just one of two players in Major or Minor League Baseball this season to have two on-base streaks of 30 games (also Salt Lake's Michael Stefaniak, 52 & 31). His current on-base streak is the second longest active on-base streak in the league and tied for the seventh longest in the league this season.

On the Mend: Blake Perkins was the only rehabbing Milwaukee Brewer to appear in last night's game. He hit a leadoff double and finished 1-for-5 as the designated hitter. Darin Ruf and Jesse Winker both had a scheduled night off. Joining Perkins, Ruf and Winker on rehab assignment is Milwaukee outfielder Garrett Mitchell. He separated his left shoulder sliding into third base in 10th inning on April 18 at Seattle.

It's Miller Time: Owen Miller returned to the Nashville lineup with a bang, hitting a three-run shot in his first at-bat in a 2-for-4 performance. He was optioned from Milwaukee on September 11 after being added as part of the 28-man roster expansion on September 1. In his last eight games with Nashville, Miller is batting .387 (12-for-31) with two doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, five runs and a .441 OBP.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's recently updated Top-30 Milwaukee prospects list. Infielder Tyler Black is the No. 4 prospect and No. 52 in baseball, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 5 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the organization's No. 28 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet collected his 315th win at the helm of the Nashville club last night. He trails Trent Jewett (1998-2000, 2003-04) for the top spot on the all-time Sounds manager wins list. In order for Sweet to pass Jewett, Nashville would need to win 6 of their last 9. Sweet has a 315-246 record in four seasons as Nashville's skipper.

LAST OUTING: Teheran earned another win against Memphis, getting through five innings in Nashville's 10-7 win. He surrendered three runs on three hits, issued two walks and struck out five.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Teheran has faced Charlotte nine times (8 starts) in his career, all coming with Gwinnett. He is 3-2 with a 3.38 ERA (45.1 IP/17 ER), 1.41 WHIP and 35 strikeouts. His last appearance against the Knights was July 29, 2012 (ND, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 5 BB, 2 K).

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began season with Triple-A El Paso in the Padres organization... posted 5.63 ERA (40.0 IP/25 ER) in eight starts before released on May 24
