### Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (27-35) vs. Memphis Redbirds (34-29)

#### JACKSONVILLE SPLITS DE FACTO TWIN BILL

Dane Myers hit a pair of home runs and Devin Smeltzer tossed a seven-inning complete game to help the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp split their de facto doubleheader against the Nashville Sounds, 6-4 and 8-2, Sunday. The Jumbo Shrimp fell in the resumption of Saturday's first game but the offense came alive in game two. In the first inning of the series finale, Xavier Edwards singled and advanced to third courtesy of a double by C.J. Hinojosa. Myers blasted his first Triple-A home run to plate the first runs of the game off Nashville starter Eric Lauer.

### **BIRD HUNTING SEASON**

Since 2021, Jacksonville's first year back in Triple-A, they are an extraordinary 25-10 (.714) against the Memphis Redbirds. Perhaps most dominantly, in 2022, the clubs matched up 18 times, with Jacksonville winning 14 of those contests (.778). Since 2021, Jacksonville has outscored Memphis 194 to 136 or an average of 5.5 to 3.9 runs per game. In close contests, the Jumbo Shrimp own a record of 15-9, including an incredible come-from-behind 9-8 win on Saturday, May 6, a six-run comeback that marked Jacksonville biggest come-from-behind victory in 10 years.

#### THE BRIAN KING

Heading into play on May 12, Brian Miller had posted just a .217/.318/.315/.633 line for the season. However, over the last 22 games, the Durham, N.C., native is 26-for-74 (.351/.417/.486/.903) with six doubles, two triples, eight RBIs and 11 runs scored. After posting an 8.2 percent walk rate in 2022, Miller is walking in 10.9 percent of his plate appearances this season. He has chopped his ground ball rate from 46.3 percent to 37.5 percent.

#### CHICKS ARE DIGGING IT

In the 11 games from May 14-26, the Jumbo Shrimp launched just nine home runs, tied for the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. However, over the last 15 contests, Jacksonville has blasted 21 long balls, including a season-high six on May 27 against Charlotte, their most at notoriously pitcherfriendly 121 Financial Ballpark since hitting seven against the Carolina Mudcats on June 4, 2010. Those 21 home runs are the sixth-most in the International League level over the last 15 games.

THROUGH THE GOOD TIMES AND THE BAD Jacksonville salvaged their seven-game series on Sunday with Durham, but the six losses the Jumbo Shrimp suffered to the Bulls were their most in any set since Montgomery swept a six-game series from June 28-July 3, 2018 at 121 Financial Ballpark. Nonetheless, Jacksonville has lost 21 of its last 31 games. During this span, the club has dropped 10.0 games in the standings (6.5 to 16.5 games back). The Jumbo Shrimp's 126 runs scored (4.1 per game) are the second-fewest in Triple-A during this span, and the club owns a collective batting line of .235/.320/.385/.705, all figures that rank in the bottom three in Triple-A. Jacksonville's 180 runs allowed (5.8 per game) is the 17thmost at the level during this run.

#### **IT'S \*STARTING\* TO TURN AROUND**

Over the 27 games from May 5-June 4, Jacksonville starting pitchers combined to surrender 103 runs, 100 earned, on . 142 hits (12.4 H/9) in 103.1 innings for an 8.71 ERA. During this stretch, Jacksonville starters walked 64 (5.8 BB/9) against only 75 strikeouts (6.5 K/9). However, over the last eight contests, the club's starting pitching has improved considerably. Over this eight-game stretch, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have totaled 16 runs. 16 earned. on 26 hits (6.4 H/9) in 36.1 innings for a 3.96 ERA with 26 strikeouts (6.4 K/9) against 11 walks (2.7 BB/9). Jacksonville starters have yielded one run or fewer in four of these eight games.

#### JACOB ARTIST

Jacksonville infielder Jacob Amaya came into play on May 1 with just one hit in his previous four games. His season batting line sat at .211/.284/.311/.595 with five extra-base hits. In the 31 games, since, the El Monte, Calif., native has taken his offensive game to a new level. Amaya is 36-for-112 during this stretch, slashing .321/.386/.545/.931 with five doubles, one triple, six home runs, 20 RBIs, 12 walks and 19 runs scored. After posting a .122 ISO with Triple-A Oklahoma City in 2022, Amaya's ISO is .172 this year.

#### SHRIMP BITES

lacksonville has scored exactly four runs in four consecutive games. They had plated at least four runs in just one of the previous nine contests...Jacksonville snapped a four-series losing streak, and are looking for their first win since May 2-7.

-A graduate of Illinois State University, Lindgren was mainly a reliever in college, starting in just 17 of his 83 appearances. He went 8-14 with a 6.02 ERA over his four seasons. However, entering 2023, he has already totaled 45 minor league starts in 63 career games.

-Jeff comes from an athletic family; His father, John, played football at Henderson State University in Arkadelphia, Arkansas.

-An alumnus of Illinois State University, Jeff followed in his sister Allyson's footsteps in attending school in Bloomington-Normal, Illinois. Allyson is a fellow graduate of Illinois State.

### 2023 SEASON

- Named International League Pitcher of the Week for June 5-11. -Threw seven-inning complete game with one-run allowed on two hits with five strikeouts.

2022 SEASON

-Lingren played for the Pensacola Blue Wahoo's between stint with Jacksonville. In 2022 combine, Lingren posted a 7-4 record with 116 strikeouts in 136.2 IP.

### 2021 SEASON

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .234 (59-for-252) with a .740 OPS. However, with runners in scoring position, Lindgren buckled down for a .211 (16-for-76) opponents' average and .598 OPS.

-Lindgren got off to slower starts in 2021; in the first and second innings, opponents batted .290 (43-for-148). However, in the third and fourth innings, often his second time through the order, Lindgren held opposing hitters to a .183 (25-for-136).

-When Lindgren got hitters in a 1-2 hole, they were just 7-for-71 (.099) against him with 33 strikeouts.

Interestingly, when Lindgren was pitching from behind on the scoreboard, he performed better, holding opponents to a .176 (24-for-136) average. When his team led, opposing hitters collected a .241 (27-for-112) average.

### 2019 SEASON

-With High-A Jupiter, lefties hit .297 with a .680 OPS against Lindgren. However, he held right-handed hitters to a .176 average with a .432 OPS.

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .275 (11-for-40) against Lindgren with a .626 OPS. With runners in scoring position, Lindgren limited opposing batters to .194 (6-for-31) with a .508 OPS. Total, with runners on, Lindgren posted a .188 (9-for-48) batting average against with an OPS of .471.

### **ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES**

-At Centennial High School (Champaign, Ill.), Lindgren competed in both baseball and basketball. He served as the baseball team captain, helped win two regional championships and one sectional championship.
