**LAST OUTING:** Teheran earned another win against Memphis, getting through five innings in Nashville's 10-7 win. He surrendered three runs on three hits, issued two walks and struck out five.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Teheran has faced Charlotte nine times (8 starts) in his career, all coming with Gwinnett. He is 3-2 with a 3.38 ERA (45.1 IP/17 ER), 1.41 WHIP and 35 strikeouts. His last appearance against the Knights was July 29, 2012 (ND, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 5 BB, 2 K).
