The Round Rock Express and Las Vegas Aviators (Oakland Athletics) get set for game three of their series at Las Vegas Ballpark. Round Rock RHP Ryan Garcia is scheduled to face Las Vegas RHP Wander Guante. First pitch is slated for 9:05 p.m. CT.

AVIATORS EARN ANOTHER WIN

Las Vegas took game two yesterday by a final of 6-2. The E-Train plated two in the first inning. After a leadoff walk for CF Dustin Harris, he stole second base. 1B Blaine Crim walked before a single for DH Sam Huff plated Harris and advanced Crim to third base. A sacrifice fly from RF Kellen Strahm made it 2-0. In the second, a two-out solo homer for Aviators SS Darrell Hernaiz cut the Express lead at 2-1. Las Vegas evened the score in the third with a two-out rally. A double for LF Hoy Park and a wild pitch advanced him to third base. After CF Ryan Noda walked, 2B Logan Davidson singled to tie the game. The Aviators scored four in the seventh. Park singled in one run, Davidson was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded to score another before DH Carlos Perez drove home two with a double to finish off the scoring for the night.

GARCIA ON THE BUMP

Round Rock RHP Ryan Garcia is scheduled for his sixth Triple-A start on Thursday. He has gone 5.0 innings or more in four of his first five starts and has not allowed more than two runs in any outing. The right-hander has made it through at least 5.0 innings in 10 of his last 11 starts which includes six starts with Double-A Frisco.

FIVE STRAGHT

The Express have lost five consecutive games for the third time this year and for the first time since August 2-7. Their longest losing streak of the year (7) came from April 18-25. Round Rock is 6.0 games back of the second playoff spot with only 16 games remaining.

TRUSTING TREVOR

Express OF Trevor Hauer finished 1-for-3 with a double and a walk last night. He owns a 15-game on-base streak in which he is slashing .357/.463/.625 with nine doubles, two home runs, nine RBI, eight runs scored, 10 walks and 16 strikeouts. He has reached base in 14 consecutive games and 15 of his last 16 while 11 of his last 20 hits have come for extra bases.

OFFENSE AS OF LATE

The E-Train offense has scored four runs in their last 33.0 innings of work going back to the third inning of Saturday's game against Oklahoma City (Excluding the 10th inning on Saturday). In the last nine games, they are averaging 2.7 runs per game. They have hit seven homers in those nine games with four of them coming from 1B Blaine Crim. The Express have not hit a home run in their last five games. The longest home run drought of the season came over seven games from May 29-June 6.

HUFF ON THE RISE

Round Rock C Sam Huff owns a six-game hitting streak and has a knock in seven of his last eight games. He is 8-for-22 with three doubles, four RBI, one walk and four strikeouts during the six games.

GOOD LUCK WITH THE CUTTER

Opposing hitters are batting just .176 against Round Rock RHP Ryan Garcia's cutter since he arrived at the Triple-A level. He is tossing the pitch more than any other offering (35.4%). PCL hitters are batting .194 against him through his first five starts.

CY YOUNG CITY (BOLD IF APPEARED AT DELL DIAMOND)

This season, the Express have seen a total of six Cy Young award winners take the mound. RHP Max Scherzer (**April 24**, June 9, **June 15**) and RHP Jacob deGrom (**August 27**, **September 1**) are the two that have pitched for the Express on rehab assignments. Los Angeles Dodgers LHP Clayton Kershaw (**July 19**), Tacoma Rainiers LHP Dallas Keuchel (**June 15**) and San Francisco Giants teammates, LHP Blake Snell (June 23) and LHP Robbie Ray (June 23) all faced the Express. Los Angeles Dodgers RHP Yoshinobu Yamamoto (**August 29**) has not won a Cy Young award but also appeared at Dell Diamond on a rehab assignment and was awarded the largest contract for a pitcher in Major League Baseball history this offseason (\$325 million). While RHP Johnny Cueto did not win a Cy Young award, he did finish second in the Cy Young voting in 2014 with Cincinnati and received votes in three different seasons (2012, 2014, 2016). Cueto made eight starts with the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
