TO THE HILL CITY FOR TWO: After splitting a home series with the league-leading Carolina Mudcats by winning the first three and losing the last three, the FredNats hit the road again to face the second-place team in the North Division, the Lynchburg Hillcats - Single-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. The two teams will play a 7-inning doubleheader today to make up for yesterday's rainout. This is the second series of the month between these two longtime division rivals. Lynchburg won the final four games of the first series the teams played in Fredericksburg after the FredNats outscored the Hillcats 14-1 in two wins to open the series.RHP Xander Meckley starts today looking to improve upon his better results recently, facing Lynchburg righty Sean Matson.

ABOUT LAST WEEK: The FredNats and Mudcats played five very close games to begin the series, with Fredericksburg winning the first three 2-0, 5-4 and 4-3. Fredericksburg arms took a no-hitter into the 9th inning of Tuesday's win, and Cristhian Vaquero hit a walk-off home run to win game three. But Carolina bounced back for a 6-3 win on Friday night, a 4-3 win in 11 innings on Saturday, and then they scored seven runs in the 6th inning of Sunday's game on just one hit to pull away 9-1 for the series split.

PURE DOMINANCE: The FredNat pitching staff recently enjoyed its best stretch in franchise history. In the eight games leading into Friday's doubleheader, the FredNats allowed a total of 14 runs (12 earned) in 65.2 innings, which added up to a ERA of 1.64 — the best mark in all of Minor League Baseball in that time frame. On the weekend, the FredNat arms came back down to earth, allowing a total of 23 runs in the three games, all but one two of them earned.

STARTING PITCHING REBOUND: After finishing 10th out of 12 teams in the Carolina League in ERA in the month of April, the FredNat starting rotation has turned it around in a big way in May. This month, Fredericksburg starters have an ERA of 3.08, which is tied for fourth in off al Single-A and third in the Carolina League behind Columbia (2.96) and this week's opponent Lyncburg (2.98). In the aforementioned eight-game time frame, FredNat starters posted a 1.43 ERA - six earned runs in 47.2 innings - which was the second best mark in Minor League Baseball in that time frame.

USE THE FORCE: Shortstop Luke Dickerson is off to a torrid start for the FredNats since his promotion from the FCL two weeks ago. Washington's 6th-best prospect, as ranked by MLB Pipeline, is hitting .295 with an OPS of .895. The 19-year-old already has seven extrabase hits in 10 games played for Fredericksburg. Since his call-up on 5/13, no Single-A hitter has notched more doubles (7) than Dickerson, who has three doubles in his last two games. In that same time span, his 10 RBI rank second-most among all Single-A hitters under the age of 20. Dickerson was promoted the game after these two teams last played, so this will be his first time facing the Hillcats.

DON'T EVEN TRY IT: The FredNat catching duo of Kevin Bazzell and Nate Rombach have been prolific at throwing out potential base stealers to start the season. Bazzell is throwing out 41% of base runners this year, which is the best rate in all of MiLB among qualified catchers and he ranks second in all of MiLB with 19 caught stealings. Rombach has 14 caught stealings, which is tied for the eighth-most in Single-A. Rombach is throwing out 34% of potential base stealers this year, which is top-15 in Single-A percentage wise.

SO LONG, PARTNER: FredNat reliever Adam Bloebuam was promoted to High-A Wilmington prior to today's game, deservedly so. He finally allowed his first earned run of the season on Saturday night, but in 19.2 innings for Fredericksburg, he allowed just eight hits and one earned run. He had the longest scoreless inning streak to begin the season for any Carolina League pitcher, starter or reliever. He finished those 19.2 innings with 26 strikeouts, five walks, and the opponents hit just .123 against him.

2024 CHAMPIONS: The 2024 Fredericksburg Nationals won the franchise's sixth total Carolina League championship last September, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to capture the crown. It was the franchise's first since moving to Fredericksburg in 2020, and the first since the Potomac Nationals won the Carolina League in 2014. The FredNats broke the Charleston RiverDogs' run of three titles in a row, and became the first non-Charleston team to win the league since MiLB realigned to its current leagues in 2021.

NEW SKIPPER IN TOWN: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. Prior to joining the Nationals, he coached for over a decade in the Boston organization, managing at all four full-season levels and also spending three seasons (2016-18) as the organization's base running and outfield coordinator. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: Meckley, the Nationals' 12th round pick (350th overall) in the 2024 MLB Draft, was flawless after being called up to Fredericksburg last year. He made five appearances for the FredNats between the regular season and postseason and did not give up a run. In total, he allowed just four hits in 9.1 IP and got a save in his lone opportunity with two shutout innings against LYN on 9/4.

START IT UP: Meckley's five appearances for the FredNats last year during his first year at the professional level were all out of the bullpen, making this his first year as a starter in his professional career.

LAST TIME OUT: Meckley struck out a season-low one hitter against Carolina one week after striking out a career-high six in Delmarva. He still managed to give the FredNats five innings, allowing just two runs.

VS LYNCHBURG: Meckley has pitched three times against the Hillcats in his career and has a win, a loss and a save. He's 1-1 with a 4.70 ERA and six strikeouts in 7.2 IP.

BACK IN SCHOOL: Meckley made 21 appearances at Coastal Carolina in 2024 with nine starts for the Chanticleers, posting a 7.52 ERA in 52.2 IP with 57 K's. He previously pitched two seasons at WVU Potomac State (NJCAA)...made 20 appearances (17 starts) and led the Catamounts with 73 K's and a 2.96 ERA in 2023

NEW DIGS: Yoel Tejeda Jr (Pronounced: Yo-ell Tay-hay-duh) is making his ninth Minor League appearance and start in today's game. He was the Nationals' 14th round pick (410th overall) in the 2024 MLB Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: The FredNats' most-consistent starter this season battled through traffic last week against Carolina. Tejeda allowed seven hits and four walks in 4.1 IP but only two earned runs.

TIP TOP TEJEDA: Tejeda currently ranks eighth in the Carolina League in ERA (3.53) and BAA (.234), plus ninth in WHIP (1.26).

EXECUTIVE DECISION: Tejeda has recently been working on his mental game with a sports psychologist, developing the mindset to be an "executioner" on the mound, attacking hitters without any fear.

ON FLORIDA TIME: Tejeda pitched for two different Florida schools at the collegiate level. The righthander had a 5.56 ERA in 22.2 IP as a primary starter for Florida in 2023 and a 5.95 ERA in 19.2 IP as a reliever for Florida State in 2024 after transferring.

TOP SHELF: At 6-foot-8, Tejeda is tied with Jackson Rutledge ('21, '22) as the tallest player to ever play for the FredNats.

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
