PAPILLION, NEB. - On Legends Night at Werner Park, the Omaha Storm Chasers scored a run in the first inning and led the rest of the night, for a 1-0 win over the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp for a four games to one series lead.

- In the bottom of the opening frame, Omaha opened the scoring as **John Rave** singled and scored on a **Nick Pratto** single for a 1-0 Chasers lead, what ended up being the only run of the night.
- Walter Pennington** opened what was slated to be a bullpen game for the Storm Chasers and threw 4.0 perfect innings with six strikeouts, the longest outing of his career and a career-high in strikeouts, with a stretch of five straight punchouts between the second and third innings.
- Right-hander **Jonah Dipoto** followed Pennington and pitched a 1-2-3 fifth inning, as the two combined to retire the first 15 Jumbo Shrimp hitters.
- Dipoto allowed Jacksonville's first hit of the game to open the top of the 6th inning, but otherwise finished a scoreless frame, with the potential tying run thrown out at home on a fielders' choice.
- Behind Dipoto, left-hander **Austin Cox** struck out two over a scoreless 7th inning, then **Colin Selby** worked out of trouble in a scoreless 8th inning and **Sam Long** earned his first save of the year with a scoreless 9th inning ... the latter two each used a double play to end the eighth and ninth innings respectively.
- Omaha mustered just the one run on six hits, including two from each Rave and **Devin Mann**, while the Jumbo Shrimp were held to three hits in Omaha's second shutout win of the year.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

- Omaha has won 9 of its last 10 games ... 8 of those 10 games have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 7 of the 9 wins.
- After Omaha's relievers had just 4 saves in the first 26 games, 7 of the last 8 wins have had a save awarded ... **Will Klein** has earned three saves in the last 7 wins, while **Walter Pennington** has two and **Carlos Hernández** and **Sam Long** each have one.
- In total, 24 of Omaha's 35 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or fewer (69%), including 10 of the Chasers' 12 losses this season ... in 5 of the 10 games that Omaha has lost by 3 or fewer runs, the Chasers have at the tying run either at the plate or on base ... the Storm Chasers have only lost one game by more than 4 runs: a 9-1 loss on April 18 at Nashville.
- The Storm Chasers have not allowed more than 9 runs in a game this season ... of the 20-team International League, only Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and Omaha have yet to allow a double-digit run total, but SWB has 5 games of 9+ runs allowed ... 16 of 20 IL teams have allowed 10 or more runs at least 3 times.

#### I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

- Omaha has outscored its opponents 205 to 157 this season, a +48 run differential.
- A +44 run differential ranks as the best in the International League and is 3rd in Triple-A ... Oklahoma City leads the Triple-A lead at a +65 run differential.

#### GETTING OFFENSIVE

- Omaha has been one of the top hitting teams in the International League in the month of May, with a 8-2 record so far this month.
- Omaha leads the league in doubles this month (28) and ranks 2nd in hits (96), tied 2nd in stolen bases (15), 3rd in runs scored (65) and tied 3rd in total bases (161).
- Overall in 2024, Omaha's 205 runs scored rank 5th in the International League and 12th in Triple-A, with 7 of the 10 Pacific Coast League teams ahead of the Chasers.

#### JUST THE 2 OF US...

- The Storm Chasers are one of the best 2-out hitting teams at the Triple-A level.
- In 2-out situations this season, Omaha is slashing .269/.346/.506 (104-for-386) ... among all 30 Triple-A teams, the Chasers are 5th in average (.270) and 2nd in slugging (.506) and OPS (.852) ... 196 total bases and 19 home runs with 2 outs also rank 2nd-best at the Triple-A level.
- During this week's series, Omaha is hitting .321 (18-for-56) in 2-out situations, with a .877 OPS.

#### RELIEF AID

- Omaha's bullpen remains one of the best in the International League and even across the entire Triple-A level.
- The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a .205 average (122-for-595), which is tied for the best mark among Triple-A teams, while the .660 opposing OPS also ranks 3rd-best and a 3.73 ERA against the Omaha bullpen is also 3rd-best in Triple-A.
- Yesterday's combined shutout marked the 7th time Omaha's relievers combined in a single game to not allow any runs ... 5.0 scoreless innings from the bullpen is the second-most in a game this year, after 6.0 scoreless frames on March 29 vs. Iowa.
- With 36 strikeouts and just 4 walks, **Walter Pennington** boasts a Triple-A best 9.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio (min 20.0 IP) ... his 37.1% strikeout rate (36 K in 97 TBF) is 4th in Triple-A (also min. 20.0 IP).
- Dan Altavilla** has recorded SEVEN consecutive scoreless games ... **Evan Sisk** has five straight with 9 strikeouts in his last 5.1 innings (16 outs), while **Sam Long** has 4 straight scoreless appearances and **Carlos Hernández** has 3 consecutive.

#### TODAY'S START

- ✓ Davies is making his **4th start** of the season after signing a Minor League deal with the Royals on April 8 ... he was assigned to Omaha on April 24, ahead of his first start ... he was in Spring Training with Washington, released by the Nationals on March 24.
- ✓ This year is his first time pitching in Triple-A outside of rehab assignments since April 2016 with Colorado Springs (Brewers AAA).
- ✓ The Royals in 2024 mark Davies' 7th MLB organization ... was with the Orioles for the first 4 seasons (2012-15) of his professional career before being traded to Milwaukee in 2015 ... pitched parts of 5 seasons in the Brewers organization (2015-19), then was traded from Milwaukee to San Diego in 2019 and spent the 2020 season with the Padres, traded from San Diego to the Cubs after the season ... spent 2021 with the Cubs, elected free agency after the season ... signed with Arizona in March 2022, then re-signed January 2023, spending two seasons with the Diamondbacks (2022-23) ... was in Spring Training in 2024 with Washington.

#### LAST OUTING: TUESDAY, MAY 7 vs. JACKSONVILLE

Made his third start of the season in the series opener and allowed 3 runs in the 1st inning on three hits, including a 2-run homer from Tristan Gray ... retired 11 of his next 14 into the 5th inning after the home run, including a 1-2-3 frame in the 3rd inning ... was removed after allowing a one-out double in the fifth, earned a no-decision ... Omaha scored 4 in the bottom of the 1st after the 3 run top of the 1st.
