The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland A's, activated southpaw Hogan Harris to start the series finale in a six-game set against the Great Lakes Loons, who counter with lefty Lael Lockhart. A Nuts victory would split the series, while a Loons victory would give the hosts a series win, 4-2. This will be Harris's first start since May 4 vs. West Michigan and his fourth start of the year (these starts lasting 1 IP, 2 IP and 1 IP as he eases back from missing all of last year due to injury).

Last Night: Lugnuts 4, Loons 2. Patrick McColl broke a 1-1 7th-inning tie with an RBI triple, Lawrence Butler added insurance with a 9th-inning HR, and the Lugnuts rode the pitching of Joey Estes, Brock Whittlesey and Trayson Kubo to victory, halting a three-game skid.

On Deck: The Nuts take a travel day tomorrow, continuing this 12-game, 13-day homestand with a six-game series at the Beloit Sky Carp on Tuesday. The Lugnuts' next home game is on May 31, opening a six-game series with the Cedar Rapids Kernels.

Power Binge: Lawrence Butler's 9th-inning roundtripper yesterday extended the Lugnuts' streak to 12 consecutive games with a home run. (The MLB record is 31 games, set by the 2019 New York Yankees.)

May Power: With that longball yesterday, the Lugnuts have slugged a league-leading 29 roundtrippers in 18 games in May after hitting 11 homers in 20 freezing games in April, the second-fewest total in the MWL. The Lugnuts are slashing .255/.340/.462 (.802 OPS) this month.

As a Team: The Lugnuts' offense ranks 3rd in the MWL in batting average (.248), 3rd in base hits (304), 3rd in total bases (493), tied for 2nd in home runs (40), 3rd in OBP (.332), 4th in slugging percentage (.402) and 3rd in OPS (.734).

Among the MWL Leaders: 3B Brett Harris ranks 2nd in the Midwest League in OBP (.429), 4th in slugging (.602) and 4th in OPS (1.031). OF Lawrence Butler is tied for 5th in runs scored (23), INF Euribiel Ángeles is tied for 5th with 41 hits, and relievers Angello Infante and Kumar Nambiar are tied for 2nd with 13 appearances. Starter Jeff Criswell owns the only shutout in the league thus far, a seven-inning one-hitter at Lake County.

Getting Moving: After swiping only 10 bases in their first 36 games of the season, the Nuts have stolen three bases in each of the last two games.

Your Hits, Sir: OF Jonny Butler is batting 10-for-25, .400, in his last seven games, with the first six games of that streak in April. Butler spent April 30-May 20 on the Injured List.

Southpaw's Success: Reliever **Kumar Nambiar** tossed two scoreless innings Friday, giving him one run allowed (May 10 vs. Dayton) over his last 14 1/3 innings, a streak spanning his last seven relief appearances. During that time, Nambiar has struck out 18 while walking just five. Additionally, the Yale product has allowed just one run in 9 1/3 innings this year in road games.

166 Major League Nuts: Pitcher **Danny Young** (2016 in Lansing) debuted for the Seattle Mariners on May 9 with 2 1/3 scoreless innings in relief, becoming the 166th all-time Nut to reach the Majors and the fifth this year, joining Oakland A's relievers **Zach Logue** and **Zach Jackson** and infielder **Christian Lopes** and Toronto Blue Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra**.

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

In a Nutshell: Considered at one time one of the A's top left-handed pitching prospects in the organization, Harris has overcome a series of injuries to return to the mound, delivering his first outings since August 2019... he is expected to be followed to the mound today by Stevie Emanuels... @itshoganharris.

Sports in the Family: Harris's mother was an All-American softball player at Louisiana, playing from 1992-1995... grandfather Joe Harris played football at Auburn University... Hogan himself started two years at quarterback at St. Thomas More.

Glory Days: It was baseball, however, where he truly distinguished himself... played at Petco Park in the 2014 Perfect Game All-American Game, the only player from Louisiana invited... ranked Louisiana's No. 1 player in 2015 and the No. 5 southpaw in the nation... led St. Thomas More to back-to-back state titles in 2014 and 2015... as a senior, in 42 innings, posted 0.67 ERA with five shutouts; allowed eight hits and 26 walks while striking out 76 batters... career high school ERA: 1.03.

Ragin' Cajun: In first ever college appearance, notched save... in all, made 14 relief appearances and two starts as a freshman: 3.90 ERA, 27 2/3 IP, 26 K... moved to the starting rotation as a sophomore in 2017, with a 2.66 ERA (5th in Sun Belt Conf.) and 87 strikeouts (6th) in 67 2/3 innings... followed up with a 2.62 ERA in 58 1/3 innings as a junior in 2018, whiffing 54 while allowing just one home run... played summer in Cape Cod League in 2016 (Wareham, teammates with Casey Mize and former Lugnut Sean Rackoski) and 2017 (Yarmouth-Dennis)... worked as high as 98 mph, putting him among the hardest throwers in the country.

Draft Day: Signed for \$660,000 as the 85th overall selection in the 2018 draft... other notable Athletics picks in the draft: Kyler Murray (1st round), Jeremy Eierman (2nd round), Lawrence Butler (6th round), Joe DeMers (11th round), Cobie Vance (18th round), Matt Cross (19th round), Max Schuemann (20th round), Daniel Martinez (21st round), Aiden McIntyre (22nd round), Jonah Bride (23rd round), Chase Calabuig (27th round).

Shut Down: Wrote Melissa Lockard for The Athletic, Hogan Harris was "the first pitcher the A's selected in that draft after they used their first three picks on college position players. There was a lot of excitement at the time about Harris, who came to pro ball with a fastball in the mid-90s and a high spin rate from the left side. He signed quickly, and then the momentum stopped. Before he could throw a professional pitch, Harris was sidelined with an elbow strain. The A's were cautious with his rehab, shutting him down for the rest of the 2018 season and keeping him back at extended spring training to start the 2019 campaign."

Optimism in 2019: Harris made his professional debut for the Vermont Lake Monsters in the New York-Penn League, tossing 3 1/3 innings in a loss to Connecticut on June 17, though he struck out five... two appearances later, he whiffed six while allowing just one run on two hits on June 28 vs. Staten Island... on July 3, he struck out the first six batters he faced and finished with 8 K's in 3 2/3 innings at Lowell... on July 8, he tossed four perfect innings vs. Hudson Valley... on July 13, he fanned six in three scoreless innings vs. Batavia... on July 26, he was promoted to Stockton, combining to allowing just two runs in his 9 1/3 innings in his first two starts... finished the season with four hitless innings on August 29 at Modesto.

But Then: Melissa Lockard promoted Harris as one of her top three Athletics prospects ready for a 2020 breakout, projecting him as returning to High-A Stockton to start the year before a quick promotion to Midland awaited... she wrote, "Although Harris sat more in the low-90s than the mid-90s last season, he did touch the mid-90s on occasion. A's minor-league pitching coordinator Gil Patterson said Harris got nearly 40 percent of his strikeouts on his curveball and the fastball and changeup were effective pitches for him in 2019. The focus will be improving his command a bit and tightening up the slider." Unfortunately, there was no 2020 Minor League Baseball season, and then Harris missed all of 2021 due to injury.

2022 in the Midwest League: Harris joined the Lugnuts from Spring Training, but was placed on the Injured list on Opening Day... on April 24, at last, he was activated and made his return as a starter that afternoon vs. Fort Wayne... allowed an unearned run in the 1st inning, then walked the first two batters in the 2nd inning and departed; both scored against reliever Osvaldo Berrios in a seven-run 2nd inning, and the TinCaps rolled onward to a 13-5 win... departed May 4 due to injury precaution in the middle of his warm-up pitches in the 2nd inning vs. West Michigan after tossing a scoreless 1st with 2 K... David Leal followed with 6 IP in relief in a 7-1 win... spent May 7-22 on the Injured List.

Draft Day: Selected 157th overall in the 5th round, 2020 from the University of Washington (the "Huskies")... scout: Jim Coffman, who also signed Joe DeMers, Jared McDonald and current Oakland A's outfielder Seth Brown... signed for \$400,000... drafted three picks before the end of the draft... one of three of Oakland's five 2020 draft picks on the Lugnuts (1st round - Tyler Soderstrom; 2nd round - Jeff Criswell).

Personal: Born in Seattle... played three years in Little League for, coincidentally, the A's, and still has his old A's baseball cap... younger brother, Josh, is currently a pitcher at Washington, standing 6'3... uncle, Jake, also played baseball for Washington.

Hometown: Bellevue is the third largest city in the Seattle metropolitan area... "belle vue" in French means "beautiful view"; it's situated across Lake Washington from Seattle... Amazon was founded in Bellevue in Jeff Bezos's garage on July 5, 1994... many companies are headquartered in Bellevue, notably T-Mobile USA, the North American headquarters for Pokémon, QFC, Expedia Group, Coinstar and Eddie Bauer... Russell Wilson and Ciara are currently seeking to sell their house in Bellevue (with amazing tree hosue) for \$36 million.

Glory Days: Attended Interlake High School... rated by Baseball Northwest as Washington's No. 1 baseball recruit in the Class of 2017... rated by Perfect Game as Washington's No. 4 right-handed pitcher... Interlake's alumni includes John Olerud, Larry Andersen, Jim Mora Jr., and actor Timothy Omundson.
